- Records are being maintained along with photographs/videos to show progress of works.







HEALTH & SANITATION

Procurement of Cold Chain Equipment for Covid-19 Vaccination

To support and strengthen the health infrasture in UT of Jammu & Kashmir during COVID pandemic, NHPC took intiative to augment the Govt. intiative in vaccination programme. NHPC has procured 176 no. Cold Chain Equipment such as Walk-In Freezer-01 no., Ice Lined Refrigerator-112 no., Deep Freezer- 64 no. for an amount of Rs. 1.60 cr. These medical eqipment were handed over to the Department of Family Welfare, MCH & Immunization, Govt. of J&K (UT) in phased manner in the March-21 & April-21.

NHPC Regional Office, Jammu spent Rs. 160.10 lakh to purchase Walk in Freezer (01 nos.), ILR (Small -83 nos., Large - 29 nos.), Deep Freezer (Small - 62 nos., Large - 01 nos.) under Corporate Social Responsibility.

2. SALAL POWER STATION

EDUCATION AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT:

चार स्कूलों का जीर्णोद्वार और अन्य आधारभूत निर्माण कार्यों का निष्पादनः

स्थानीय प्रशासन एवं शिक्षा विभाग के अनुरोध पर सलाल पावर स्टेशन द्वारा वित वर्ष 2020–21 में सीएसआर एवं एसडी योजना के तहत अपने परियोजना क्षेत्र में आने वाले सरकारी विद्यालयों में रु 36.41 लाख की लागत से जीर्णोद्वार और अन्य आधारभूत निर्माण कार्य जैसे कि प्ले/एसेम्बली ग्राउण्ड, बाउन्ड्री, वाल, रसोई घर, क्लास रूम, सीढ़ियाँ और टॉयलेट आदि का निर्माण तथा कुछ मरम्मत कार्य करवाये गए। सलाल पावर स्टेशन की इस सीएसआर गतिविधि से लाभान्वित होने वाले सरकारी विद्यालयों में गवर्नमेंट मिडिल स्कूल, बक्कल ,गवर्नमेंट हाई स्कूल,खैरल, गवर्नमेंट हाई स्कूल, कुंडरा और गर्वनमेंट प्राईमरी स्कूल त्रिंथा शामिल हैं। इस गतिविधि से प्रतिवर्ष लगभग कुल 500 से ज्यादा विद्यार्धियों को लाभ मिल रहा है।

सलाल पावर स्टेशन के आवासीय कालोनी ज्योतिपुरम में स्थित "केंद्रीय विद्यालय" इस दूर—दराज के क्षेत्र में रहने वाले बच्चों के लिए एक वरदान के रूप में अपनी पहचान बना चुका है। इस विद्यालय से स्थानीय बच्चे लगातार अच्छी शिक्षा प्राप्त कर अपने उज्जवल भविष्य के ओर अग्रसर हैं। विगत वर्ष की भांति ही वित्त वर्ष 2020—21 में भी कुल 941 छात्रों को इसका लाभ प्राप्त हुआ। वित्त वर्ष 2020—21 में इस विद्यालय के संचालन में पावर स्टेशन ने कुल 259.19 लाख का खर्च किया है।

RURAL DEVELOPMENT

• बिड्डा गाव में आरसीसी पानी की टकी का निर्माण

परियोजना परिक्षेत्र के बिडड़ा गांव को स्थानीय पंचायत और निवासियों द्वारा "आदर्श ग्राम" बनाने की गुजारिश की गई थी, जिसके फलस्वरूप सलाल पावर स्टेशन ने इस गाँव को गोद लिया है। सलाल पावर स्टेशन द्वारा गाँव को सुचारू जल आपूर्ति के लिए रु. 10.97 लाख की लागत से 1.25 लाख लीटर की क्षमता वाली आरसीसी पानी का टैंक बनवाया। इससे पहले इस क्षेत्र में मात्र 25000 लीटर की क्षमता वाली टैंक से जल–आपूर्ति किया जाता था, जोकि वहां के स्थानीय जन के लिए अपर्याप्त था। इस पानी के टैंक बनाने से लगभग 1250 लोगों को लाभ मिल रहा है।

