INTRODUCTION

NHPC Limited is the largest hydropower development organization in India, with capabilities to undertake all the activities from conceptualization to commissioning of hydro projects. NHPC has also diversified in the field of Solar & Wind energy development etc.

As on date NHPC's total installed capacity is 7097.20 MW including 1546 MW in Joint Venture, comprising 6971.20 MW from 22 Hydro Power Stations, 76 MW from two Solar Power Project and 50 MW from a Wind Power Project.

NHPC including its JVs/ Subsidiaries is presently engaged in the construction of 16 projects aggregating to a total installed capacity of 10489 MW, which includes three hydroelectric projects i.e. Subansiri Lower HEP (2000 MW) & Dibang Multipurpose Project (2880 MW) in Arunachal Pradesh and Parbati-II HEP (800 MW) in Himachal Pradesh and four Solar Projects, one of 40 MW in Odisha and three solar projects totaling 1000 MW being undertaken under MNRE, CPSU scheme in Gujarat(600 MW), Rajasthan(300 MW) & Andhra Pradesh(100MW) by NHPC, whereas six Hydroelectric projects and three Solar projects are being executed by Subsidiaries / JV Companies of NHPC namely Pakal Dul HE Project (1000 MW), Kiru HE Project (624 MW) & Kwar HE Project (540 MW) in UT of J&K by CVPPL, Ratle HE Project (850 MW) in UT of J&K by RHPCL, Teesta-VI HE Project (500 MW) in Sikkim by LTHPL, Rangit-IV HE Project (120 MW) in Sikkim by JPCL, 88 MW Floating solar PV project in the Reservoir of Omkareshwar Project & 8 MW Sanchi solar PV plant in M.P by NHDC and Kalpi Solar Project (26 MW out of 65 MW is under operation and 39 MW is under construction) in UP by BSUL.

In addition, Eight projects aggregating to a total installed capacity of 4297 MW are Under Clearance Stage which includes three hydro & 2 solar projects by NHPC on its own and three projects (2 in hydro & 1 in solar) in JV mode. Further, three Hydroelectric projects aggregating to a total installed capacity of 1130 MW are in Survey & Investigation Stage being undertaken by NHPC.

SELECTION OF CSR ACTIVITIES

- The proposals received are compiled and further scrutinized in accordance with Schedule-VII of Companies Act, 2013 as well as the availability of funds.
- The proposals are initially evaluated by the internal CSR Committee of CSR & SD Division and further by GM Level committee and then recommended for consideration of the Committee of Directors on CSR & Sustainability. The CoD on CSR & SD recommends the CSR proposal to the Board of Directors for approval.
- Selection is done solely on the merit of proposals.



MONITORING AND EVALUATION OF CSR ACTIVITIES

- Institutional arrangement exists for Implementation, Monitoring and Evaluation of the CSR & Sustainability activities of the corporation.
- The 03 tier Management structure for Implementation, Monitoring and Evaluating the progress of CSR schemes/ activities in NHPC are as under:
 - i) The Board level Committee on CSR headed by an Independent Director
 - ii) Nodal Officer of the Rank of Executive Director assisted by his team
 - iii) Regional ED/ Project Head/ Unit Head and his team for implementation and monitoring
- The progress of CSR & Sustainability schemes under implementation at each of the location is being reported by the Unit Head to Nodal Officer at Corporate Office, on monthly basis.
- Records are being maintained along with photographs/ videos to show progress of works.

