

Performance Highlights: April 2023

1. Shri R. K. Vishnoi, CMD, NHPC and Shri Y.K. Chaubey, Director (Technical) met Rt. Hon'ble Prime Minister of Nepal, Shri Pushpa Kamal Dahal 'Prachanda'. NHPC delegation also had interactions with Hon'ble Minister of Energy, Water Resources and Irrigation Shri Shakti Bahadur Basnet, Hon'ble Minister of Finance Dr. Prakash Sharan Mahat, Hon'ble Minister of Foreign Affairs Shri Narayan Prakash Saud, Chief Secretary Shri Shanker Das Bairagi and other senior government officials of Nepal at Kathmandu on 19th April 2023 and apprised them about NHPC's initiatives in Nepal with request for greater opportunities for NHPC in Nepal in the future.
2. CMD, NHPC addressed the plenary session of the Power Summit'23, organized by Independent Power Producers' Association, Nepal (IPPAN) on 19th April 2023 at Kathmandu, Nepal and highlighted upon the critical role of hydropower for overall economic development and emphasized on the need to develop hydropower projects to meet the energy demand.
3. CMD, NHPC Visited Gujarat from 17th to 18th April 2023 wherein he met Shri Raj Kumar, Chief Secretary, Gujarat on 18th April 2023 at Gandhinagar and apprised him about establishment of Renewable Energy & Green Hydrogen (RE&GH) Division of NHPC at Ahmedabad. During the meeting, he expressed NHPC's interest in taking up the development of Pump Storage Projects in Gujarat. The Chief Secretary appreciated the efforts made by NHPC in Power Sector and welcomed NHPC's presence in Gujarat and assured all possible support to NHPC.
4. Parbati-II HE Project (800 MW) has achieved a major milestone towards full commissioning of Powerhouse with restoration of Unit#3 and Unit#4 on 03.03.2023 and on 21.04.2023 respectively.
5. Teesta-VI HE Project (500 MW) has achieved a cumulative heading excavation of 4Km in Head Race Tunnels on 22.04.2023. The progress has been made overcoming adverse geological conditions encountered in the twin tunnels.
6. Shri R. K. Vishnoi, CMD, NHPC alongwith Shri. Y. K Choubey, Director (Technical), presented a cheque of Rs. 2 Crore to Shri Pushkar Singh Dhami, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Uttarakhand on 12th April 2023 at Dehradun as contribution towards Chief Minister Relief Fund for Joshimath crisis. All the selected candidates virtually attended the event wherein Hon'ble Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi addressed the new recruits.
8. NHPC organized a special programme to commemorate the 132nd birth anniversary of Bharat Ratna Babasaheb Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar at its Corporate Office, Faridabad on 17th April, 2023. Dr. (Prof.) Kirit Premjibhai Solanki, Hon'ble Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha) and Chairman, Parliamentary Committee on Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, graced the occasion as Chief Guest.
9. In a major step towards venturing into Green Hydrogen business, NHPC has awarded the work to develop Grid-connected Green Hydrogen Fuel Cell based 25 kW Microgrid Pilot Project at Nimmo Bazgo Power Station (UT of Ladakh) to M/s Uneecops Technologies Limited.

10. Miss Reetika, an NHPC Elite Sports Scholarship awardee won the Bronze Medal at the Asian Senior Wrestling Championship 2023 (72 kg category) in Astana, Kazakhstan on 12th April 2023.
11. Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh in association with NHPC organized 3rd awareness trip for 29 villagers from Siang Upper Multipurpose Project area of Siang and Upper Siang districts of Arunachal Pradesh from 18th to 25th April 2023. The participants visited Omkareshwar Power Station (520 MW) & Indira Sagar Power Station (1000 MW) of NHDC and Tehri Hydro Power Plant (1000 MW) & Koteshwar HE Project (400 MW) of THDC India Ltd. to witness engineering marvels and their Rehabilitation & Resettlement (R&R) initiatives.

