INTRODUCTION

With the introduction of Companies Act 2013, the focus has been on taking employees, customers, and communities at large along the road to sustainable development. Leading the way, in this stakeholder’s era are the CPSEs with NHPC playing a key role in securing the interests of stakeholders.

The “mandatory” directive regarding CSR is meant for profit-making CPSEs but even loss making ones are continuing with CSR activity which is a reflection of how much CSR has become a part of the philosophy of CPSEs.

This Annual Report puts the spotlight on kaleidoscope of programmes conducted under CSR activities in NHPC during the year 2014-15 while discharging its role with due diligence.

Corporate Social Responsibility at NHPC

- NHPC is continually striving for sustainable development of its neighbouring communities and society at large.
- Since its inception, NHPC has focused on inclusive growth and assisted the local population in the vicinity of its Projects/ Power Stations/ Offices.

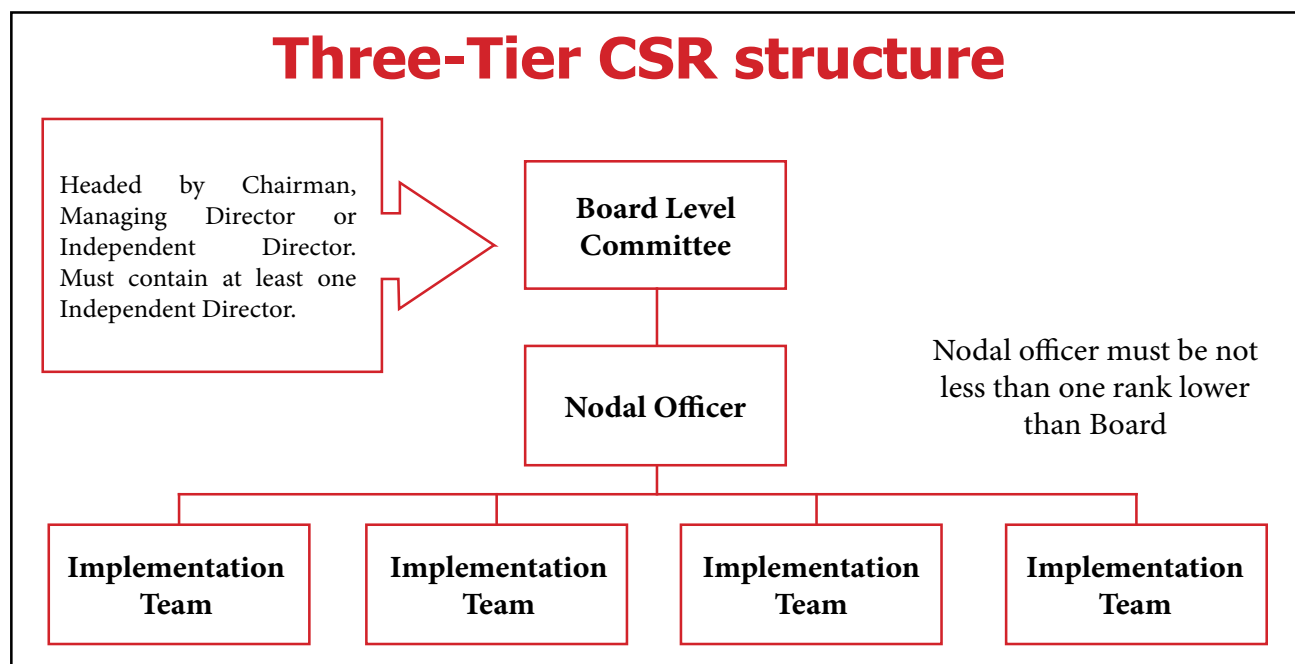
Main Objectives of NHPC's CSR-Sustainability Policy

SECTORS COVERED UNDER CSR & SUSTAINABILITY DURING 2014-15

The Projects/Power Stations/Units of NHPC are located in extreme remote locations all over India under varying socio-economic condition. The CSR activities and programs are identified and formulated based on the specific needs and requirement of the particular locality after proper consultation with local people and authorised

representatives of the people in the vicinity of the Projects/Power Stations. NHPC has conducted CSR & Sustainability activities in following major sectors.

