- Selection is done solely on the merit of proposals.

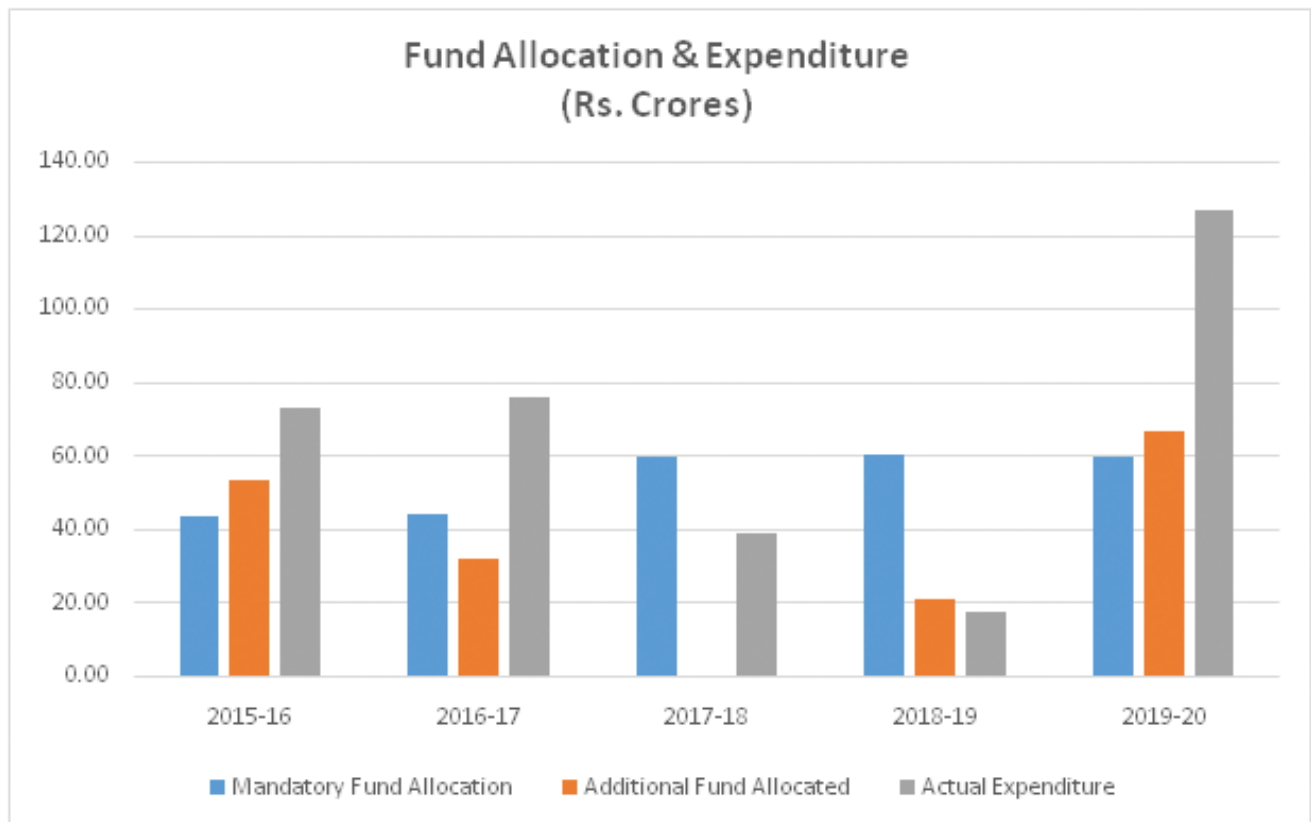
## Monitoring and Evaluation of CSR Activities

- The 03 tier Management structure for Implementation, Monitoring and Evaluating the progress of CSR schemes/activities in NHPC are as under:
  - i) The Board level Committee on CSR headed by an Independent Director
  - ii) Nodal Officer of the Rank of Executive Director assisted by his team
  - iii) Regional ED/ Project Head/ Unit Head and his team for implementation and monitoring
- The progress of CSR & Sustainability schemes under implementation at each of the location is being reported by the Unit Head to Nodal Officer at Corporate Office, on a monthly basis.
- Records are being maintained along with photographs/videos to show progress of works.
- Quarterly Reports regarding the progress of implementation of CSR and Sustainability activities are reviewed by CSR Committee and NHPC Board.