13. The total cumulative generation of all NHPC Power Stations stood at 1882.6 MUs at the end of April 2023.

Performance Highlights: May 2023

1. For the FY 2022-23, NHPC has achieved a Profit After Tax (PAT) of Rs. 3834 Crore on standalone basis compared to Rs. 3538 Crore in last financial year, an increase of 8%.
2. NHPC's Board of Directors have recommended final dividend of Rs 0.45 per equity share for Financial Year 2022-23 in addition to interim dividend of Rs 1.40 per share already declared. Accordingly, total dividend for FY 2022-23 is Rs 1.85 per share.
3. Hon'ble Minister of State for Power and Heavy Industries Shri Krishan Pal Gurjar visited 2000 MW Subansiri Lower HE Project on 11th and 12th May 2023. During the visit, the Hon'ble Minister alongwith Hon'ble MLA, Likabali (Arunachal Pradesh), Shri Kardo Nyigyor inaugurated the 400KV Pothead Yard of Subansiri Lower HEP on 12th May 2023. Hon'ble Minister also held a review meeting of the project wherein he appreciated NHPC's efforts and highlighted the need for development of Renewable energy for country's growth.
4. Power Purchase Agreement was signed on 2nd May 2023 by NHPC, Lanco Teesta Hydro Power Limited (LTHPL) and Jal Power Corporation Limited (JPCL) with Gujarat Urja Vidyut Nigam Limited (GUVNL) at Vadodra, Gujarat for off take of power generated from 2880 MW Dibang Multipurpose Project, 500 MW Dugar HEP, 500 MW Teesta VI HEP and 120 MW Rangit IV for a period of 40 years from COD. Quantum of power to be supplied shall be as per power allocation order of MoP.
5. Shri Biswajit Basu, Director (Projects), Shri Uday Sakharam Nirgudkar, Independent Director, NHPC along with other senior NHPC officers met Shri Deepak Kapoor (IAS), Addl. Chief Secretary, Water Resource Dept., and Smt. Abha Shukla (IAS), Principal Secretary (Energy), Govt. of Maharashtra at Mumbai on 2nd May 2023. During the meeting, the developments of Pumped Storage and Floating Solar PV Projects in Maharashtra with aggregate capacity of 4000 MW were discussed.
6. Gujarat Urja Vikas Nigam Ltd (GUVNL) has issued a Letter of Intent to NHPC for 200 MW capacity Solar Power Project on 16th May 2023. The project will be located within Gujarat State Electricity Corporation Limited's (GSECL) Solar Park in Khavda (GSECL Stage-1).
7. Some major landmarks have been achieved at NHPC construction Projects. Overt Concrete Lining of all 08 Nos. Head Race Tunnels of 2000 MW Subansiri Lower HEP has been completed on 27th May 2023. At 120 MW Rangit-IV HEP, the

- Concreting up to Dam top i.e. EL 471m of Right bank Non Overflow block no.7 has been achieved on 18th May 2023. Further, Excavation of Transformer cavern of 624 MW Kiru HE Project completed on 12th May 2023.
8. The Hon'ble 2nd Sub Committee of Parliament on Official Language inspected the official language works of NHPC's Tanakpur Power Station on 25th May 2023 in Dehradun in CMD, NHPC presence alongwith senior officials from MOP and NHPC.  14. Shri Biswajit Basu, Director (Projects) during his visit to Dibang MPP took a review meeting on 8th May 2023 with project officials and M/s L&T. He also held a meeting with Dibang Downstream Affected Area Committee and discussed the downstream issues related to Dibang Project.
 15. NHPC Sports scholar Shri Navdeep won Gold medal in Javelin & Ms. A. Nalini, Senior Manager (Finance) won Bronze Medal in Discus Throw in 5th Indian Open Para Athletics International Championship 2023 held from 5th May to 7th May 2023 at Bengaluru.
 16. Power Usage Agreement for off take of 400MW Solar power under CPSU scheme for 25 years from COD was signed by NHPC with Punjab State Power Corporation Limited on 16th May 2023.
 17. NHPC observed Swachhta Pakhwada-2023 from 16th May to 31st May 2023 across all its Power Stations, Projects and Offices. Various programmes related to cleanliness/ were organized during Swachhta Pakhwada-2023.
 18. The revenue collection during the month of May 2023 stood at Rs. 503 Crore.
 19. The total cumulative generation of all NHPC Power Stations stood at 4611.1 MUs at the end of May 2023.