Education & Skill Development

To upgrade the level of the education and skill of the people by way of organising skill development programs, vocational trainings,



livelihood training programs, adoption of ITI, Construction of Engineering College, Computer trainings, providing scholarships to SC/ST/Girl students including poor and meritorious students and to facilitate the students by providing study materials like school bags, books, stationery items, Providing furniture, drinking water facility and other items to Govt. schools.

Success Stories:- Education

- Promotion of technical education through 13 nos of ITIs adopted by NHPC in states of J&K, Uttarakhand, Arunachal Pradesh by upgradation of classrooms and other infrastructure, advanced training to faculties and distribution of scholarships to the students.
- Construction of Vivekananda Kendra Vidyalaya academic building and residential complex at Kolaputkar, Assam and Construction of new Kendriya Vidyalaya building at Loktak, Manipur. In addition construction of additional school buildings / number of classrooms has also been made.
- Establishment of computer training centers/ providing computers and other peripherals, development of library and digital classroom at Govt. Higher Secondary school, Leh to facilitate/ improve the quality of education in surrounding areas.

- Scholarships under “NHPC Scholarship Award Scheme” to the students and provision of books, stationery & uniform for school children from economically weaker sections of the society for promotion of literacy.

Success Stories:- Skill Development

- Training to about 1300 students in the 13 Industrial Training Institutes (ITI) at various locations, in partnership with the Central and State Governments.
- Establishment of sample farming centre in various locations of Arunachal Pradesh/ Assam for farming of “Bhoot Jhalokia”
- Two months training programme on Graphic Design for 30 unemployed youth of Arunachal Pradesh for Skill Development/ Upgradation. Construction of Skill Development Centre for capacity building at Subansiri Lower Project, Gerukamukh, Assam.
- Training programme for farmers in organic farming and instrumentation support in Sikkim.
- Imparting training to 200 members of registered youth society of Alchi & Khamtsi village, Leh on food processing covering all aspects to operate and manage the food processing center.
- Training programme for local youth on driving/ rafting in Kargil for skill development & livelihood.

Health & Sanitation

To improve overall health and sanitation facilities in the locality through conducting the health surveys, identification of health concerns, awareness campaigns, programs on malnutrition, and awareness programs on adolescence for girls,

organizing regular immunization programs, Eye camps including free Cataract Surgery Camps, Providing assistance for improvement of infrastructure of Govt Hospitals as Ambulances, DG Sets, Medical equipment etc. Providing of toilets, drains in local community as well as in schools for improvement of sanitation facilities

Success Stories:- Health & Sanitation

- **Health camps and distribution of free medical appurtenances**

An important feature of NHPC's healthcare initiatives is organizing health camps in rural areas and urban villages as a part of its commitment towards a healthy India. Free medical health check-up camps were organized at number of locations near our projects/ power stations/ offices for the general public, especially women, the elderly and school children. In addition construction of Medical Inspection room at JNV school Leh (J&K)/ renovation works at hospital building Dalhousie (H.P) were taken up. Four Districts in Subansiri area in Arunachal Pradesh were made cleft free through “Operation Smile.”

- **Supply of medical equipments to hospitals**

In order to augment the existing capacity of Government hospitals, medical equipment has been provided to hospitals located in remote areas, for example:

- X-Ray machine in Govt. hospital Bani, Distt. Kathua (J&K)
- Boyles Apparatus in Nubra Valley Govt. Hospital.
- Digital X-ray, ECG machine, CR system at BBS, Regional Hospital, Kullu (H.P)
- Upgradation of maternity & OPD cell of District hospital, Singtam (Sikkim)

- Construction of toilet blocks

Sanitized toilet blocks in schools not only improve hygiene but also lower the drop-out rates, especially of girls. Toilets have been constructed in the following locations:

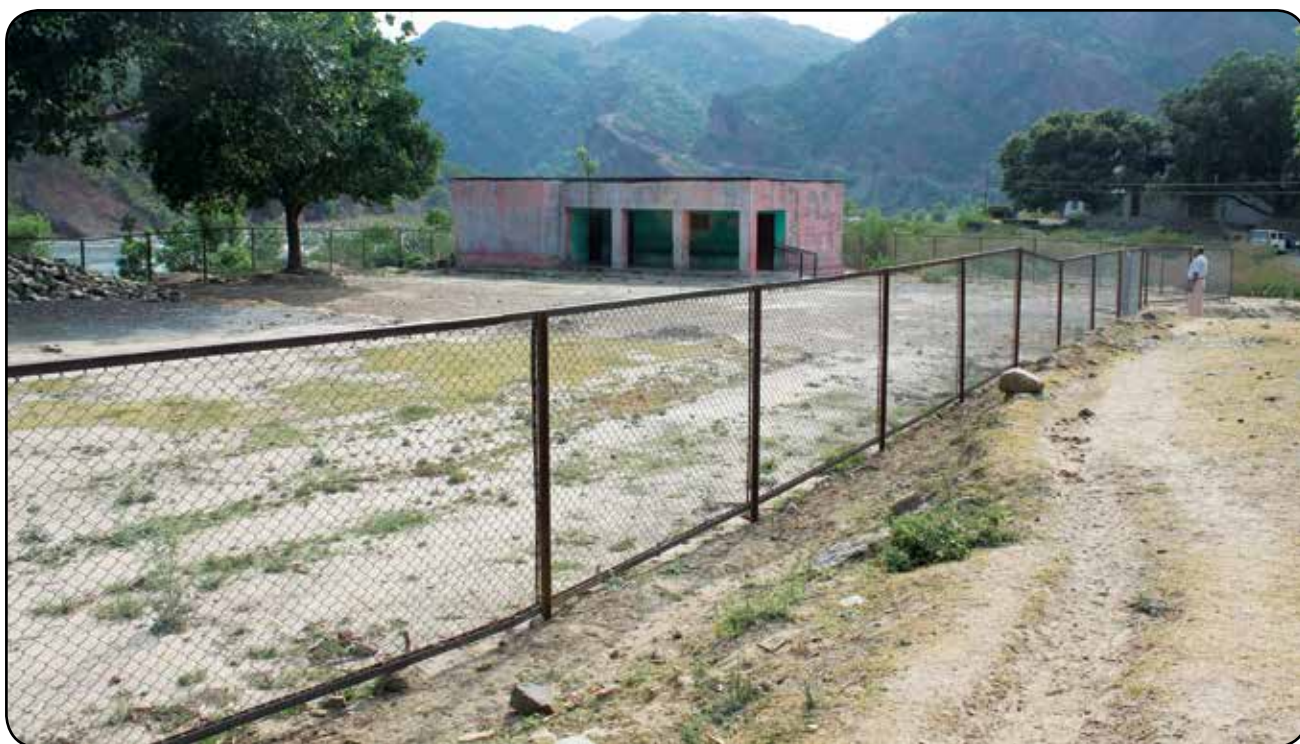
- Construction of toilet blocks at city middle school, Kishtwar (J&K)
- Construction of toilet at maternity center in Dachi village (J&K)
- Construction of toilet at village Danunu (H.P)
- Construction of toilet block at Gracy Christian School and at Charoikhullen in Manipur.
- Construction of toilet block at village New Anaya & at Lumla (Arunachal Pradesh)
- Construction of drains

To improve the sanitation facilities nearby its projects/ power stations/ offices NHPC has constructed drains for local community as well as in schools for improvement of sanitation facilities:

- Construction of drain from Bagrakote Chunabhati to Leesh river dam/ Kalijhora village in Darjeeling District(W.B)
- Construction of drain slab culvert & drain at Charoi Kuman/ New Kungpi naosen/ Kha Potshangbam/ Lower and Upper Komkeriap/ Kokdam & at Aimol village in Manipur.

