
CSR ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN THROUGH CORPORATE OFFICE

(A) HEALTH & SANITATION:

Provide medical care and nutritional support to physically and mentally challenged persons residing at Cheshire Home India, Delhi Unit for the period of one year:

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed with Cheshire Home India, Delhi Unit on 17.01.2024 for providing medical care and nutritional support to the physically and mentally challenged persons living in Cheshire Home India at Delhi unit. Under this initiative, arrangement is being made to provide services of doctors, nurses, psychiatrists and attendants for day to day care of the physically and mentally challenged people. Speech Therapy session, Oro- motor exercises, Articulation therapy, Imitation, Phonetic sounds for voice clarity, Memory games/ word searching games, Vegetative skills training and Blowing/ Breathing Exercises, Physiotherapy, Speech therapy etc. are being conducted for the residents.

A Visit to Amrit Udhyan "Rashtrapati Bhawan" was organised on 26th February 2024, 22 beneficiaries of Cheshire Home visited the Amrit Udhvan.



Supply and Distribution of Blankets to vulnerable population of Dumariyaganj. Siddharthnagar District of Uttar Pradesh under CSR Initiative of NHPC.

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed with Uttar Pradesh Small Industries Corporation Ltd (UPSICL), Gorakhpur on 05.01.2024 for providing Blankets to vulnerable population of Dumariyaganj Constituency, District Siddharthnagar, Uttar Pradesh. Under this initiative, 10,000 unit of Blankets were supplied & distributed to the people of Durmariyaganj, Siddharthnagar through UPSICL. Sh. Jagdambika Pal, Hon'ble Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha) along with the social worker was present during the distribution of blanket. This activity was organised from 23.01.2024 to 29.01.2024 in different parts of District Siddhartnagar.



Supply and Distribution of Ration Kits in Domariyaganj, Siddharthnagar District, Uttar Pradesh under CSR Initiative of NHPC.

An Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed with Uttar Pradesh Small Industries Corporation Ltd (UPSICL), Gorakhpur on 16.01.2024 for providing Ration Kits to vulnerable population of Dumariyaganj Constituency, District Siddharthnagar, Uttar Pradesh. The total financial implication of this activity was Rs.34.12 Lakh. Under this initiative, 2500 Ration Kits were supplied & distributed to the people of Durmariyagani, Siddharthnagar through UPSICL. Sh. Jagdambika Pal, Hon'ble Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha) along with the social worker was present during the distribution kits.



> CSR Support to School of Mentally Retarded Children in Sector-14, Faridabad by providing one time Capital Items and Running expenditure for three years (2023-24 to 2025-26).

An MoU was signed with Rajasthan Association on 28.06.2023. Project Cost is Rs.34.64 Lakh. The first instalment of Rs.2.57 Lakh for Running Expenditure was released in July 2023, and the first instalment of Rs.12.68 Lakh for Capital Expenditure was released in January 2024. The activity is under progress. Around 40 students are getting benefitted from this activity.




> Afternoon Nourishment Meal Program for Underprivileged Girl Students" at Amitasha Foundation for Upliftment of Under privileged Children at Noida, Uttar Pradesh.

An MoU was signed between NHPC Limited and Amitasha Foundation on 06.10.2023 at NHPC Corporate Office. As part of this CSR initiative, Amitasha Foundation will provide Afternoon Nourishment Meal for one year to 300 underprivileged girls students studying in their Noida center. Providing nutritious food to underprivileged girls will not only help prevent malnutrition and related health problems, but will also strengthen their all-round development and immunity. This CSR initiative involves F.I. of Rs. 9.90 Lakh.





An MoU was signed between NHPC Limited and U.P. Small Industries Corporation Ltd on 20.02.2024 at NHPC Corporate Office. The Scope of work involves Design, Supply, Erection, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of 10 nos Reverse Osmosis System complete with fully automatic pre-treatment, chilling plant and post treatment for conditioning RO permeate to produce ideal quality treated water for domestic/ drinking and utility including chilling plant, water vending/ ATM machine with shed and floor complete in all respect at various places in Basti, Uttar Pradesh. This CSR initiative involves F.I. of Rs.83.89 Lakh.



Construction of 7 nos public toilets, named 'Sanitary Haven,' in various public places in Auraiya District, Uttar Pradesh.

An MoU was signed between NHPC Limited and Uttar Pradesh Cooperative Processing and Cold Storage Federation Ltd (PASCFED), Auraiya on 26.02.2024 at NHPC Corporate Office. The scope of work includes the construction of a 7 nos of public toilet facility at various locations in District Auraiya, Uttar Pradesh. This CSR initiative involves F.I. of Rs.60.00 Lakh.





Installation of 15 Nos Reverse Osmosis (RO) Water Treatment Plant 'Swachh Jal Dhara' at schools in District Gorakhpur of Uttar Pradesh.

An MoU was signed between NHPC Limited and Society for Advancement of villagers Empowerment and Rehabilitation of All (SAVERA), New Delhi on 26.02.2024 at NHPC Corporate Office. The Scope of Work involves Procurement and Installation of 15nos of 100 LPH Reverse Osmosis Plant with Alkaline cartridge at Different Schools. This CSR initiative involves F.I. of Rs.74.93 Lakh.





(B) EDUCATION & SKILL DEVELOPMENT:

Hydro Engineering College, Bandla, Bilaspur: Managed by HP Government.

The classes are running in the Campus of Government Hydro Engineering College since 16 December,2021. Physical work has been completed up to 93.5 % as per master plan. Both NHPC and NTPC have provided CSR support for establishment of Hydro Engineering College. NHPC has contributed Rs. 62.50 Crore for this CSR initiative.