Performance Highlights: June 2023

1. A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was exchanged between NHPC and Vidhyut Utpadan Company Limited, Nepal for development of Phukot Karnali Hydro Electric Project (480MW) in Nepal in the august presence of Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India and Shri Pushpa Kamal Dahal 'Prachanda' Hon'ble Prime Minister of Nepal at Hyderabad House, New Delhi on 1st June 2023. The MOU was signed by the undersigned and Shri Surya Prasad Rijal, Managing

- Director, VUCL. The signing of this MOU is a landmark step towards India-Nepal Joint Vision on Power Sector Cooperation.
2. An MOU has been signed between NHPC and Department of Energy, Govt. of Maharashtra on 6th June 2023 in the presence of Shri Devendra Fadnavis, Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister, Govt. of Maharashtra for the development of Pumped Storage Schemes and other Renewable Energy Source Projects in the State of Maharashtra. The MOU envisages development of four Pumped Storage Projects aggregating to 7350 MW namely Kalu-1150MW, Savitri-2250MW, Jalond-2400MW & Kengadi-1550MW and other Renewable Energy Source Projects in the state.
 3. An MOU was signed between NHPC and Govt. of Odisha through GRIDCO Limited on 23rd June 2023 for “Development of Pumped Storage Projects (PSPs) and Renewable Energy in the State of Odisha”.
 4. Shri Uttam Lal took over as Director (Personnel) at NHPC.
 5. Concreting upto Dam top level of EL 210 M in all the blocks of 2000 MW Subansiri Lower HE Project was completed achieved on 29th June 2023.
 6. NHPC participated in Annual meeting on International Commission on Large Dams (ICOLD 2023) held from 10th to 15th June 2023 in Gothenburg, Sweden. The NHPC delegation actively participated and presented various Papers on critical issues faced by hydropower developers in respect of management and safety of dams which were highly appreciated by the participants. NHPC's capabilities in the field of hydropower development were also showcased in a special pavilion at the event.
 7. NHPC signed an MOU with Kerala State Electricity Board (KSEB) to set up a “Design Clinic” for vetting of design of KSEB Projects on 16th June 2023 as part of its Consultancy Services initiatives.
 8. A Pump Hydro Storage site with estimated storage capacity of 525 MW X 6 Hours has been allotted to NHDC by Department of New and Renewable Energy, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh on 7th June 2023.
 9. The revenue collection during the month of June 2023 stood at Rs 710.55 Crore.
 10. The total cumulative generation of all NHPC Power Stations stood at 7786.7 MUs at the end of June 2023.

Performance Highlights: July 2023

1. Government of Arunachal Pradesh on 21st July 2023 has conveyed its approval for allotment of two mega projects i.e. 2000 MW Subansiri Upper Hydroelectric Project and 1800 MW Kamala Hydroelectric Project to NHPC.
2. In Rangit- IV HEP (120 MW), concreting upto Dam top i.e. EL 471m of Overflow Block no 5 completed on 6th July 2023.
3. Teesta- VI Project (500 MW), Cumulative progress of 5 Km in HRT heading excavation achieved on 22nd July 2023.
4. In Pakal Dul HE Project (1000 MW), the launch of Tunnel Boring Machine-1 for construction of HRT - 1 has been successfully achieved on 25th July 2023.
5. On 26th July 2023, NHPC contributed Rs. 3 Crore to Chief Minister's Relief Fund (CMRF), Himachal Pradesh towards the relief of the flood and landslide victims in the state.
6. NHPC has released the 1st installment of Local Area Development Fund (LADF) amounting to Rs 14.95 Crore to Himachal Pradesh State Government in respect of Dugar HE Project (500 MW) located in Himachal Pradesh. This fund will be highly beneficial in taking up development works in remotely located Pangi Tehsil of Himachal Pradesh.