- Construction of drain at Gati village, District Khatua (J&K)
- Rural Development:

To improve basic infrastructure facilities works related to Rural Electrification, Construction of Community Centres and Drains and Provision of Drinking water facilities, Providing of Roads connectivity and Up-gradation of libraries etc. were taken up and executed as per the need and requirement of locals.

Success Stories:- Rural Development

- Establishment of 02 Food Processing Centres at Alchi, Leh through District Administration & Youth Society of Alchi & Khaltsi village and handing over of units to
- Construction of cold storage for keeping and securing the agri-products at Kamiray village, East Sikkim.
- Construction of RCC bridge of 6.00m span in the village Manha in District Sant-Kabir Nagar (UP)
- 'Jal Hi Jiwan' a scheme to combat water scarcity and to fulfill the water requirement of the villages. NHPC under the scheme had made arrangement of drinking water supply

the society thereby providing livelihood to nearly 1000 local people besides preventing wastage of 200 tons of apricot and apples. Apart from these, centers are also being used to process sea-buckthorn, tomatoes, carrot and other vegetables.

line for Bor Jhora to Sanu Makum, Borboty & Jarayotar village in Darjeeling District and Rangrang village, in Sikkim benefiting 1700 households in these villages.

- Water supply scheme to provide filtered & perennial water by gravity driven method in Sadwania/ Darkote/ Kalgai/ kargil/ Leh in J&K/ Aimol Louchabung village in Manipur/ Kolaputkar Dollungmukh Arunachal Pradesh wherein small check dams are constructed across natural streams or springs to collect water for storage in filter tanks. Thereafter the filtered water is connected to a ground level service reservoir with tap points.
- Providing of 06 transformers of 1000/ 500 KVA to State PDD, J&K for augmentation of stable power supply in Leh District keeping in view the electricity requirement of the

local population, benefiting around 35% household in the District.

- To mitigate the hardship of the local community and to improve the quality of life and socio-economic conditions of the area, NHPC has undertaken rural electrification works in J&K/ construction of community centres, approach roads / bridges/ link roads for improving accessibility between villages in surrounding areas of its projects/ power station/ office benefiting around 5000 people.

Environment & Sustainability

To Protect and improve the environment an Impact assessment study to quantify reduction in carbon footprint was conducted. Implementation of measures including distribution and installation of Solar Lanterns, Solar Street Light



Poles, voluntary afforestation by planting Saplings, Rain water Harvesting and development of Bio-Diversity Parks/ Eco- Parks etc.

Success Stories:- Environment

- Installation & commissioning of 686 LED Solar Street Lights in Siddhartha Nagar (UP)
- Installation & commissioning of 200 LED Solar Street system at various locations in Faridabad.
- NHPC has also installed Solar Street Lights in NHPCs office/ residential complex in order to conserve electricity to quantify reduction in carbon footprint.
- Vigorous afforestation has been an ongoing programme of the company. Green belts have been created in and around NHPCs

projects/ power station/ offices.

- Creation of Biodiversity Park & Plant Repository for conservation and propagation of species, creation of water bodies, Nature trail, plantation, observatory, watchtowers and Ethnic huts etc. at Subansiri Lower Project, in Assam / Arunachal Pradesh.

Women Empowerment and Senior Citizen:

To provide employment oriented training, soft skill training to women including training on cutting and tailoring, soft toy making, food processing like Pickle and Jams and providing assistance to earn their livelihood by providing sewing machines. Special focus on health of women and senior citizen and providing assistance to Old Age Homes.

Success Stories:- Women Empowerment

It is said that “**educating a woman means educating a family**” hence empowering a woman tantamounts to empowering a family. It is in this context that women Empowerment programmes targeting adolescent girls and women have been implemented in many of the projects/ power stations/ office locations in the states of West Bengal/ Uttarakhand/ Chandigarh/ Manipur/ Himachal/ J&K wherein training by master trainers through different modules involving soft and hard skills are provided. The training modules include Knitting & sewing, food processing, beautician, tailoring, soft toys, bag making etc.