Setting up of Kyan based Smart Classrooms for improved learning outcomes in 50 Govt. Schools of Uttarakhand.

An MoU was signed between NHPC Limited and Social Empowerment & Economic Development Society, New Delhi on 27.02.2024 at NHPC Corporate Office. The scope of the CSR initiative involves installation of Integrated Teaching Device (K-YAN) in 50 Government Schools of Pithoragarh and Champawat Districts of Uttarakhan. This CSR initiative involves F.I. of Rs.60.00 Lakh.



(C) ART & CULTURE:

Construction of Civic Amenity Building at Badrinath Dham through Shri Kedarnath Utthan Charitable trust (SKUCT).

An MoU was signed with Shri Kedarnath Utthan Charitable Trust (SKUCT) on 18.10.2021 for the construction of a Civic Amenity Building in Badrinath Dham. Project cost is Rs. 18.58 crore. A total amount of Rs. 13.0 crore has been released in four installment, and Utilization certificate of Rs. 9.29 Crore has been received & adjusted in account. Slab casting of 1st floor has been completed & slab casting for 2nd floor & erection of roof truss is under progress. The activity has achieved 75% of targeted work. Under this activity targeted beneficiaries are 1,25,000 nos.



D) TRAINING TO PROMOTE RURAL SPORTS/ PARALYMPIC SPORTS

For providing Regular sports training to Persons with Intellectual and Development Disability (PWIDD), an amount of Rs.100.00 Lakh has been allocated in FY 2023-24. An MoU had been signed on 19.07.2022 between NHPC and Special Olympics Bharat (SOB). Under this activity, NHPC is supporting 20 Centers. Rs.55.00 Lakh stands released in 2 installments. Training is under process. No. of beneficiaries is more than 800.

SALAL POWER STATION

Adoption of village Sai Lanjan in district Reasi by Salal Power Station as Adarsh Gaon:

Work awarded on 25.11.2023. Excavation work for levelling the road is in progress at present. Approx. 45% work completed Approx. About 5000 persons will be benefitted by the activity.



Construction of community hall at Pounsali village (Total cost Rs. 60 lacs). An amount of Rs. 30.00 lakh has been allocated during the current FY. Approx. 60% work completed. The no. of beneficiaries will be approx.1300.



Saksham Livelihood and Skill Development Programmes for unemployed poor adolescent girls and women:

An amount of Rs. 3.80 lakh has been allocated, out of which an amount of Rs. 1.40 lakh has been utilized. The activity is in progress. The no. of beneficiaries is about 50.





Nimmo-Bazgo Power Station

Supply, Installation, Testing and commissioning of 100 nos. 20 Watt Solar Street Lightning System at Demchok and other villages at Leh near China Border:

MoU signed on 17.03.2023. 2nd instalment of Rs.8,14,189/-released on 06.09.2023 to LREDA. Work completed. Handing-over/ inauguration by CEC, LAHDC, LEH done on 18.12.23. Payment under process. No. of beneficiaries is 375.



Educational Improvement Programme (Financial Assistance for hiring of tutors/ Instructors to conduct winter tuitions):

- NHPC Nimmo-Bazgo Power Station is conducting Educational Improvement Programme by providing financial assistance for hiriing of tutors/ instructors to conduct winter tuition for students of five villages namely Alchi, Bazgo, Likir, Khaltsi and Lamayuru in Leh Area.
- No. of beneficiaries of this initiative is 300.
- In the current FY 2023-24, Rs. 10.00 Lakh has been allocated for this CSR initiative.





Providing drinking water through Tanker supply. An amount of Rs.8.08 lakh has been allocated during the FY 2023-24 out of which an amount of Rs. 5.64 lakh has been spent till date. No. of beneficiaries is about 3500. Activity is in progress.



URI POWER STATION

> Installation of 10 Nos Solar Lights in village Kanipora, Tehsil & Distt. – Kulgam.

An amount of Rs. 3.20 lakh was allocated. Work is completed. Payment is under process.

EDUCATION & SKILL DEVELOPMENT:

Vocational training courses of cutting & tailoring, Beauty culture and certificate in computer applications to rural youth through Yog Manav Vikas Trust, Banikhet, Distt. Chamba (HP) for three years 2023-24, 2024-25 & 2025-26 (Project Cost Rs.57.51 Lakh).

An amount of Rs.18.52 Lakh has been allocated in FY 2023-24 and MoU was signed on 27.07.2023 with Yog Manav Vikas Trust, Banikhet, Distt. Chamba (HP) for imparting vocational training courses. A total of 360 youths shall be provided vocational training courses. As on 31.12.2023, 145 women have been enrolled in various courses. 1st instalment of Rs. 5.0 lakh released on 27.07.2023 as per MoU. Training is in progress.



Construction of Fencing of Playground Boundary Walls, Plastering floors, Painting & Electricity work of three classrooms, levelling of playground with interlocking tiles and providing Computers & Water Purifier to Govt. Sr. Secondary School, Nagali.

NHPC Regional Office Banikhet has provided 80 Lph Water Purifier to Govt. Senior Secondary School, Nagali on 10.01.2024. This CSR initiative involves F.I. of Rs. 7.00 Lakh. No. of beneficiaries of this initiative is 114.



SEWA-II POWER STATION

Construction of one female ward and one Tuberculosis ward at Sub District Hospital Bani:

Work awarded on 02.12.2023. Approx 25% work completed. Work is under progress. No. of beneficiaries is approx. 771.