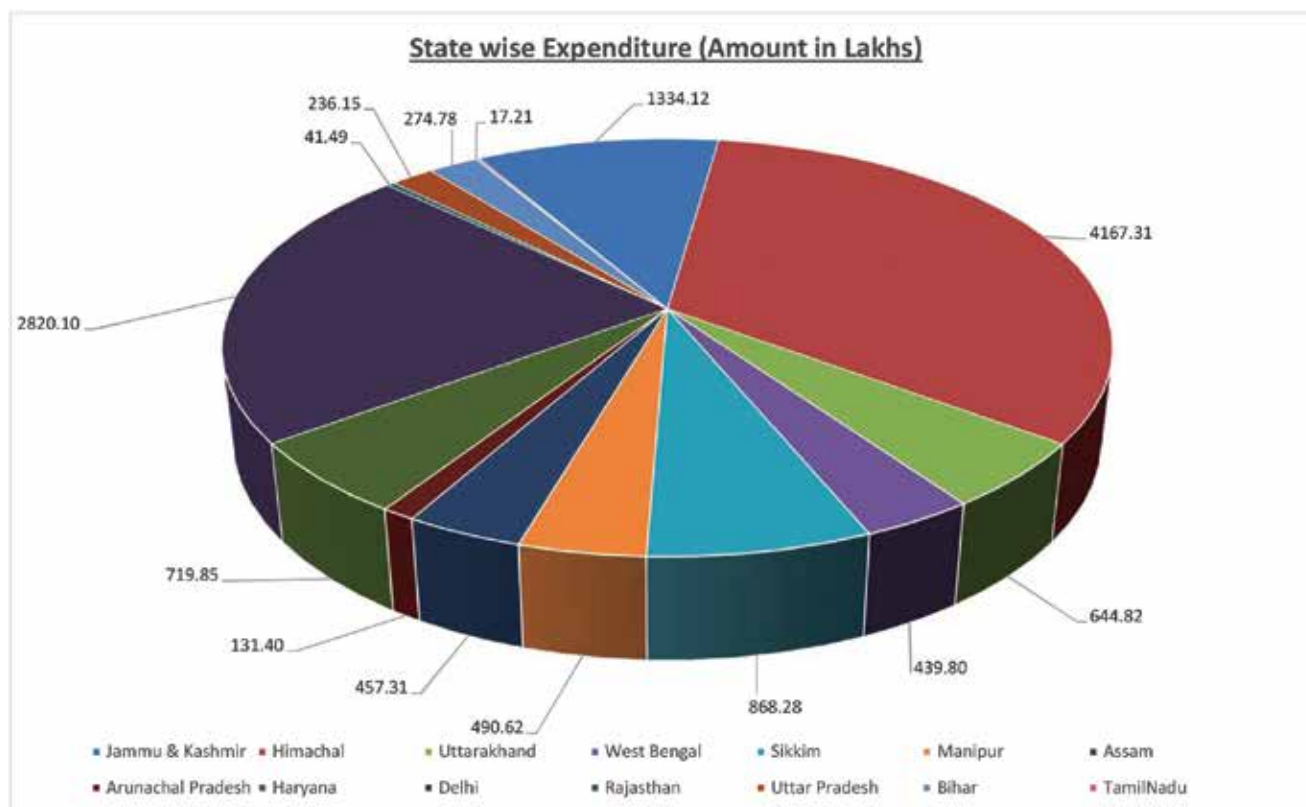

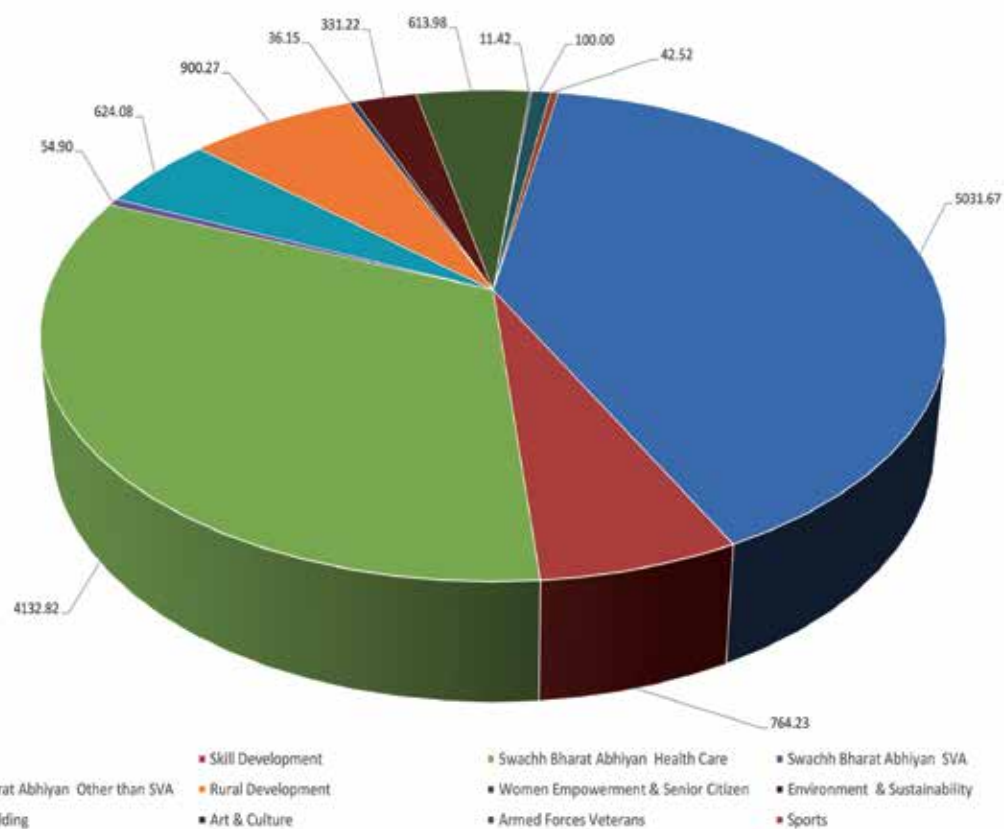

## EDUCATION & SKILL DEVELOPMENT

Education is a lifelong process for sustainability that leads to informed and involved citizens having scientific, social literacy and commitment to engage in responsible individual and cooperative actions.

NHPC believes in holistic learning and giving top priority to education. Supporting the school education today will nurture citizens of tomorrow. It is felt that building a good base for holistic learning will contribute to a developed society. Social literacy being one of the main objectives, NHPC, under its CSR initiatives, focuses on creation/up gradation of more infrastructures for primary education, higher education and vocational courses for the rural population helping them to achieve success.

The Schools, shaping the generations, are in very bad condition at many places. The teachers (Gurus), having a very special role to play in imparting education, are bound to work in a miserable condition due to old and dilapidated infrastructure of the school. NHPC under its CSR initiative, has changed and upgraded a good number of such schools and few more are in the process by way of Construction & Up-gradation of their class rooms, establishing Libraries, Labs, Digital Smart Class Rooms, providing scholarships to a large number of students studying in Govt. schools within the vicinity of Projects/ Power Stations/ Townships. NHPC is already promoting education at all levels through its Kendriya Vidyalayas and a few DAV Schools in the NHPC's Power Stations & Projects across the Country.

Various Skill Development Programs have been initiated to improve quality of life of people and around 3000 persons have been trained with the aim of providing 70% placement in Government identified Aspirational districts of Baramulla (UT of J&K) and Chamba (HP) as well as at other locations. Employment Oriented Training for livelihood enhancement of around 1000 Persons

with Disabilities (PwDs) have also been taken up.

NHPC in association with NTPC has set up a Hydro Engineering College at Bilaspur, Himachal Pradesh (H.P.). NHPC has contributed Rs. 37.5 Crore for setting up of the College during FY 2016-17. It has also paid Rs.15.0 Crore towards the administrative expenses of the College. NHPC has also contributed Rs.13.0 Crore for establishment of Darjeeling Engineering College, Takdah, West Bengal. This college is also under construction.

NHPC has adopted 13 nos. ITIs in the country (7 in UT of J&K, 4 in Uttarakhand & 2 in Arunachal Pradesh). NHPC has spent around Rs.5.23 Crores towards various up-gradation activities of these ITIs.

## RENOVATION & UPGRADATION OF GOVT. SR. SECONDARY SCHOOL, PAWTA:

The Govt. senior secondary School, Pawta (Faridabad) was running with very poor and old building with only basic infra-structures, laboratory for science students with only few instruments, computer lab without Computer, No furniture for classrooms, Unhygienic condition of toilet and damaged septic tank and Water tank.

Principal of the School requested NHPC to help in renovation of the School under NHPC CSR Initiative. The School was visited by the NHPC Engineers, prepared Estimates and NHPC



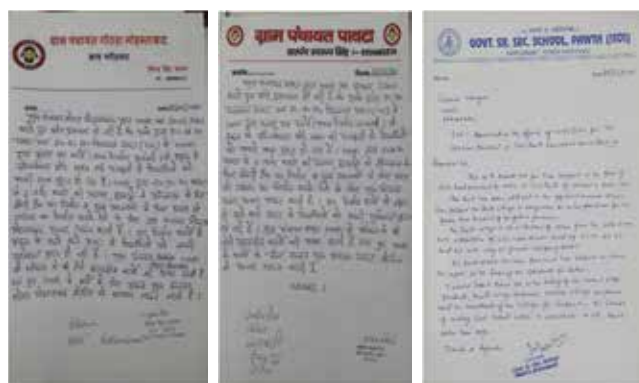

The project was executed by the Vidyalay Management Committee at a cost of Rs 10,00,000/- and all financial, technical help and supervision was extended by the Engineers of NHPC as and when required free of cost.

Similarly, CSR Division funded for the installations of Water cooler, R.O Plant, Water dispenser, Interactive Board with Speaker for classrooms and its utilities in Kendriya Vidyalaya No.3, Faridabad and contributed with smart Board, library books, computer, printer and enriched the Practical room of DAV Police public School, Sector 30 at Faridabad. NHPC CSR Division contributed for 100 Ekal Vidyalayas in Himachal Pradesh for informal education at villages of Himachal Pradesh.



## EMPLOYMENT ORIENTED SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING THROUGH NSDC

Providing Employment oriented Skill Development Training has been one of the key interventions of NHPC. It has provided Skill Development Training to 5500 Unemployed Youth in Job Roles of Asstt. Electrician, Sewing machine operator, Self-employed Tailor, Customer care executive, Food & beverage service steward, Retail Sales

associate, Meet & greet Officer through agencies like National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), CIDC etc with an FI of Rs.7.47 Crores. 3965 trained youth have been placed so far and are taking their families forward.

## EMPLOYMENT ORIENTED SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING FOR DIVYANGJANS/ PWDS:

NHPC has also endeavoured to provide Skill Development Training to 1000 nos. of Divyangjans in the Job Roles of Sewing machine operator, Hand Embroidery & Self-employed Tailor through National Handicapped Finance Development Corporation (NHFDC) with an FI of Rs. 2.65 Crores. Out of 1000 PwDs trained from across the country, 329 have been trained in the Aspirational Districts of Chamba and Baramulla. Around 338 divyangjans have been placed, so far, of which 104 Divyangjans have been placed from Aspirational Districts.

The brief details of other CSR initiatives taken under Education & Skill Development by the NHPC Power Station/Projects/Units are as under:

### 1. SALAL POWER STATION

- **Up-gradation of adopted ITI Reasi & Ramban (J&K)**

Salal Power Station has adopted two ITI's i) ITI Reasi and ii) ITI Ramban. Hydraulic Lifting Jack Unit, CRDI Diesel Engine and other equipment's for greasing wheel alignment and washing vehicles etc. with Financial Implications of Rs. 12.85 Lakhs were provided to Motor Mechanic trade of above two ITIs on 30.11.2019.

- **Improvement of School Buildings:**

Improvement of existing buildings and



construction of boundary wall/protection walls and other facilities have been taken up in 04 Nos. Govt. Schools of Reasi

District, J&K under CSR initiative. The works are in progress.

