

Highlights of March 2020

- NHPC continues uninterrupted power supply and is ensuring that operations continue 24X7, in the wake of the threat posed by pandemic COVID-19.
- NHPC has contributed Rs.40 crore towards PM CARES Fund from its CSR budget.
- NHPC has paid an interim dividend of Rs. 840.96 crore to Govt. of India for the FY 2019-20.
- NHPC has surpassed previous highest generation of 24193 MUs achieved during FY 2018-19 with generation of more than excellent MoU Generation Target (26000 MU) in FY 2019-20.
- During 2019-20, 13 power stations Salal, Chamara-I, Uri-I, Uri-II, TLD-III, TLD-IV, Dhauliganga, Tanakpur, Sewa-II, Teesta-V, Nimoo Bazgo, Chutak & Kishanganga have achieved their highest ever annual generation since commissioning.
- Remote Controlled Operation of TLD-III PS and TLD-IV PS from Regional Office, Siliguri has been successfully achieved.
- The Major Contract package of Lot-2 and Lot-1 of 500 MW Teesta-VI H.E. Project was awarded on 15.03.2020 and 31.03.2020 respectively in a record time.