Sports

Promotion of local sports by organizing of local tournaments and local sports, providing sports items to the players of the locality and providing sports items/kits for school children in Govt. schools. Training for sports like rafting training, Rifle training etc.

Success Stories:- Sports

NHPC has been promoting sports in rural areas & has been encouraging local talent by developing sports infrastructure, play grounds and conducting various sports events and tournaments at many of its locations.

- Training is provided by specialized coaches

Capacity Building & Other Initiatives

To conduct various awareness programs, training programs, meetings with key stakeholders to facilitate and train the people in and around the Power Stations in self-employment through co-operatives / self-help groups. Organising and arranging various training programs on CSR & Sustainability through prestigious institutions. In addition to this NHPC has also contributed to the victims of natural disasters in Kashmir Valley and Uttarakhand, NHPC is also committed towards the preservation of monuments of National as well as Regional importance in the vicinity of the Power Stations/Projects/Units.

Swachh Vidyalaya Abhiyan

In response to the clarion call given by Prime Minister in his Independence Day speech last year, NHPC Ltd, the largest hydro power utility in India, has constructed 7045 toilets against the target of 6802 toilets committed by NHPC to MoP/MHRD in schools spread across 34 districts in 08 States nearby its projects/ power stations/ units which are mostly in extremely difficult and remotely accessible locations in the Himalayan belt. NHPC achieved the timely completion of 7045 toilets under Swachh Vidyalaya Abhiyan. In North Eastern states namely Assam, Arunachal Pradesh and Manipur, 3182 toilets have been constructed in government schools. Dedicated teams of more than 300 officials from various departments within NHPC were associated and instrumental in accomplishing this herculean task. State and Districts covered are as under:

Scholarship distribution programme - Dibang Multipurpose Project

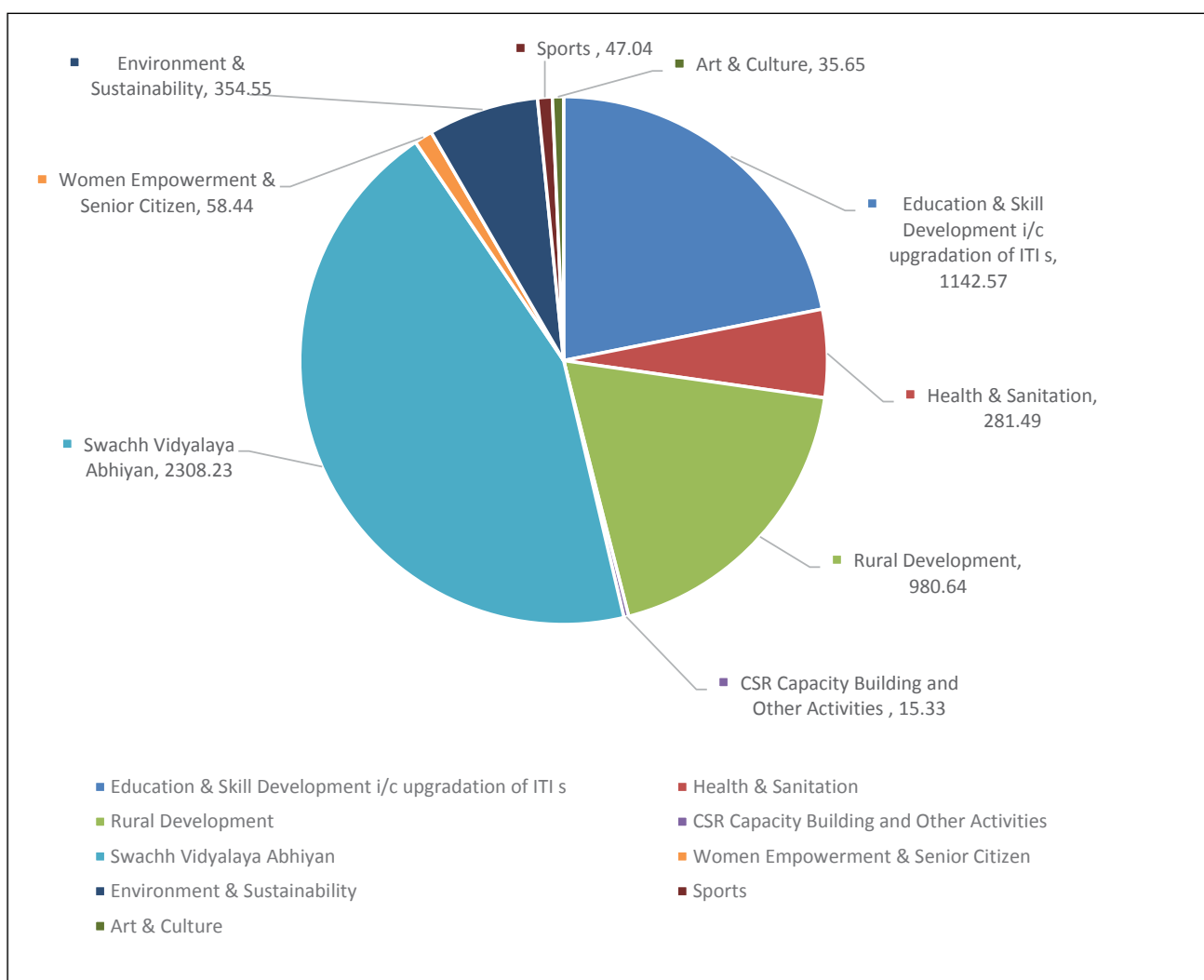

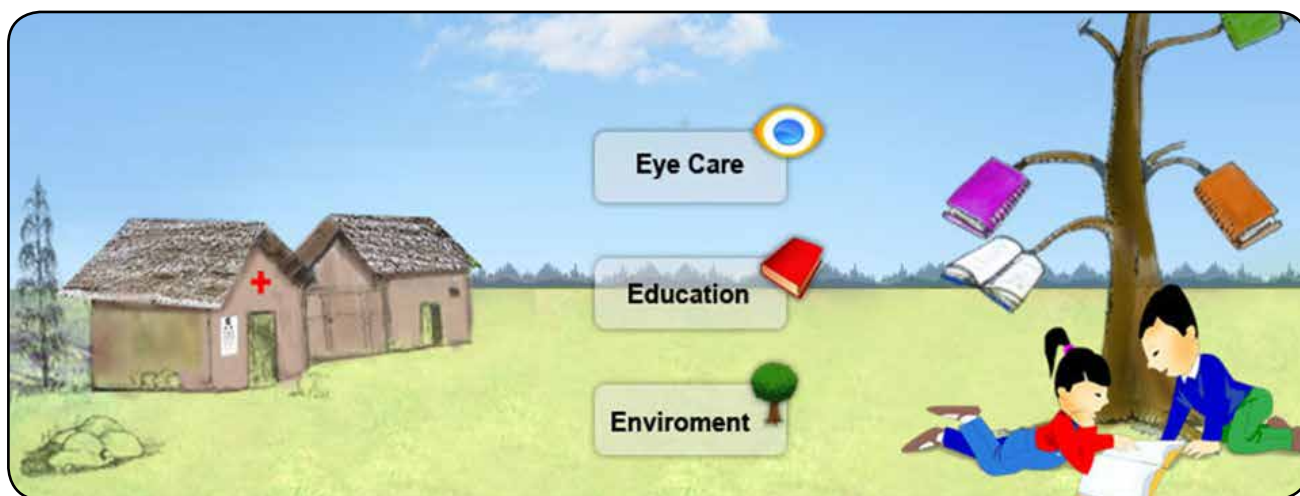