## 2. DULHASTI POWER STATION

- **Up gradation of adopted ITI:**

ITI Kishtwar has been adopted by NHPC in September 2013. Since then every year activities are undertaken for up gradation of ITI Kishtwar as per the request received from the Principal, ITI Kishtwar. In FY 2019-20, CCTV Camera System has been installed in ITI Kishtwar with total cost of Rs.2,69,113/-

- **Construction of two rooms at 1st Floor and stairs in Govt. High School:**

The construction work of two rooms and stairs in Govt. High School, Dumna, Dool, Kishtwar has been completed in FY 2019-20 with total expenditure of Rs.11,33,809/-



- **Maintenance/ Repair/ Renovation of building of Govt. Girls H. School Sangrambhata:**

MoU for the Maintenance/ repair/ renovation work of building of Govt. Girls H. School Sangrambhata, Kishtwar has been signed with Distt. Administration on 28.02.2020. The total project cost is Rs.7.40 Lakh. The work is under progress.



- **Repair of Compound Wall and Floor of the Govt. Middle School, Bagwan Mohalla, Kishtwar.**



The MoU for the above work has been signed with Distt. Administration on 28.02.2020. The total project cost is Rs.6.60 Lakh. The work is under progress.



### 3. KISHENGANGA :

- **Establishment of Smart Class Rooms with Computer Lab:**

With a view to promoting education, Kishanganga Power Station is implementing a CSR initiative namely Establishment of Smart Class Rooms with Computer Lab at High School Wanpora Gurez in association with District Administration, Bandipora. Materials/ aids required for establishment of Smart Class Rooms at HS Wanpora Gurez have been procured during FY 2019-20 for installation and Rs. 1.25 lac spent

for the procurement of equipment during FY 2019-20.

### 4. CHUTAK POWER STATION :

- **Winter Tuition in nearby four Govt. Schools:**

Schools of the locality remain closed during the peak winter period between the month of December to February every year. During this period tuition classes for school going children are arranged by the respective Village Education Council. On the basis of requests received from respective VEC, Chutak Power Station launched a scheme of Winter Tuition in four nearby Govt. Schools. Financial Assistance of Rs. 6.0 lac were provided to these schools to meet the expenses towards arrangement of tutors, basic heating facilities etc. Approximately, 500 children benefited by this scheme of Winter Tuition during FY 2019-20.



### 5. NIMOO-BAZGO:

- **Winter Tuition:**

During the peak winter period between the months of December to February every year the Schools of the locality remain closed. Many local committee/ schools run winter tuitions at various government schools of the district so that students can be kept engaged during

vacation period. During FY 2019-20, Nimoo Bazgo Power Station has provided financial assistance to the tune of Rs.4.00 Lacs, to meet the expenses towards arrangement of tutors and other basic heating facilities in various nearby schools, for the benefit of local students.

- **Up gradation of ITI – Providing IT related scraps for Computer Hardware Lab:**

With a view to give practical demonstration to ITI, Leh students in Computer Hardware and Network Maintenance Trade, IT related scraps for Computer Hardware Lab were provided to ITI, Leh for the benefit of students.

- **Financial Assistance to District Administration, Leh for Extra Coaching classes for Female Students:**

Considering the nobility of purpose of education to female students and to bring confidence and help in shaping up their future, Financial Assistance to the tune of Rs. 1.00 lac (One Lac only) was provided to District Administration, Leh for Extra Coaching classes for Female Students.

## 6. SEWA-II POWER STATION :

- **Installation of smart classrooms in 05 Govt. Middle/ High/ Higher Secondary Schools:**

Promoting IT-enabled school education by way of installation of smart classrooms in 05 Govt. Schools in the Vicinity of the Power Station at Hutt, Mashka, Draman, Bani & Gatti. The infrastructure has been handed over to the school authorities for its optimum utilization and routine maintenance. Each & every staff member and student of the school has welcomed

this new initiative and some have already raised demand for more in the future.

- **Scholarships for Higher Studies:**

NHPC Scholarships for Higher Studies have been provided to 19 eligible students pursuing different undergraduate courses in Govt. Degree College Basohli & Bani. The State Administration, College authorities & students have profusely thanked NHPC for this immensely helpful support.

## 7. BAIRA SIUL POWER STATION :

- **Providing Scholarship for Higher Studies after Passing class 12th under “NHPC Scholarship Award Scheme” (Expenditure- Rs. 6.56 Lakh)**

On 28th January 2020, Scholarship was given to total 31 Students residing in Chamba District for their higher studies after passing class 12th. (Female- 20, Male-11). Amount has been directly credited in the account of concerned students through ECS. A total expenditure of Rs. 6.56 Lakh incurred on this scholarship. These Students also narrated the benefit of Scholarship







and their parents have been very much grateful to NHPC.

नीति आयोग, भारत सरकार द्वारा जिला चम्बा को एस्पिरेशनल जिला घोषित किया गया था एवं सार्वजनिक उपक्रम होने के नाते एनएचपीसी को जिला चम्बा में स्वास्थ्य व शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में विकास करने के लिए जिम्मेदारी सौंपी गई थी।

इसी क्रम में, शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में विकास करने के लिए, जिला प्रशासन चम्बा से एक अनुरोध प्राप्त हुआ जिसके अनुसार जिला चम्बा में 52 विद्यालय ऐसे थे जिनके पास अपने विद्यालय भवन नहीं थे तथा इनमें शिक्षा ग्रहण करने वाले विद्यार्थियों को असुविधा होती थी व इस कठिनाई को देखकर अन्य बच्चे भी एडमिशन नहीं ले पा रहे थे। एनएचपीसी ने शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में योगदान करने के लिए इन 52 स्कूलों के लिए विद्यालय भवन का निर्माण करने

का निश्चय किया व जिला प्रशासन के इस अनुरोध को स्वीकार किया। शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में ही, जिला प्रशासन द्वारा एक अन्य अनुरोध किया गया जिसके अनुसार जिला चम्बा में स्थित समानीकोठी विद्यालयों में 04 स्मार्ट क्लासेज तथा पुस्तकालयों का निर्माण करने से संबंधित था उसे भी एनएचपीसी द्वारा पूर्ण किया जा रहा है।

जिला प्रशासन चम्बा द्वारा प्रस्तुत किए गए उपरोक्त प्रस्तावों के लिए जिला प्रशासन चम्बा व एनएचपीसी के मध्य रुपये 21.39 करोड़ का समझौता ज्ञापन हस्ताक्षरित किए गए, जिसमें से रुपये 11.12 करोड़ के शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में विकास से संबंधित थे।

## 12. DHAULIGANGA POWER STATION

- **बांध स्थल के निकट ग्राम खेत के राजकीय इंटर कॉलेज में ओडिटोरियम का निर्माण कार्य :**

धौलीगंगा पावर स्टेशन के बांध स्थल, छिरकीला के समीपवर्ती ग्राम खेला में प्रदेश सरकार द्वारा एक इंटर कालेज स्थापित है। पावर स्टेशन के सम्पूर्ण जलग्रह (catchment) क्षेत्र व दारमा घाटी में स्थापित यह एक मात्र इंटर कॉलेज है। वर्तमान में इस कॉलेज में पूरी घाटी के दुर्गम क्षेत्र में स्थित गाँवों के निर्धन/मध्यमवर्गीय परिवारों के कुल 154 छात्र-छात्राएं अध्ययनरत हैं। विगत वर्ष 2013 में उत्तराखंड में आई प्राकृतिक आपदा में इस कॉलेज की तीन इमारतें क्षतिग्रस्त हो गई थी। कक्षाओं के लिए कमरों की कमी होने से पठन-पाठन के कार्य में असुविधा होने लगी जिससे इन ग्रामों से पलायन कर लोग आस-पास के कस्बों में जाने को बाध्य हो गए। आपदा ग्रस्त इस कॉलेज में स्थान की भी कमी होने के कारण कॉलेज प्रशासन द्वारा एनएचपीसी से एक ओडिटोरियम निर्माण का अनुरोध किया गया ताकि बच्चों को सामूहिक रूप से भी पढ़ाया जा सके। कार्य के महत्व व आवश्यकता को देखते हुए एनएचपीसी द्वारा ओडिटोरियम निर्माण का कार्य किया जा रहा