परियोजना परिक्षेत्र के कोटला और थेरु गांव में ग्राम पंचायत और स्थानीय लोगों के अनुरोध पर जल—आपूर्ति परियोजना का कार्य सलाल पावर स्टेशन द्वारा सीएसआर एवं एसडी योजना के अंतर्गत करवाया जा रहा है। यह कार्य स्थानीय प्रशासन "डिप्टी डेवेलेपमेंट कमिश्नर" के साथ एमओयू के तहत "डिपॉजिट बेसिस" पर करवाया जा रहा है। परियोजना की कुल लागत रु.123.00 लाख है और अभी तक कुल रु 39.5 लाख खर्च किया जा चुका है। जिसमें से वित्त वर्ष 2020—21 में कुल रु 16.5 लाख का भुगतान किया गया है। इस गतिविधि से कुल 601 लोग लाभाविन्त होंगे।

Govt. Primary School, Sarowa is located near to dam of the Power Station. The village and school authorities have been requesting for providing toilet facilities for girl students as there was no proper toilet facility for them. Power Station constructed the toilets in the school under Swachh Vidyalaya Abhiyan and an amount of Rs. 2.86 Lakhs was spent in carrying out the said activity. About 28 students are benefitted through this CSR activity.

The existing class rooms of Govt. Primary School Bhandar were in dilapidated state and it was dangerous for the students as well as teachers. Owing to its poor condition, Power Station has received a request for its renovation. Accordingly, the class rooms were got renovated by Power Station and handed over to the school in good condition. The School Management Committee was very much obliged and thanked for the help extended by Power Station under their CSR initiative. The activity is benefitting to approximately 58 students. An expenditure of Rs. 2.66 Lakh was incurred on said CSR Work.

• Re-Construction of Surangani Bus Stand

Surangani bus stand was very old & in dilapidated condition, which was unsafe & dangerous for the commuters. A population of about 1500 persons frequently use this bus stand to commute anywhere. Surangani experiences inclement weather and most of the time, rain occurs which causes trouble to the local villagers who wait for Bus and other vehicles at Surangani. The Panchayat Pradhan of Byana and other villagers requested the Power Station to re-construct the Bus stand so that it may serve the cause of the local people. Power Station at the request of Panchayat & villagers, reconstructed the bus stand at an expenditure of Rs. 9.06 Lakhs

• Emergent activities for COVID-19 and others

After the onset of COVID-19, there has been widespread panic and a sense of insecurity among the local population. Power station has distributed face masks, sanitizers, Dettol soap, cleaning materials, hand wash etc among the villagers and it helped them in taking precautions to fight against COVID. Approximately 1030 villagers got benefitted. Apart from that a quarantine centre was also established in the Power Station as per the direction of the District Administration and many patients were treated in this centre. During quarantine period, patients were also provided food and other facilities free of cost. An expenditure of Rs. 1.00 Lakh was made against this activity.

 बाँध के निकट राजकीय इंटर कॉलेज में ओडिटोरियम का निर्माण:

धौलीगंगा पावर स्टेशन के बांध स्थल, छिरकीला के समीपवर्ती ग्राम खेला में प्रदेश सरकार द्वारा एक इंटर कालेज स्थापित है। पावर स्टेशन के सम्पूर्ण जलग्रह (catchment) क्षेत्र व दारमा घाटी में स्थापित यह एक मात्र इंटर कॉलेज है। वर्तमान में इस कॉलेज में पूरी घाटी के दुर्गम क्षेत्र में स्थित गाँवों के निर्धन / मध्यमवर्गीय परिवारों के कुल 154 छात्र / छात्राएं अध्ययनरत है। विगत वर्ष 2013 में उत्तराखंड में आई प्राकृतिक आपदा में इस कॉलेज की तीन इमारतें क्षतिग्रस्त हो गई थी। कक्षाओं के लिए कमरों की कमी होने से पठन—पाठन के कार्य में अस्विधा होने लगी जिससे इन ग्रामों से पलायन कर लोग आस–पास के कस्बों में जाने को बाध्य हो गए। आपदाग्रस्त इस कॉलेज में स्थान की भी कमी होने के कारण कॉलेज प्रशासन द्वारा एनएचपीसी से एक ओडिटोरियम निर्माण का अनुरोध किया गया ताकि बच्चों को सामुहिक रूप से भी पढाया जा सके। कार्य के महत्व व आवश्यकता को देखते हए एनएचपीसी द्वारा ऑडिटोरियम निर्माण का कार्य किया जा रहा है। इस कार्य से जहां इस वर्ष के 154 बच्चों को लाभ होगा वहीं कार्य के जीवन पर्यन्त तक 7700 से अधिक बच्चे लाभान्वित होंगे साथ ही ग्रामों से पलायन भी रुक पाएगा। यह कार्य संबंधित क्षेत्र के सामाजिक एवं आर्थिक विकास में भी लाभकारी सिद्ध होगा। अभी तक इस कार्य में कुल 6.09 लाख रुपये की लागत आई है। कार्य अभी प्रगतिशील है और वित्त वर्ष 2020-21 में पूर्ण न होने के कारण, इसे वर्ष 2021–22 में पूरा किया जाना सुनिश्चित किया गया है । इस कार्य के लाभार्थियों का विवरण निम्न सारणी में दर्शाया गया है:--

धौलीगंगा पावर स्टेशन द्वारा भारत—तिब्बत—चीन सीमांत क्षेत्र के गांवों में चिकित्सा शिविरों का आयोजन—

तहसील धारचूला के सीमांत क्षेत्र व्यास घाटी के अत्यंत दुर्गम एवं सुदूरवर्ती ग्रामों के ग्रामीणों की स्वास्थ्य संबंधी समस्याओं को देखते हुए धौलीगंगा पावर स्टेशन की टीम द्वारा व्यास घाटी के सीमांत ग्रामों नाबी, रोंगकोंग, गर्ब्यांग एवं कुट्टी आदि के निवासियों के स्वास्थ्य लाभ हेतु चिकित्सा शिविरों का आयोजन किया गया। ये गांव भारत–तिब्बत / चीन सीमा पर व्यास घाटी में बसे भारतवर्ष के सबसे अंतिम गांव हैं और इसके आगे कोई आबादी नहीं है एवं इन गाँवों के आस–पास कोई भी चिकित्सालय या औषधि केंद्र नहीं है। कैलाश–मानसरोवर यात्रा मार्ग पर व्यास घाटी में स्थित इस अत्यंत दुर्गम एवं सीमांत क्षेत्र में निशुल्क चिकित्सा शिविरों का आयोजन किया जाना स्वयं में एक महत्वपूर्ण उपलब्धि है एवं अपने सामाजिक दायित्वों के निर्वहन के प्रति एनएचपीसी लिमिटेड की प्रतिबद्धता को दर्शाता है।

कोविड—19 के कारण उत्पन्न विषम परिस्थितियों को देखते हुए धारचूला तहसील के सुदूरवर्ती ग्रामों के ग्रामीण अपने स्वास्थ्य संबंधी समस्याओं के लिए धारचूला स्थित राजकीय चिकित्सालय तक नहीं पहुंच पा रहे हैं क्योंकि इन सुदूर ग्रामों के दुर्गम मार्गों पर वाहनों का आवागमन बर्फबारी, खराब मौसम तथा सड़कों की स्थिति ठीक नहीं होने के कारण अधिकांशतः बंद ही रहता है। इन क्षेत्रों में नेटवर्क / टेलीफोन की कोई सुविधा नहीं है एवं इन क्षेत्रों के ग्रामीण अभी भी मूलभूत आवश्यकताओं की कमी से जूझ रहे हैं।

• Emergent activities for COVID-19 & Others

Tanakpur Power Station has responded proactively to reach out to the local residents of nearby villages

during COVID pandemic. Power Station has successfully conducted the awareness program to sensitize the villagers and distributed necessary medical items to fight against Covid-19. During FY 2020-21, Rs. 1.50 lakhs were spent by the Power Station for conducting the awareness programs alongwith distribution of essential medical items.

