# CSR BULLETIN JULY, 2024



## CSR ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN THROUGH CORPORATE OFFICE

### (A) HEALTH, NUTRITION & SANITATION:

- **Providing medical care and nutritional support to physically and mentally challenged persons residing at Cheshire Home India, Delhi Unit for the period of one year:**

An MoU was signed with Cheshire Home India, Delhi Unit on 17.01.2024 for providing medical care and nutritional support to the physically and mentally challenged persons living for period of 12 months. Under this initiative, a provision has been made to provide services of doctors, nurses, psychiatrists and attendants for day to day care of the physically and mentally challenged people. Around 60 residents of Cheshire Home are getting benefitted from this activity. The activity is under progress. The total project cost is Rs. 68.24 Lakh. Recently, Counselling was conducted at Cheshire Home.



- **CSR Support to School of Mentally Retarded Children in Sector-14, Faridabad by providing one time Capital Items and Running expenditure for three years (2023-24 to 2025-26).**

MOU was signed with Rajasthan Association on 28.06.2023. Project cost is Rs.34.64 Lakh. This project aims at benefiting 26 students. In FY 2024-25, Rs.6.86 Lakh has been allocated for this initiative.



➤ **Afternoon Nourishment Meal Program for Underprivileged Girl Students at Amitasha Foundation for Upliftment of Under privileged Children at Noida, Uttar Pradesh.**

MoU was signed with Amitasha Foundation on 06.10.2023 for providing afternoon nourishment meals for 300 underprivileged girls. This CSR initiative involves financial implication of Rs.9.90 Lakh. In FY 2024-25, Rs.5.49 Lakh has been allocated.



➤ **Distribution of Aids and Assistive devices to around 1000 Divyangjans through Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation Limited (ALIMCO) in the North & North Eastern states.**

Under CSR initiative of NHPCL, free distribution of aids and assistive devices has been arranged at Dak Bungalow, Baramulla on 18.07.2024 in the presence of District Administration, Baramulla.





➤ **Construction of 7 nos public toilets, named 'Sanitary Haven,' in various public places in Auraiya District, Uttar Pradesh:**

An MoU was signed between NHPC Limited and Uttar Pradesh Cooperative Processing and Cold Storage Federation Ltd (PASC FED), Auraiya on 26.02.2024 for constructing 7 public toilets in Auraiya, UP. This CSR initiative involves F.I. of Rs.60 Lakh. Work is under progress.



➤ **Installation of 15 Nos Reverse Osmosis (RO) Water Treatment Plant 'Swachh Jal Dhara' at schools in District Gorakhpur of Uttar Pradesh:**

An MoU was signed between NHPC Limited and Society for Advancement of villagers Empowerment and Rehabilitation of All (SAVERA), New Delhi on 26.02.2024 at NHPC Corporate Office. The scope of work includes installation of 15 Reverse Osmosis (RO) Water Treatment Plants at schools in District Gorakhpur of Uttar Pradesh. In the current FY 2024-25, fund amounting to Rs.74.93 Lakh has been allocated for this CSR initiative. 1st instalment of ₹ 37.47 Lakh released as advance. Work is under progress.



➤ **Operation & Maintenance of Tank Type Stand Post (TTSP) Booths, Water lines & Tube wells for Chhoti and Badi Parikrama at Govardhan, Mathura for 3 years:**

An MoU was signed with Uttar Pradesh Braj Tirth Vikas Parishad on 27.07.2023 for implementation of this CSR initiative. The activity is under progress. The no. of beneficiaries is more than 5 lakhs. In the current FY 2024-25, fund amounting to Rs. 41.86 Lakh has been allocated for this CSR initiative.



## B) EDUCATION & SKILL DEVELOPMENT:

### ➤ Setting up of Kyan based Smart Classrooms for improved learning outcomes in 50 Govt. Schools of Uttarakhand.

An MoU was signed between NHPC Limited and Social Empowerment & Economic Development Society (SEEDS), New Delhi on 27.02.2024. The scope of work involves installation of Integrated Teaching Device (K-YAN), digital e-learning content with Multimedia content and English learning solution in 50 Government Schools of Champawat and Pithoragarh Districts of Uttarakhand. In the current FY 2024-25, fund amounting to Rs.60.00 Lakh has been allocated for this CSR initiative. 1st instalment of ₹ 36.00 Lakh has been utilized and 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment of ₹ 18.00 Lakh has been released as advance. The K-YAN projector has been installed in all 50 Schools and the training of teachers is under progress.