है। इस कार्य से जहां इस वर्ष के 154 बच्चों को लाभ होगा वहीं कार्य के जीवन पर्यंत तक 7700 से अधिक बच्चे लाभान्वित होंगे साथ ही ग्रामों से पलायन भी रुक जाएगा। इस कार्य में कुल 9.59 लाख रुपये की लागत आई है।

#### ● राजकीय कन्या इंटर कॉलेज, धारचूला के विद्यार्थियों के लिए फर्नीचर आवंटन

सम्पूर्ण धारचूला तहसील में केवल बालिकाओं के लिए स्थापित इस राजकीय इंटर कॉलेज में 478 बालिकाएँ अध्ययन कर रही हैं। कॉलेज प्रशासन के अनुरोध पर इस कॉलेज का सर्वे करने के उपरांत ज्ञात हुआ कि कॉलेज में अध्ययनरत कुल बालिकाओं में से आधी संख्या में ही फर्नीचर उपलब्ध है। ऐसे में जाड़ा हो या बरसात अधिकांश बालिकाओं को जमीन पर ही बैठ कर पढ़ाई करनी होती है। बालिकाओं में शिक्षा के प्रति प्रोत्साहित करने की सरकार की नीति व इस विश्व भौगोलिक परिस्थितियों में निवास करने वाले ग्रामीणों को बालिकाओं की पढ़ाई बीच में ना छोड़ना पड़े, और उन्हें उत्साहित करने के लिए एनएचपीसी की ओर से इन्हें 160 तबले और 160 कुर्सियाँ उपलब्ध कराई गई। इस कार्य में कुल 3.24 लाख रुपये की लागत आई है।

#### ● राजकीय प्राइमरी स्कूल भवन जमकू का नवीकरण:

धौलीगंगा पावर स्टेशन के ऊपरी बहाव में पहाड़ी पर स्थित जमकू गाँव में एक राजकीय प्राइमरी स्कूल है। इस स्कूल में लंबे समय से मरम्मत का कार्य न होने के कारण इसकी छत, फर्स व खिड़कियाँ अत्यधिक खराब हो चुकी थी। बरसात के मौसम में छत से पानी टपकने के कारण बच्चों की पढ़ाई का कार्य अवरुद्ध हो जाता था। स्थलीय निरीक्षण के पश्चात आर्थिक रूप से कमजोर परिवारों से संबन्धित इन छोटे बच्चों के लिए, जो जाड़ों में ठिठुरने व बरसात में भीगने के कारण पढ़ाई से वंचित हो जा रहे थे, भवन नवीकरण का कार्य एनएचपीसी द्वारा किया गया। वर्तमान में इस स्कूल में कुल 25 बच्चे पढ़ते हैं। इस प्रकार कहा जा सकता है कि इस कार्य से आगामी 20 वर्षों में 500 से अधिक बच्चे लाभान्वित होंगे।

#### ● राजकीय इंटर कॉलेज खेत, राजकीय इंटर कॉलेज खुम्ती, राजकीय इंटर कॉलेज खेला, राजकीय इंटर कॉलेज रांथी एवं आंगन बाड़ी केंद्र एवं प्राइमरी स्कूल, बोरा गाँव में शौचालय का निर्माण:

उपरोक्त दुर्गम पहाड़ी स्थानों में स्थित प्रदेश सरकार के इन स्कूलों के प्रशासन द्वारा लंबे समय से शौचालय न होने अथवा क्षतिग्रस्त होने के कारण एनएचपीसी से शौचालय निर्माण का अनुरोध किया जाता रहा है। धौलीगंगा पावर स्टेशन की ओर से स्थल निरीक्षण में भी पाया गया कि पहाड़ियों पर स्थित इन विद्यालयों में बालक व बालिकाएँ संयुक्त रूप से पढ़ते हैं, परंतु शौचालय की समुचित व्यवस्था नहीं है। अतः आवश्यकता



के अनुरूप इन विद्यालयों में शौचालयों का निर्माण किया गया। इस कार्य में कुल 15.30 लाख रुपये की लागत आई है। वर्तमान में इन विद्यालयों में 930 विद्यार्थी अध्ययनरत हैं और शौचालय का लाभ ले रहे हैं।

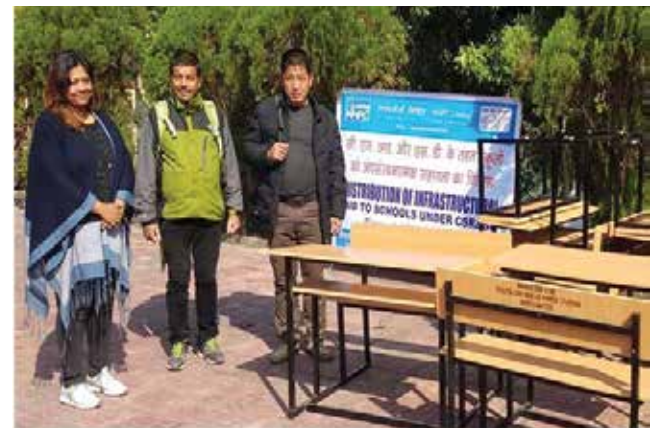
- **Providing Infrastructure support/aid to Govt. schools in project vicinity through distribution of furniture and other educational aids**

## HEALTH CARE

NHPC endeavour to provide better healthcare facilities to the poor and needy patients belonging to the underprivileged sections of the society has proactively undertaken several health related initiatives under its Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR). Organising series of Eye and general health check-up camps across NHPC benefitting numerous people of the tough and hilly regions of the country with health and eye ailments, malnutrition etc. During the camps, patients are provided with free consultation, medicines, referrals and cataract surgeries etc. to maximise the impact of the CSR initiatives.

Under the CSR initiatives of NHPC, Divyangs are being supported with artificial limbs at various places by identifying their needs with the help of local administration. NHPC also supported the installation of sanitary vending machines at schools to provide hygiene facility to school going girl students. Apart from the above, NHPC is facilitating a few medical centres with High end Medical Equipments, Multi-utility vehicles/ambulances and other infrastructural support to Govt. Hospitals on recommendations of State and District Administration.

During the year NHPC organized assessment camp for identification of beneficiaries and distribution of artificial limbs, clutches, hearing aids, wheel chairs etc. to the selected beneficiaries in West Sikkim (Sikkim) through Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation of India (ALIMCO), a Central Public Sector Enterprise.

### COMBATING COVID-19

In the present pandemic scenario of Covid-19, NHPC took initiatives from the beginning to combat Covid-19 with its support to the Govt. and the community living around its establishments across the country. The focus area was fixed with creating awareness among the community,

distribution of Masks, PPE Kits, Alcohol based sanitizers, Food for the daily wagers & Contract workers besides wages. Extending medical support to the Local People and all required support to the Local Administration with special reference to airlifting of medical equipments, medicines etc. under CSR to Govt. of Manipur by hiring a chartered plane on request and many more. NHPC is taking all care of community during the COVID-19 pandemic.

### CONTRIBUTION TO PM CARE FUND

NHPC contributed with Rs. 25.0 crore from the CSR budget of 2019-20 to PM CARES Fund towards combating COVID-19 pandemic in the country.

### DRINKING WATER MANAGEMENT

**Water contamination** is rampant and leads to nearly 6,00,000 deaths annually. NHPC, under its CSR initiatives, started safe Drinking water facilities by way of bore wells, RO plants, Construction/ Installation of Water Supply Lines in villages/ schools etc. Rain water harvesting is also getting its space in the CSR initiatives of NHPC with future plans.

NHPC, under its CSR initiatives, started safe Drinking water project for the rural citizen in Muzaffar-Nagar district of Uttar Pradesh.





## PROVIDING AIDS & ASSISTIVE DEVICES TO DIVYANGJANS/ PWDS

NHPC in its aim to provide a healing touch to the lives of Divyangjans has entered into 04 MoUs with Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation Limited (ALIMCO) at an estimated value of Rs. 3.24 Crores for assessing the special needs of Divyangjans and provide them with customized Aids and Assistive devices in Baramulla, Chamba, West Sikkim, Bandipora, West Siang, Subansiri, Lakhimpur, Pithoragarh and Churachandrapur.