Distribution of saplings - Tanakpur Power Station

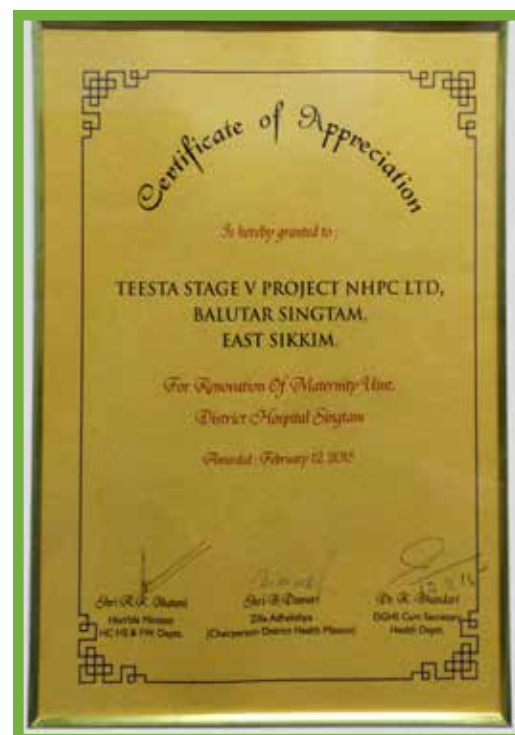
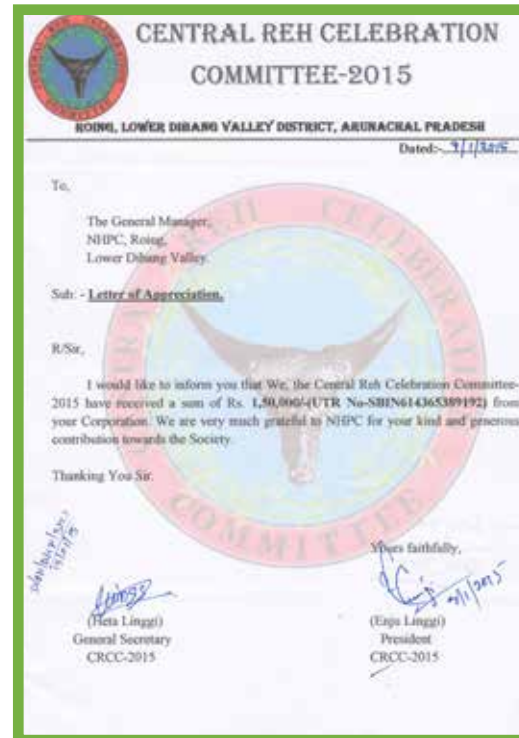
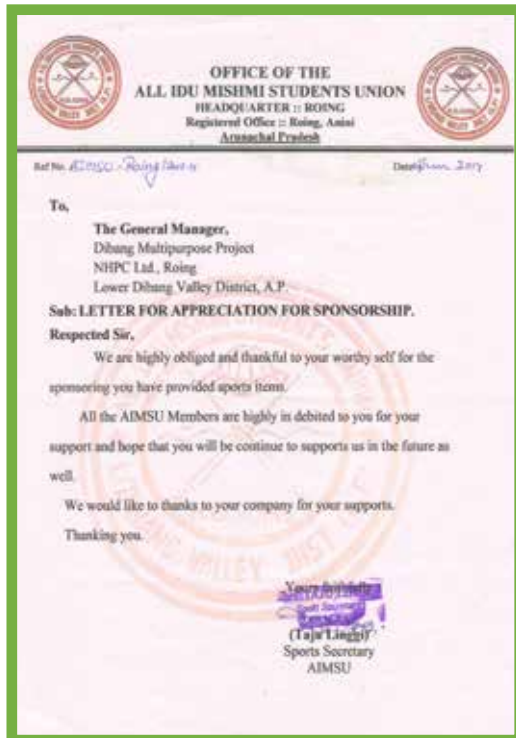
