

As on March 2017

- Company has registered a net profit at Rs.214.69 crore for the third quarter of the current fiscal thereby registering a growth of 25.87 % over Rs. 170.57 crore for the corresponding period in the last fiscal year. Net profit upto third quarter at Rs. 2627.17 crore also rose up by 20.27 % as compared to Rs. 2184.41 crore for the corresponding period in the last fiscal year.