ALIMCO has provided Aids and Assistive devices for 202 People with Disabilities (PwDs) from Baramulla District, J&K with total cost of Rs 22.45 lakhs in 2019. A total of 395 aids and assistive devices were distributed, which includes 6 Joy stick Wheel chairs, 8 Tricycles, 67 Wheel-chairs, 13 CP Wheel chairs, 122 Hearing aids, 13 MSIED kits, 3 Smart canes, 46 Crutches, 54 Walking sticks, 10 Rollator, 1 Cervical collar, 9 Artificial limbs and 42 Callipers. 73 Divyangjans from West Sikkim District have been provided Aids and Assistive devices through ALIMCO with total cost of Rs 6.18 lakhs. 180 People with Disabilities (PwDs) from Chamba District have been assessed for providing Aids and Assistive devices through ALIMCO with total cost of Rs 22.66 lakhs.

Three number Medical Camps were organized

in nearby areas of Banikeht & Dalhaousie on 25/9/2019, 14/11/2019 & 6/3/2020. Total amount spent during the FY 2019-20 is Rs.5.67 lakh.

## 10. BAIRA SIUL POWER STATION

### ● Organising medical Camps

One Medical Camp was organised at Bhajradu (Tissa) near Dam of Bairasiul Power Station on 20.09.2019. Afterwards, medicines were provided to patients. Total 1445 Villagers got benefited from Medical Camp. ECG and other routine check-up were also carried out by Medical Officers of this Power Station. Many senior citizen of the village appreciated the step of NHPC as they got benefitted through this camp. (Expenditure-Rs. 3.73 Lakh)



### ● Providing services of Hospital/ Dispensary to outsiders:

Baira Siul Power Station runs a Hospital at Surangani. Presently there are two Doctors, out of two, one lady doctor is also available. Many local villagers are getting benefitted by this Project

Hospital. In nearby area, there is no such large Hospital. Many serious cases are being also attended here even in odd hours. It is truly serving as Welfare gesture to locals. This noble help is very much helpful in image building of NHPC. Approx. number of beneficiaries are 5200.

## 11. CHAMERA-I POWER STATION

### ● Free Multispecialty Medical Camp:

Good health is an important aspect for the growth of human being and also for healthy society & nation. Providing primary health care services to local people is our basic corporate social responsibility. In FY 2019-20, Chamera Power Station-I has organised 02 nos. Multispecialty Medical Camps at project hospital on 07.12.2019 and 04.02.2020 in association with the India's premier hospitals i.e. Fortis Hospital, Kangda and Indraprastha Apollo Hospital, New Delhi respectively.

In the medical camps, specialist doctors of cardiology, orthopaedics, general medicine, gynaecologists etc. provided their consultation to the patients. Various pathological tests like ECG, Bone Mineral Density, X-Ray, Sugar tests etc. were conducted and medicines

were given to patients free of cost. A large number of people from nearby villages availed the benefit from these multispecialty medical camps.

### ● Providing of Steel benches to the Ayurvedic Health Centre:

Chamera Power Station-I provided 02 nos. steel benches to the Ayurvedic Health Centre, Village- Simni in March 2020. Ayurvedic Health Centre is situated en route to dam site of the power station in village Simni. It is the only health care centre which provides primary medical services in the vicinity.

## 12. CHAMERA-II POWER STATION

### ● एस्पिरेशनल जिला चंबा के विकास के लिए सीएसआर एंड एसडी के अन्तर्गत एनएचपीसी ने रुपये 21.39 करोड़ के समझौता ज्ञापन किए:

नीति आयोग, भारत सरकार द्वारा जिला चंबा को एस्पिरेशनल जिला घोषित किया गया था एवं सार्वजनिक उपक्रम होने के नाते एनएचपीसी को जिला चंबा में स्वास्थ्य व शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में विकास करने के लिए जिम्मेदारी सौंपी गई थी। इस संबंध में जिला प्रशासन चंबा द्वारा राजकीय मैडिकल कॉलेज, चंबा में एमआरआई व सीटी स्कैन मशीनों के लिए अनुरोध किया गया। उपरोक्त मशीनों की अनुपलब्धता के कारण जिला चंबा के निवासियों को सी टी स्कैन व एमआरआई कराने के लिए 150 किलोमीटर दूर स्थित पठानकोट जाना पड़ता था एवं इसमें उन्हें अनेक कठिनाईयों का सामना करना पड़ता था। एनएचपीसी ने वस्तुस्थिति को समझते हुए जिला प्रशासन के इस अनुरोध को स्वीकार किया।

### 13. CHAMERA & III POWER STATION

- निःशुल्क चिकित्सा कैंप:

चमेरा-II पावर स्टेशन द्वारा परियोजना क्षेत्र के आस पास के गाँव जोकि चम्बा शहर से काफी दूर दराज इलाकों में अवस्थित हैं और जहाँ के लोगों को चिकित्सा जाँच एवं दवाईयों के लिए बीमारी की अवस्था में अपने घर से काफी दूर पैदल चलकर जाना पड़ता है। ऐसे ग्रामीण इलाकों में चिकित्सा शिविरों के माध्यम से लोगों को उनके घर के समीप ही आवश्यक चिकित्सा सुविधाएं उपलब्ध करवाई जाती हैं। इन शिविरों में निःशुल्क जाँच करवा कर लोग अपने स्वास्थ्य के प्रति सजग रहते हैं तथा जो लोग (जिसमें काफी संख्या में बुजुर्ग, बच्चे व महिलाएँ होती है) चिकित्सा-जाँच के दौरान बीमार पाए जाते हैं उन्हें तुरन्त निःशुल्क दवाईयाँ उपलब्ध करवाई जाती हैं और आवश्यक उपचार सुझाए जाते हैं। वर्ष 2019-20 में भी सी.एस.आर. के अन्तर्गत दो चिकित्सा शिविरों का आयोजन किया गया। जिनमें से एक निःशुल्क चिकित्सा शिविर 02.11.2019 को चम्बा की राड़ी पंचायत के गुआँ गाँव में और एक कैंप 02.12.2019 को बटोट गाँव में लगाया गया। इन दोनों चिकित्सा शिविरों में 711 लोगों ने निःशुल्क चिकित्सा जाँच व दवाईयों का लाभ उठाया।



- कोविड-19 महामारी से निपटने हेतु किए गए कार्य:

भारत के समक्ष एक बड़े संकट के रूप में खड़ी वर्तमान चुनौती कोविड-19 से निपटने के लिए एनएचपीसी के अन्य पावर स्टेशनों की तरह चमेरा-III भी यथा आवश्यक कार्य कर रहा है। चमेरा-III में वैश्विक महामारी कोविड-19 से निपटने के लिए सी.एस.आर. के अन्तर्गत अनेक कार्य किए गए हैं और यह कार्य अभी भी जारी हैं।

इसके लिए कोविड-19 महामारी के दौरान लॉकडाउन में फंसे हुए श्रमिकों व पावर स्टेशन के आस-पास के लोथल, खड़ामुख व धरवाला इत्यादि गाँवों के जरूरतमंद गरीब स्थानीय लोगों को किराने की वस्तुओं का वितरण किया गया। जून माह के प्रथम सप्ताह तक कुल 4531 किलो राशन का वितरण पावर स्टेशन द्वारा जरूरतमंद लोगों में किया जा चुका है। इसके अतिरिक्त इस महामारी से लड़ने में सहायता हेतु आवश्यक Medical PPEs थर्मल-स्कैनर की व्यवस्था के साथ-साथ निरंतर सैनिटाइजर, मास्क इत्यादि भी लोगों को उपलब्ध करवाए जा रहे हैं।

Total cost of the activity is Rs. 6.22 lakhs and the work done through reserved fund.