HEALTH & SANITATION

With the help of Project, total 05 nos. of Medical camps were organized in the far- flung areas of Power Station which includes village Thapliyal Kheda (On the border of Nepal and Tanakpur), Fagpur, Canal Colony, **Aganwadi Kendra** and Meena Bazar. During these camps, Mask, Sanitizers & immunity boosters were provided to frontline workers and volunteers, School children and villagers to fight against COVID -19 pandemic. About 850 no. of beneficiaries have taken the advantage of this initiative.

In addition to this, Tanakpur Power Station has also organized two Free Medical Camps and one Blood Donation Camp on dated: 19.01.2021, 30.03.2021 and 07.11.2020 respectively. Free Medical Camps were organized at Govt Primary School, Cinigote and at Thapiyal Kheda village. Total 45 blood donors participated in the blood donation camp organized at Tanakpur Power Station.



EDUCATION

To strengthen the educational facilities in and around project location, Kendriya Vidyalay no. 2, Banbasa under the Tanakpur Power Station plays a vital role in education field. During FY 2020-21, 559 no. of children have been enrolled wherein 79% students belong to local areas and 21% were of NHPC dependent. Power Station made substantial expenditure on this school to provide quality education particularly to children of local residents.




• Financial support to Anushruti Academy for the Deaf (AAD), IIT Roorkee for Improving the Drawing & Painting Lab.

Anushruti Academy for the Deaf (AAD), a social initiative of IIT Roorkee, is a special school for educating DEAF children of Roorkee and nearby area. Roorkee School for the Deaf now known as Anushruti Academy for the Deaf (AAD), was established on the campus of the then University of Roorkee (now IIT Roorkee) in 1989. This is the only school for the disabled children which exists in the campus of this High-Tech institute. The prime objective of this school is to educate the deaf children so as make them self reliant. NHPC under its CSR initiative has provided a financial assistance of Rs. 5.80 Lakhs to support and improve the drawing and painting lab of the school.

• CSR support on collaborative mode for Providing Bus service for movement of Disabled students from outer rural areas to Hansraj College, University of Delhi.

Hansraj College is a constituent college of the University of Delhi. It has made significant and unparalleled contribution to Society in terms of producing numerous dignitaries' scholars, intellectuals and sports persons who served different domains not only in our own country but even at international levels.

To facilitate the transport needs and to provide easy and safe travel to the students with physical disabilities, NHPC under its CSR inititive has provided a support of Rs. 10.0 lac to purchase the bus to Hansraj College on collaborative mode for movement of Disabled students from outer rural areas to College. The students with physical disabilities residing within a radius of 5 to 20 km of Hansraj College are directly benefitted and ease of their mobility has also improved.



During FY 2020-21, under this activity an expenditure of Rs. 9.0 lakhs was incurred to procure the bus.

• Providing 10 nos. of Industrial Sewing machines to Shirdi Sai Baba Temple Society, Faridabad:

Shirdi Sai Baba Temple Society is primarily engaged in Socio-economic upliftment of the needy section of the society through its various social welfare activities. To augment their social works for needy people, NHPC has joined hands with the Sai Baba Society and provided a fund of Rs. 2,03,840/- under its CSR support. The funds were provided for the purchase of 10 no. Industrial Sewing machines under Skill Development programme to Shirdi Sai Baba Temple Society, Faridabad. These Industrial Sewing machines have been provided to girls hailing from poorer sections of the community, who often discontinued their studies at the school level. These sewing machines shall boost the vocational training programs of the society that requires little effort and less education.

With the support of these sewing machines, vocational trainings programs like tailoring, industrial sewing, dress designing, beauty culture, hospitality etc. can be imparted so as to make them self-reliant. Thus, empowerment of girls will not only improve their socio-economic wellbeing but of their families too.


