# United States and Nato main threats to Russia, says Putin

St Petersburg, Russia, July 31

**PRESIDENT VLADIMIR PUTIN** on Sunday signed a new naval doctrine which sets out the United States and NATO as the main threats to Russia's maritime ambitions for the Arctic and in the Black Sea.

Speaking on Russia's Navy Day in the former imperial capital of St Petersburg founded by Tsar Peter the Great, Putin praised Peter for making Russia a great sea power and increasing the global standing of the Russian state.

After inspecting the navy, Putin made a short speech in which he promised that what he touted as Russia's unique Zircon hypersonic cruise missiles, cautioning that Russia had the military clout to defeat any potential aggressors.

Shortly before the speech, he signed a new 55-page naval doctrine, which sets out the broad strategic aims of Russia's navy, including its ambitions as a "great maritime power" which extend over the entire world.

The main threat to Russia, the doctrine says, is "the strategic policy of the USA to dominate the world's oceans" and

the movement of the Nato military alliance closer towards Russia's borders.

Russia may use its military force appropriately to the situation in the world's oceans should other soft powers, such as diplomatic and economic tools, be exhausted, the doc-

trine says. Putin did not mention the conflict in Ukraine during his speech but the military doctrine envisages a "comprehensive strengthening of Russia's geopolitical position" in the Black and Azov seas.

It also set out the Arctic Ocean, which the United States has repeatedly said Russia is trying to militarise, as an area of particular importance for Russia.

Russia's vast 37,650 km (23,400 mile) coastline, which stretches from the Sea of Japan to the White Sea, also includes the Black Sea and the Caspian Sea.

Putin said the delivery of Zircon hypersonic cruise missiles to the Admiral Gorskoy frigate would begin within months. The location of their deployment would depend on Russian interests, he said.

"The key thing here is the capability of the Russian navy... It is able to respond with lightning speed to all who decides to infringe on our sovereignty and freedom."

Hypersonic weapons can travel at nine times the speed of sound, and Russia has conducted previous test launches of the Zircon from warships and submarines over the past year.

In Crimea, Sevastopol governor Mikhail Razvozhayev said Ukrainian forces struck the headquarters of Russia's Black Sea Fleet in the Russian-held port city early on Sunday, wounding five members of staff.

**DEUTSCHE LUFTHANSA** may face further disruption after its pilots voted for strikes if they're considered necessary to force a wage deal, a move that could unleash another wave of cancellations unless the airline's negotiators and labour representatives can settle their differences.

The VC pilot's union voted overwhelmingly on Sunday in favour of walkouts, meaning Lufthansa could be hit with stoppages as soon as next month. Strikes would trigger additional cancellations on top of the 7,000 flights the company has scratched this summer due to staffing shortages.

"This positive ballot does not yet necessarily lead to strike action," the union said in an emailed statement. "But it is an unmistakable signal to Lufthansa to take the needs of cockpit staff seriously."

A Lufthansa spokesperson said by email that the company respects the vote result and is continuing to rely on "constructive discussions" in order to resolve the conflict. Further talks with VChA have been arranged, the spokesperson said, declining to specify when they will take place.

Pilot strikes at Europe's biggest airline would add to a summer of chaos across the continent, as Lufthansa struggled to accommodate a surge in bookings compared with the pandemic-induced slowdown.

# Lufthansa faces more turmoil as pilots back possible strikes

Having initially avoided walkouts that have plagued rivals like Ryanair Holdings, Lufthansa's management is facing action from its various labour unions. The carrier last week cancelled around 1,000 flights at its Frankfurt and Munich hubs due to industrial action by ground staff. "We need a modern and fair, internationally competitive remuneration structure," Marcel Groels, the VC's chief negotiator, said Sunday by email. "In the interest of our passengers, and, too, Lufthansa must show a serious willingness to find solutions."

# Racism not a factor in British PM race, says Rishi Sunak

**FORMER CHANCELLOR** Rishi Sunak said on Sunday that racism is not a factor in the Conservative Party membership's decision to vote for the next party leader and successor of Boris Johnson as British Prime Minister.

The finalist in the race to 10 Downing Street who is trailing his opponent, Foreign Secretary Liz Truss, in surveys during the leadership election campaign set to conclude on September 5, dismissed factors such as gender or ethnicity would play a part in Tory members' postal ballots from next week.

It followed an Indian-origin businessman and Conservative Party donor, Lord Rami Rangan, saying in a video last week that Britain would be seen as racist if Sunak goes on to lose the Tory leadership poll.

"I absolutely don't think that's a factor in anyone's decision. I just don't think that's right," Sunak told *"The Daily Telegraph"* in an interview.

"I was elected as a member of Parliament in Richmond. Our members rightly put merit above everything else. I'm sure that they are considering this

Culture secretary Nadine Dorries reposted a tweet on her social media account showing an image of Johnson dressed as Roman Emperor Julius Caesar and Sunak stabbing him in the back, a reference to his killer Brutus.

# China factory activity sees shock contraction

**CHINA'S FACTORY ACTIVITY** unexpectedly contracted in July, reversing earlier economic momentum as sporadic Covid outbreaks weigh on the recovery.

The official manufacturing purchasing managers index fell to 49 from 50.2 in June, the National Bureau of Statistics said Sunday.

Economists had expected a reading of 50.3, according to the median estimate in a July survey of economists. A reading above 50 indicates expansion from the previous month, while anything below indicates contraction.