### 15. PARBATI-III POWER STATION

एनएचपीसी की 520 मेगावाट की पार्वती-III पावर स्टेशन, हिमाचल प्रदेश के दूरस्थ इलाके कुल्लू के सैन्ज वैली में स्थित है और जून 2014 में इस परियोजना से लगातार बिजली का उत्पादन किया जा रहा है। पार्वती-III द्वारा अभी तक सीएसआर एवं एसडी योजना के अंतर्गत लगभग 2.04 करोड़ रुपये इस इलाके व स्थानीय जन के चौमुखी विकास हेतु खर्च किए जा चुके हैं। जिससे निःसंदेह पार्वती-III

के प्रभावित पंचायतों का आर्थिक-सामाजिक विकास हुआ है। गत वर्ष 2019-20 में पार्वती-III पावर स्टेशन द्वारा निम्नलिखित सीएसआर एवं एसडी की गतिविधियों को किया गया, जिसमें कुल रु 30.00 लाख का खर्चा किया गया।

● **स्वास्थ्य के क्षेत्र में किया रिकार्ड मरीजों की जांच व आवश्यक इलाज:**

स्वास्थ्य के क्षेत्र में इस वर्ष पावर स्टेशन द्वारा लगभग 6.0 लाख की राशि में कुल तीन मुख्य कैंप लगाए गए। जिसमें दो कैंप निःशुल्क नेत्र जांच चिकित्सा कैंप जिसमें लगभग रिकार्ड 224 लोगों की जांच की गयी व 37 लोगों के आंखों की मोतियाबिंद का सफल आपरेशन भी करवाया गया। इसके साथ ही "हेल्थ व न्यूट्रीशन" हेड के अंतर्गत प्रभावित पंचायतों के 11 आंगनबाड़ी के कुल 80 बच्चों को "पोषण व स्वच्छता किट प्रदान किया गया। इसके अतिरिक्त इस वर्ष परियोजना क्षेत्र "बंजार" में हुए बस हादसे में 5 घायल जनों तथा कुल्लू स्थित नवचेतना केंद्र के 10 दिव्यांग बच्चों को "व्हील चेयर व चलने हेतु वाकिंग स्टिकस" प्रदान की गयी। एनएचपीसी के इस प्रयास व सहयोग की पूरे क्षेत्र ने सराहना की।

### ● Providing 2 Nos. of Medical Ambulances to local Govt. Hospital

The power station has provided 2 nos. of Ambulances, one each to Bishnupur and Churachandpur District Administration. The people of both the districts will be benefitted by these ambulances. These ambulances were handed over to the Dy. Commissioners of the concerned districts on 2nd July 2019. More than 10000 people of Bishnupur and Churachandpur districts will be benefitted by this CSR initiative of NHPC.



## 17. DHAULIGANGA POWER STATION

### ● ग्राम खेला के शेरी में पेय जल टैंक व 300 मीटर जल आपूर्ति लाइन उपलब्ध करना:

धौलीगंगा पावर स्टेशन के बांध स्थल के पास स्थित शेरी गाँव के 176 निवासी पेय जल की व्यवस्था करने के लिए रोज एक किलोमीटर की दूरी से पानी ढोने



को मजबूर थे। जिससे उनका रोजमर्रा के कार्यों में व्यवधान पैदा होता था। ग्रामीणों की मांग व स्थानीय प्रशासन के अनुरोध पर पावर स्टेशन द्वारा जल स्रोत से उक्त ग्राम तक पेय जल लाइन व टैंक का निर्माण किया गया। इस कार्य से ग्राम के 176 ग्रामीणों को राहत मिली है। इस कार्य में 4.74 लाख रुपये की लागत आई है।



#### ● चिकित्सा शिविर का आयोजन:

धौलीगंगा पावर स्टेशन जो उत्तराखंड के नेपाल व चीन सीमा से लगे अत्यधिक दुर्गम व कठिन भौगोलिक धारचूला में स्थित है। इस मध्य हिमालयी पर्वत श्रृंखला में बसे गाँव के ग्रामीणों का जीवन भी संघर्षपूर्ण होता है। यहाँ अन्य जीवन उपयोगी सामग्री के अतिरिक्त चिकित्सा व्यवस्था भी एक चुनौती ही है। पावर स्टेशन का प्रयास रहता है कि इन दूरदराज के गाँव में पहुँच कर ग्रामीणों के स्वास्थ्य लाभ के लिए कार्य करे, जो ग्रामीणों के लिए सुखद आश्चर्य की अनुभूति कराता है। इस वर्ष पावर स्टेशन द्वारा इस क्षेत्र में चार स्वास्थ्य शिविरों में कुल



833 मरीजों का निशुल्क स्वास्थ्य परीक्षण कर दवा वितरित की। इस कार्यक्रम में कुल 5.99 लाख रुपये व्यय किए गए।

## 18. REGION&SILIGURI

- कोरोना (कोविड-19) से निपटने में एनएचपीसी क्षेत्रीय कार्यालय ने निभाया सक्रिय भूमिका व्यक्तिगत सुरक्षा सामग्री, जरूरतमंदों को भोजन एवं जागरूकता अभियान:

उपरोक्त तथ्यों को ध्यान में रखते हुए क्षेत्रीय कार्यालय, सिलीगुड़ी द्वारा मेडिका नॉर्थ बंगाल क्लिनिक, सिलीगुड़ी के सहयोग से 07 फरवरी 2020 को बहादुर मुन्ना हैप्पी होम हाई स्कूल, पंगा साहेबबरी, जलपाईगुड़ी में एक दिवसीय निशुल्क चिकित्सा शिविर का आयोजन किया गया। इस चिकित्सीय शिविर में कुल 286 व्यक्तियों की चिकित्सीय जाँच मेडिका नॉर्थ बंगाल क्लिनिक सिलीगुड़ी के तीन वरिष्ठ डॉक्टर एवं एनएचपीसी के वरिष्ठ उप मुख्य चिकित्सा अधिकारी एवं तकनीशियनों की टीम के द्वारा की गयी तथा संबंधित बीमारियों की मुफ्त दवाएँ भी बाँटी गयी। इस चिकित्सा शिविर में ज्यादातर मरीज रक्तचाप (बीपी), मधुमेह व त्वचा से संबंधित पाए गए जिन्हें आगे के इलाज के लिए राज्य के स्वास्थ्य केंद्रों में जाने की सलाह दी गई। बहादुर

## SWACHH BHARAT ABHIYAN

A large number of public health and sanitation activities has been initiated by NHPC under Swachh Bharat Abhiyan which includes Safe Drinking water facilities in public area, Community Drinking Water facility with RO Plant, Basic Amenities/ Sanitation facilities in market/ public area, Construction/ Installation of water supply lines and sanitation in villages, construction of toilets in school/ public places, water supply system for schools, installation of Garbage bins, Adoption of Public places for carrying out developmental activities, Solid waste management of the locality, utility van for cleaning debris etc. The activities undertaken at different locations of NHPC under 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' are described below:

The brief details of CSR initiatives taken under Swachh Bharat Abhiyan by the NHPC Power Stations & Projects are as under:

### 1. DULHASTI POWER STATION

- **Construction of community Toilet Complex:**

The Community Toilet Complex in three villages, Wanni, Trigam, Kishtwar

have been constructed with Financial Implication of Rs. 4.54 Lakh.



- **Adoption Chowgan Ground for development & maintenance:**

उपरोक्त दुर्गम पहाड़ी स्थानों में स्थित प्रदेश सरकार के इन स्कूलों के प्रशासन द्वारा लंबे समय से शौचालय न होने अथवा क्षतिग्रस्त होने के कारण एनएचपीसी से शौचालय निर्माण का अनुरोध किया जाता रहा है। धौलीगंगा पावर स्टेशन कि ओर से स्थलीय निरक्षण में भी पाया गया कि पहाड़ियों पर स्थित इन विद्यालयों में बालक व बालिकाएँ सयुक्त रूप से पड़ते हैं परंतु शौचालय की समुचित व्यवस्था नहीं है। पूरे देश में चलाई जा रही स्वच्छ भारत अभियान के मद्देनजर आवश्यकता के अनुरूप इन विद्यालयों में शौचालयों का निर्माण किया गया। इस कार्य में कुल 15.30 लाख रुपये कि लागत आई है। वर्तमान में इन विद्यालयों में अध्यनरत लगभग 930 विद्यार्थी इसका लाभ ले रहे हैं।

ग्राम पंचायतों के अनुरोध एवं स्थानीय प्रशासन की अनुशंसा पर स्थलीय निरीक्षण कर आवश्यकता के अनुसार उपरोक्त ग्रामों में समूहिक शौचालयों का निर्माण किया जा रहा है। शौचालय निर्माण के लिए सम्पूर्ण गाँव के लिए सुलभ स्थल अथवा ग्राम पंचायत भवन की भूमि का चयन किया गया। शौचालयों की स्वच्छता को बनाए रखने के लिए समुचित पानी की व्यवस्था भी की गई। इन शौचालयों के निर्माण से वर्तमान में उपरोक्त ग्रामों के 1041 ग्रामीण लाभान्वित होंगे। इस कार्य में कुल 16.99 लाख रुपये की लागत आएगी। उच्च पर्वतीय क्षेत्र में बर्फबारी के कारण इस कार्य को आगामी वर्ष में पूर्ण किया जाएगा।

During FY 2019-20, 04 nos. of RO-cum-Sanitation Complexes located at different location such as Podumani, Dhemaji, Gohpur and Bilmukh in Assam have been completed and commissioned by the Project. A total amount of Rs.34.99 Lakh was utilised in this activity during FY 2019-20.