NHPC was honoured for its outstanding contribution to the education sector through the implementation of KYAN-based smart classrooms in 50 government schools across Champawat and Pithoragarh districts of Uttarakhand. The award was presented by the Chief Minister of Uttarakhand, Shri Pushkar Singh Dhama, and the Education Minister, Shri Dhan Singh Rawat, at a ceremony held at the State Council of Educational Research and Training in Dehradun on July 24, 2024, recognizing NHPC's efforts in enhancing educational infrastructure and digital learning in the region.



➤ **Hydro Engineering College, Bandla, Bilaspur: Managed by HP Government.**

The classes are running in the Campus of Government Hydro Engineering College since 16 December, 2021. Physical work has been completed up to 95.5% as per master plan. Financial expenditure of Rs.120.35 Crore has been incurred. Both NHPC and NTPC have provided CSR support for establishment of Hydro Engineering College. NHPC has contributed Rs. 62.50 Crore for this CSR initiative.

➤ **"DISHA": Nurturing Promising Life Paths for Students from Minority, SC, ST, OBC, and Economically Disadvantaged Communities across Various Districts in Kerala**

An MoU has been signed between NHPC Limited and Build India Greater Foundation on 25.06.2024 at NHPC Corporate Office. As part of this initiative, Build India Greater Foundation will conduct training sessions for 600 learners including SC/ST/OBC/OBC/OBC/Minorities from Ernakulam, Kottayam, Thrissur and Idukki districts of Kerala. The main objective of this project is to focus on professional development of the participants, guide them in making decisions about their education and career path, reduce the education-employment gap, promote environmental awareness, enable problem-solving and contribute towards nation building by promoting career growth of youth. This CSR initiative involves F.I. of Rs. 24.83 Lakh and an advance of Rs.12.41 Lakh has been released. The preliminary activities are done in the month of July 2024.



## (D) ART & CULTURE:

### ➤ Construction of Civic Amenity Building at Badrinath Dham through Shri Kedarnath Utthan Charitable trust (SKUCT).

An MoU was signed with Shri Kedarnath Utthan Charitable Trust (SKUCT) on 18.10.2021 for the construction of a Civic Amenity Building at Badrinath Dham. Project cost is Rs. 18.58 Crore. A total amount of Rs. 1300.60 Lakh has been released so far in four installments and Rs. 1013.37 Lakh stands utilized. Slab casting of two floor & erection of roof truss has been completed, finishing work are in progress. The activity has achieved 81% of targeted work. Under this activity, targeted beneficiaries are 1,25,000 nos. In the current FY 2024-25, fund amounting to Rs. 8.45 Crore has been allocated for this CSR initiative.



## (E) RURAL DEVELOPMENT

### ➤ Construction of 03 nos Community Halls in 3 villages of Krishna District, Andhra Pradesh:

An MoU was signed on 19.11.2022 for implementation of this CSR initiative. An amount of Rs. 83.19 Lakh has been allocated in the current F.Y. 2024-25 for construction of 03 Community halls in 3 villages (Kalasamalapalli Village of Thotlavalluru Mandal, Angaluru Village, of Gudlavalleru Mandal and Tarakaturu Village of Guduru Mandal) in Krishna District, Andhra Pradesh. The first instalment of Rs. 25 lakhs has been released & utilized. 2nd Instalment of Rs 32 Lakh has been released as an advance. Work of community halls at Kalasamalapalli, Anguluru and Tarakaturu is under Progress. No. of expected beneficiaries is 7843.

➤ **Gram Sethu Project, Nhattithod, Ayyankunnu, Kannur, Kerala:**

An amount of Rs. 28.48 Lakh has been allocated in the current FY 2024-25 for implementation of 'Gram Sethu Project, Nhattithod, Ayyankunnu, Kannur, Kerala'. The MOU has been signed between NHPC Limited and Sevakaran Charitable Society on 6<sup>th</sup> March 2024. Work stopped due to heavy rains in Kerala.



## E) TRAINING TO PROMOTE RURAL SPORTS/ PARALYMPIC SPORTS

For providing Regular sports training to Persons with Intellectual and Development Disability (PWIDD), Rs.75.00 Lakh has been allocated in FY 2024-25. An MoU had been signed on 19.07.2022 between NHPC and Special Olympics Bharat (SOB) for implementation of this initiative. NHPC has supported 20 centers in different states. No. of beneficiaries is more than 800. Training is under progress.





## CHUTAK POWER STATION

- **Installation of water ATM of 250 LPH at New District Hospital Kurbathang Kargil.**

An MOU was signed on 22.09.2023. An amount of Rs. 2.11 Lakh has been utilised. Water ATM has been delivered. Activity completed. Approx. 1500 persons will be benefitted by the activity.