7. 10. NHPC's achievements were showcased in 'Govt. Achievements & Schemes Expo-2023' organized by NNS Media Group at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi from 21st to 23rd July 2023.
11. MoU was signed on 27th July 2023 between NHPC & UP Braj Teerth Vikas Parishad for providing CSR support for O&M of TTSP Water Booths, Water Lines & Tube Wells for Choti & Badi Parikrama at Govardhan, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh for 3 years at a cost of Rs 1.5 crore.
12. The revenue collection during the month of July 2023 stood at Rs. 1063.70 Crore and the cumulative revenue collection for FY 2023-24 till July 2023 was Rs 2786.82 Crore.
13. The total cumulative generation of all NHPC Power Stations stood at 10967 MUs at the end of July 2023.

Performance Highlights: August 2023

1. Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) was signed on 12th August 2023 between NHPC and Government of Arunachal Pradesh at Itanagar for Development of Subansiri Upper Hydroelectric Project (2000 MW) and Kamala Hydroelectric Project (1800 MW) in the august presence of Shri R.K. Singh, Hon'ble Union Minister of Power, New and Renewable Energy, Shri Pema Khandu, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh and Shri Chowna Mein, Hon'ble Dy. Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh.
2. The NHPC Board approved the Quarter-I results for FY 23-24 in their meeting held on 11th August 2023. NHPC registered its Highest ever Quarter-I Standalone Profit after Tax (PAT) of Rs 1053 Crore against PAT of Rs 1050 Crore for the Quarter-I of previous FY.
3. On 19th August 2023, Shri R.K. Singh, Hon'ble Union Minister of Power, New & Renewable Energy dedicated the 'Beautification of Chhath-Ghat' works at Semariya Ojha Patti village, Shahpur (Bihar) done by NHPC under CSR. The Hon'ble Minister also laid foundation stone for completing additional works of Chhath Ghat.
4. CMD, NHPC met Hon'ble Lt. Governor of J&K, Sh. Manoj Sinha on 29th August 2023. The Hon'ble Lt Governor expressed his appreciation for the commendable works being carried out by NHPC for the development of Hydropower Projects in J&K. He assured all support from UT administration of J&K as well as the local authorities in faster

implementation of the upcoming projects as well as in exploration and harnessing of New Hydro Projects.

5. NHPC signed an MOU on 23rd August 2023 with Andhra Pradesh Power Generation Corporation (APGENCO) Limited (A Govt. of Andhra Pradesh Undertaking) for Implementation of Pumped Hydro Storage Projects and Renewable Energy Projects under Joint Venture Mode in Andhra Pradesh in the august presence of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, Shri Y.S. 6. The awards were received by Shri Uttam Lal, Director (Personnel), NHPC from the Hon'ble Union Minister of Power.
7. Ratle Hydroelectric Power Corporation signed Power Purchase Agreement on 8th August 2023 with Gujarat Urja Vikas Nigam Limited for offtake of power from its 850 MW Ratle HEP at Vadodara, Gujarat.
8. NHPC signed MOU on 21st August 2023 with RITES Limited for Construction of Railway Siding at Pasighat, (Arunachal Pradesh) for NHPC Dibang Multipurpose Project.
9. An MoU was signed on 1st August 2023 between NHPC and ALIMCO for distributing aids and assistive devices to around 1000 Divyangjans in vicinity of NHPC Projects located in North and North Eastern states under CSR.
10. 2. The critical Head Race Tunnel works at 500 MW Teesta VI HE Project (Sikkim) was restarted.
3. For the Half Year ended 30th September, 2023 (FY 23-24), NHPC registered its highest ever half yearly Standalone Profit after Tax (PAT) of Rs. 2500 Crore against Standalone PAT of Rs.2483 Crore for the corresponding previous half year.
4. Shri R.K Singh, Hon'ble Union Minister of Power, New and Renewable Energy visited NHPC's 2000 MW Subansiri Lower Hydroelectric Project (Assam / Arunachal Pradesh) on 27th November 2023. The Hon'ble Minister inspected the construction sites like the Dam, Intake structures and Diversion Tunnels. 3. The Pilot Project comprises of a 500 kW Grid-connected Solar Power Plant and Electrolyzers to produce 40 Kg of Green Hydrogen per day & Dispensing Station. The Pilot Project will be the first Green Hydrogen Based Mobility Station of Kargil and will help immensely in spreading awareness about Green Hydrogen in one of the remotest locations of India.