## RURAL DEVELOPMENT

A large number of rural development Projects focussing on building visible assets/ infrastructure with community awareness, capacity building of communities, and creation of institutions for maintaining these infrastructures. In order to make the projects sustainable, it is important to integrate community and Panchayat engagement and converge different government department's right from beginning. Sustainability is not a onetime exercise rather it is a dynamic and continuous process which needs to be carried out for certain period of time in project area. It includes the vision

of development of community in the village. The community takes interest in maintaining village infrastructure with a strong concept of ownership.

NHPC has taken up various Rural Development programs to augment basic infrastructure facilities like construction of Community Centres, Water Supply Lines, Drains, Roads/ Paths etc. as per the need and requirements of the larger under-privileged and marginalized rural communities. NHPC has also undertaken the construction activities of Rain shelters, Passenger sheds, Cremation sheds, etc. and carried out the work of educating and training the farmers for development of Agriculture/ Horticulture/ fisheries and other advanced methods of farming.

Creating Community Centres at many villages of NHPC operational areas and few more villages lie Basti district in U.P. etc. by NHPC is a part of CSR programmes. NHPC has been acting as an agency providing a robust platform to the civil society organisations joining hands for strengthening responsible business practices.





NHPC is continuously working in this area by organizing a good number of Vocational training programmes and short term computer courses at many locations. Recently NHPC has developed manufacturing units in Hathin Block at rural area of Palwal and Nuh in Mewat for manufacturing and selling Napkin for Ladies with NGO partners successfully.

## 1. SALAL POWER STATION

## 2. URI-I POWER STATION

Chutak Power Station is located at a very difficult terrain in the Union Territory of Ladakh and remains cut-off from road connectivity during winter season i.e. November to April, for a period of six months. In such situations, Chutak Power Station has undertaken various activities for CSR&SD initiative to meet the aspirations of local people. Accordingly, CSR&SD initiatives were undertaken during the FY 2019-20 in the areas of Providing Drinking Water & Rural Development.

### ● Installation of Hand Pump

To tap the alternate source for water supply, three Nos. of hand pumps were successfully installed in at nearby villages namely, Chhutuk, Stickchey and Cheycheythang.

### ● Construction of Pedestrian Suspension Bridge over Baira River in the D/S of Baira Dam:

A Pedestrian Suspension Bridge over Baira River in the D/S of Baira Dam, near village Nakhrod, has been constructed with Financial Implication of Rs. 15.05 Lakhs and It has brought delight for the users. Approximately 800 villagers has been benefited.





- **Construction of Community Hall at Mahila Mandal, Byana and MOU Signed for keeping and maintenance.**

This Power Station located at Surangani falls under Byana Panchyat and Mahila Mandal of Byana Panchayat and local people of these Panchayats had requested for construction of Community Hall for performing different community works. Accordingly, the Community Hall has been constructed at Byana with FI of Rs.3.04 Lakhs. It is proving very much useful for performing various meetings/ functions of local villagers. Approximately 2300 villagers has been benefited.



## 8. CHAMERA-II POWER STATION

## 9. CHAMERA & III POWER STATION

- **पगडंडी पर रेलिंग का निर्माण:**

पहाड़ी गाँवों की ढलानदार पगडंडियाँ चलने में काफी असुरक्षित होती हैं। क्योंकि कई बार लोग ढलानदार पगडंडियों पर चलते हुए फिसल कर दुर्घटना के शिकार हो जाते हैं। ऐसे में यदि इन पगडंडियों पर रेलिंग का निर्माण कर दिया जाए तो लोगों के लिए आड़ी-टेड़ी पगडंडी काफी सुगम्य, सुविधाजनक और सुरक्षित हो जाती है। इसी को ध्यान में रखते हुए चमेरा-III पावर स्टेशन द्वारा अक्टूबर 2019 में ग्राम पंचायत दुर्गोठी के ठेडू गाँव के फुटपाथ पर रेलिंग का निर्माण किया है। जिससे न केवल उस गाँव के 1200 लोगों को बल्कि दूसरे गाँवों से वहाँ आने-जाने वाले लोगों को भी काफी सुविधा हुई है। रेलिंग लगने से ग्रामीण अब इस पगडंडी पर चलते हुए काफी सुरक्षित महसूस करते हैं।

Banjar, Distt.- Kullu, where cow sheds were burnt completely and victim families were facing lots of difficulties, and after consideration of magnitude of loss of villagers, project had procured 200 CGI sheets and distributed to the villagers in presence of Shri Surender Shourie, Hon'ble MLA, Banjar constituency, Sh. R. K. Jaiswal, Chief General Manager and other senior officers of the project.

## 11. PARBATI-III POWER STATION

एनएचपीसी की 520 मेगावाट की पार्वती-III पावर स्टेशन, हिमाचल प्रदेश के दूरस्थ इलाके कुल्लू के सैन्ज वैली में स्थित है और जून 2014 में इस परियोजना से लगातार बिजली का उत्पादन किया जा रहा है। पार्वती-III द्वारा अभी तक सीएसआर एवं एसडी योजना के अंतर्गत लगभग 2.04 करोड़ इस इलाके व स्थानीय जन के चौमुखी विकास हेतु खर्च किए जा चुके हैं। जिससे निःसंदेह पार्वती-III के प्रभावित पंचायतों का आर्थिक-सामाजिक विकास हुआ है। गत वर्ष 2019-20 में पार्वती-III पावर स्टेशन द्वारा सीएसआर एवं एसडी की विभिन्न गतिविधियों को किया गया, जिसमें कुल रु 30.00 लाख का खर्चा किया गया, जिनमें मुख्य निम्न हैं:

- वर्षा शालिका का निर्माण:

पार्वती-III पावर स्टेशन के द्वारा सैन्ज बाजार में स्थित बस स्टैंड जहां से रोजाना लगभग 1000 से 1500 स्थानीय जन, छात्र, व्यापारी, पर्यटक आदि लगभग 50 गांवों के लिए वाहन लेकर आते-जाते हैं, वहां पर लगभग 3.0 लाख की लागत पर एक "वर्षा शालिका" का निर्माण करवाया गया। यह "वर्षा शालिका" इस इलाके की प्रथम ऐसी शालिका है जिसमें कुत्ते, गाय, भैंस आदि जानवरों को रोकने हेतु गेट का प्रावधान किया गया है, इस कारण यह शालिका सदैव ही स्वच्छ व यात्रियों के लिए सुरक्षित शालिका के रूप में इस क्षेत्र में बहुत ही अच्छी पहचान बना चुकी है।

## 12. LOKTAK POWER STATION

- Providing GI water Supply Pipeline & Roofing for the tank at Kha Aimol Village:

People of Kha-Aimol village are getting portable drinking water by implementation of this project around 2000 villagers get benefited.