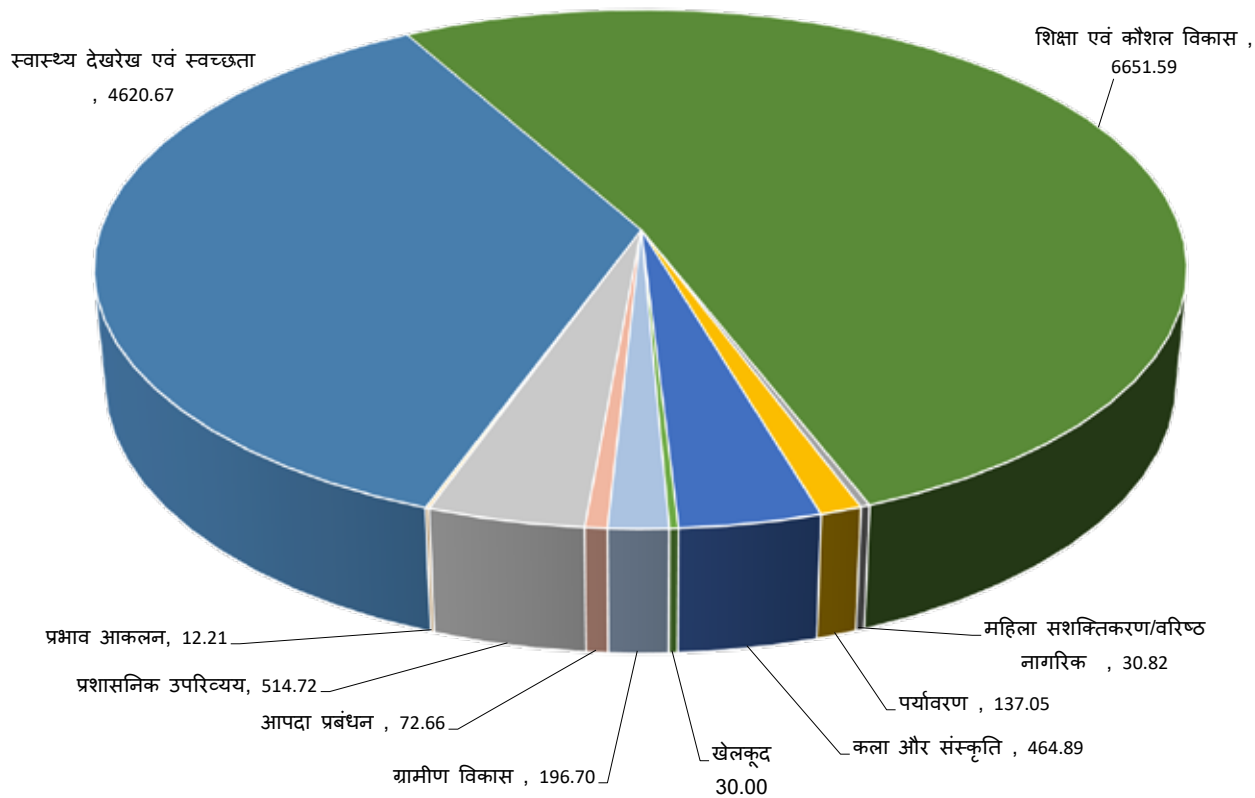

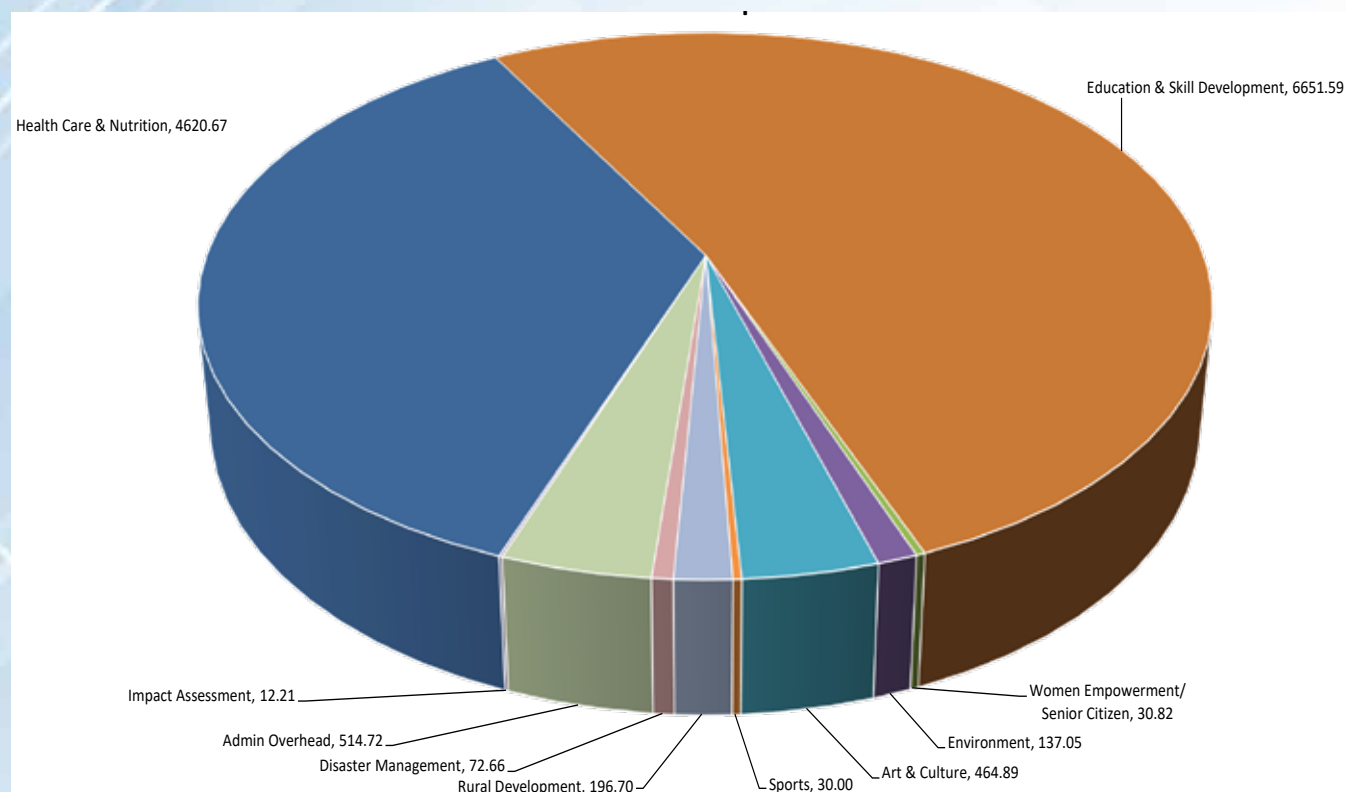

Approximately 1030 villagers got benefitted. Apart from that a quarantine centre was also established at this Power Station as per the direction of the District Administration and many patients were kept in this centre. They were also provided food and other facilities free of cost. Though district administration has de-notified the covid care centre at BSPS, like previous year Project hospital is taking care of post covid complications patients.