## Nimmo-Bazgo Power Station

- **Furnishing of Library at Alchi Gonpa:**

An amount of Rs.12.34 lakh was allocated. LOA was issued on 03-02-2024. Work is completed. About 300 persons will be benefitted by the activity.



## REGIONAL OFFICE, BANIKHET

- Vocational training courses of cutting & tailoring, Beauty culture and certificate in computer applications to rural youth through Yog Manav Vikas Trust, Banikhet, Distt. Chamba (HP) for three years 2023-24, 2024-25 & 2025-26 (Project Cost Rs.57.51 Lakh).

An MoU had been signed on 27.07.2023 with Yog Manav Vikas Trust, Banikhet, Distt. Chamba (HP) for imparting vocational training courses. An amount of Rs. 28.24 lakh has been allocated in the current FY 2024-25. A total of 360 youths shall be provided vocational training courses. Training is in progress.



## BAIRASIUL POWER STATION

- Construction of Balika Ashram, Chilli, Tissa

An MoU was signed with Govt of HP. Work awarded on 25-01-2023. An amount of Rs.132.94 lakh has been allocated during the FY 2024-25. Work is under process. Plaster and electrification work of first floor, wooden work (i.e doors and windows) are in progress. Window grill work is started. The no. of beneficiaries is 50.



## REGIONAL OFFICE, CHANDIGARH

- Installation of 100 Feet National Flag with Decorative Foundation in Agrasen Chowk, Village -Sunam Udham Singh Wala, District – Sangrur, Punjab.

An MoU was signed between NHPC and Organization for Social and Cultural Awareness on 18.06.2024 for implementation of this CSR initiative. This CSR initiative involves F.I. of Rs. 5.80 Lakh.



## PARBATI-II H.E.PROJECT

- Completion of path from Main Gate of Govt. Senior Secondary School Gadsa to Stage :

An amount of Rs. 3.33 lakh has been allocated. MoU was signed on 28.02.2024. 50% advance payment stands released. Work is under progress.



## TEESTA-V POWER STATION


- **Construction of Mid-Day meal Kitchen and electrification in the Govt. Sr. Sec School, Dickchu, Gangtok, Sikkim.**

An amount of Rs.9.00 lakh has been allocated. Work was awarded on 19.03.2024. Work is under progress. Approx 85% completed. The no. of beneficiaries will be approx.215.



- **Construction of Boundary wall/ fencing at Lum School and Construction of Pathway in the Lum Village, North Sikkim:**

An amount of Rs.7.35 lakh was allocated. Work was awarded on 09.02.2024 and is completed. More than 500 persons will be benefitted by the activity.



➤ **Renovation, Beautification and providing infrastructure for the Saraswati Vidhya Niketan, Samdong (Sikkim):**

An amount of Rs.10.00 lakh has been allocated in F.Y. 2024-25. Work was awarded on 19.03.2024. Work is under progress. Approx. 80% work completed. The no. of beneficiaries is about 500.



## DIBANG MULTI PURPOSE PROJECT

➤ **Construction of Boys and Girls Hostel for Govt. Residential School Ranli, Dibang Valley, Arunachal Pradesh.**

An amount of Rs. 14.71 lakh has been allocated. MoU was signed on 15.05.2023 with School Management Committee and Rural Works Division, Anini, Dibang Valley. Approx 97% work has been completed and work is in progress. The no. of beneficiaries will be about 65.



## LIAISON OFFICE, LUCKNOW

- **Development of 5 nos of Parks by providing Solar Trees and LED Lights in the holy city of Ayodhya, Uttar Pradesh through CSR.**

MOU was signed on 27.09.2023. The above CSR initiative involves F.I. of Rs. 60.00 Lakh out of which Rs.12.00 Lakh has been utilized. An amount of Rs.48.00 lakh has been allocated in F.Y. 2024-25. Work is under progress. No. of expected beneficiaries is 4500. This CSR initiative is being implemented through UPNEDA (Uttar Pradesh New & Renewable Energy Development Agency) in Geographical area of Municipal Corporation, Ayodhya.



- **Construction of Community/ Marriage Halls at Village Mawaiya and Village Rehnas of Block Sarsaul of District Kanpur:**

MOU was signed on 26.07.2022 with PWD, Kanpur. An amount of Rs.24.46 lakh has been allocated in F.Y. 2024-25. Work at Rehnas and Mawaiya village is in progress. Approx. 6325 persons will be benefitted by the activity.