### 13. DHAULIGANGA POWER STATION

- कमेड़पानी गाँव में पेय जल की व्यवस्था:**

पावर हाउस स्थल में पहाड़ी के ऊपर बसे कमेड़पानी गाँव में पेय जल की व्यवस्था न होने के कारण ग्रामीण पैदल मार्ग से पानी ढोने को मजबूर थे। इस गाँव की ग्रामीण मुख्यतया खेती से अपना जीवन यापन करते हैं। गाँव की महिलाओं को खेती के साथ रोजमर्रा के कार्यों को करने के साथ पानी ढोने का अतिरिक्त कार्य भी करना पड़ता था। ग्रामीणों की मांग व स्थानीय प्रशासन के अनुरोध पर

पावर स्टेशन द्वारा जल स्रोत से उक्त ग्राम तक पेय जल लाइन व टैंक का निर्माण किया गया। इस कार्य से वर्तमान में ग्राम के 112 ग्रामीणों को लाभ प्राप्त होगा। इस कार्य में 4.25 लाख रुपये की लागत आई है।



- तपोवन में शव दाह यार्ड व शेड का पुनर्निर्माण**

उत्तराखण्ड में 2013 में आई भयावह प्रकृतिक आपदा में तपोवन के निकट काली नदी के तट पर बना शव दाह स्थल क्षतिग्रस्त हो गया था। पावर स्टेशन के प्रशासनिक भवन के निकट इस शव दाह स्थल का उपयोग आस-पास के बहुत से गाँव व कस्बे के लोग करते हैं। इस स्थल के क्षतिग्रस्त होने के बाद से ही स्थानीय जनता व जनप्रतिनिधियों के साथ पंचायत प्रतिनिधियों द्वारा भी इसके पुनर्निर्माण की मांग एनएचपीसी से की जाती रही है। इस क्षेत्र में एनएचपीसी का धौलीगंगा पावर स्टेशन एक मात्र बड़ा संस्थान है जो क्षेत्र में सामुदायिक विकास के प्रति संवेदनशीलता का परिचय देता रहा है। स्वच्छता को बनाए रखने व स्थानीय जनता की परेशानियों को देखते हुए पावर स्टेशन द्वारा एक शव दाह यार्ड व शेड का निर्माण किया गया। इस कार्य में 6.28 लाख रुपये की लागत आई।

- **गाँव खेला में अंबेडकर भवन का निर्माण:**

इस क्षेत्र का गाँव खेला मुख्य सड़क मार्ग से 3.5 किलोमीटर से 6 किलोमीटर के पैदल मार्ग में बसा है। इसी गाँव का एक टोक चेतकला ग्राम है। इस गाँव में 184 एससी व 26 ओबीसी श्रेणी के ग्रामीण निवास करते हैं। सड़क मार्ग से दूर स्थित होने के कारण इस गाँव के ग्रामीणों को समय-समय पर होने वाले आयोजन, ग्राम विकास तथा समस्याओं पर चर्चा एवं मिलन समारोह इत्यादि के लिए खुले स्थानों में व्यवस्था करनी होती थी। इस अंबेडकर भवन के लिए ग्रामीणों द्वारा अपनी भूमि ग्राम सभा को दान में दी गई व प्रशासन के माध्यम से एनएचपीसी से अनुरोध किया गया। इन आर्थिक रूप से कमजोर दलित समुदाय के सामूहिक उत्थान के लिए अंबेडकर भवन की आवश्यकता महसूस करते हुए पावर स्टेशन ने अंबेडकर भवन का निर्माण किया। इस कार्य में कुल 15.50 लाख रुपये की लागत आई है एवं वर्तमान आबादी के अनुसार 210 ग्रामीण लाभान्वित हुए हैं।

#### 14. TLD-III POWER STATION

- **Construction of Community Halls at two places**

Community Halls along with Kitchen & Toilets have been constructed at two places of Mungpoo and Deorali at Teesta valley and enable the Villagers



to organize community gatherings like meetings, marriages, religious functions, etc and hence 550 villagers may benefited from such activity.

#### 15. TEESTA LOW DAM-IV POWER STATION

- **Providing drinking water**

With the aim to develop the basic amenities for the local residents, TLD IV PS has provided water supply line from Lapchay Khola to Upper Makum from the nearest water source which is approx. 5 Kms away from the village.

For the purpose, a water catch pit at the source and two collection tank with a capacity of 1000 ltrs each have been constructed near the Village and hence, 60 households comprising of 200 persons belonging to ST category benefited, thus an amount of Rs 21.95 lakhs has been spend.



- **Providing drinking water from Dodhey Jhora to Subugaon, Yangmakum GP**

TLD-IVPS has provided water supply to Subugaon, from the nearest source, by constructing the water catch pit tank of capacity of 1000 to store and supply water to the village households comprising of 200 beneficiaries belonging to ST

community. FI for the same is Rs.20.15 lakhs.



- **Providing infrastructure support/ aid to community hall constructed at villages through distribution of furniture and other aids**

Infrastructural support in the form of plastic Chairs and tables were given for the Community Halls constructed by NHPC in the villages with FI of Rs 0.78 Lakh.

## 16. RANGIT POWER STATION

- **Construction of Multipurpose Hall**

Under rural development, Rangit Power Station has been undertaking a lot of initiatives to ensure basic infrastructural facilities to the community residing in its vicinity. An activity like construction of Multipurpose Hall is being carried out with an estimated expenditure of Rs.4.0 lacs. This will benefit a number of people in this region.

#### 1. DULHASTI POWER STATION

- **Development of Herbal Park for Preventive Health care:**

A MOU for reconstruction & repair of flood-ravaged Manjhiri Park at Bani has been signed with District Authority for CSR sustainability in collaborative mode. The work is in progress.

## 3. CHAMERA-I POWER STATION

- **Providing of Steel benches to the Ayurvedic Health Centre:**

In its commitment towards Rural and Peripheral development, Chamera Power Station-I made sufficient sitting arrangement of Patients with providing steel benches to the Ayurvedic Health Centre, Village- Simni in March 2020. Ayurvedic Health Centre, Simni is situated near dam site of the power station. It is the only health care center providing primary medical services in the vicinity.

## 4. KOTLIBHEL HE PROJECT-1A

The Project has installed Solar street lights (12 Watt) in villages i.e. Muneth, Niger etc situated in the vicinity. An amount of Rs.

3.44 Lakh has been spent on this. Residents of the above villages are benefitted with this initiative. Work was completed in June, 2019.



## 5. TEESTA LOW DAM-III POWER STATION

- **Installation of Solar Street Lights:**

Untoward occurrence was regular feature in some areas of Rambhi due to darkness and unavailability of light during night. The TLD-III PS was requested by Local residents and local administration for installation of lights in the area.

Considering the above, 6 nos of Solar Street Lights have been installed in the Rambhi area adjacent to NH-10. More than 500 local residents are benefitted with this installations.

## MISCELLANEOUS ACTIVITIES

### CAPACITY BUILDING, WOMEN EMPOWERMENT & CONTRIBUTION TO ARMED FORCES VETERANS ETC.

NHPC has contributed towards numerous CSR activities designed for empowering the women and creation of facilities for senior citizens and assisted in imparting skill development training to promote self-employment for women. Established Sanitary Napkin Unit for women empowerment & livelihood enhancement in the Aspirational district of Mewat, taken up renovation of only women market & Aganwadi Centre and also distributed Sewing machines etc. for income generation and building self-dependence.

Impact assessment of the numerous activities has taken up to check and regulate the results and benefits as well as to enhance the efficiency and viability. As such the activities like Swachh Bharat Abhiyan in Assam and Arunachal Pradesh comprising of construction of 3129 Toilets, Safe drinking water Facilities, RO cum sanitation Complex, Providing healthcare facilities to remote rural villages by 20 nos. mobile medical units in five districts of Assam, skill development initiatives of RO-Itanagar, Vivekanand Kendra Vidhyalaya at Dollungmukh circle of Kamle district of Arunachal Pradesh were assessed through the Impact assessment program under the sector capacity building which gave a brief idea about its effectiveness in the region. Similar activity for impact Assessment has been done for TLD-III, IV and R.O. Siliguri through University of North Bengal. Administrative overheads has been regulated through this head for implementing the various CSR activities.

NHPC has also contributed towards Training to promote Rural Sports. NHPC has taken up CSR initiatives for protection of art and culture and

contributed towards Armed Forces Flag day Fund.

In the difficult times of the COVID 19 pandemic, NHPC has contributed an amount of Rs.25.0 Crores to the "PM CARES Fund". NHPC has provided assistance to the local administration in fighting the pandemic by distributing essential food items, medicines, Hygiene Kits, assisting in sanitation drives etc. Many of the NHPC locations geared up to create Quarantine centres in their dispensaries.

Activities undertaken by Projects/ Power Stations/ Units for protection of Art & Culture, empowerment of women & setting up of facilities for Senior Citizen, promotion of rural sports etc. are as under:

## 1. SALAL POWER STATION
