CSR ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN THROUGH CORPORATE OFFICE

(A) HEALTH, NUTRITION & SANITATION:

- **Implementing a Two-Year Initiative: Establishing a Skill Development and Education Centre, and Distributing Nutrition Supplements and Immunity Booster Kits at Titu Colony, Sector 28, Faridabad, Haryana.**

MoU was signed with Punarjagaran Samiti, New Delhi on October 23, 2024, with a total project cost of Rs 20.10 lakh. Under this initiative, a skill development and education center has been set up and nutritional support is being distributed to children. The primary objective of this activity is to empower children and women from underprivileged families through skill development, education and health promotion.

Education Center: A total of 100 children in the age group of 3 to 13 years are actively participating in free classes of Hindi, English and Mathematics.



➤ **Providing CSR Support for Organizing 05 Rural Health Camps in District Basti, Uttar Pradesh:**

NHPC Limited under its Corporate Social Responsibility initiative approved the CSR activity for organizing 05 Rural Health Camps in the districts of Uttar Pradesh and signed a MoU with Maati, Charitable Trust, Ghaziabad, UP on dated 05.02.2025 for its implementation.

05 Rural Health Camps were organized from 28.02.2025 to 02.03.2025. Postal banners and print and digital media announcements were made during the health camps. 6 outstation doctors, 2 local doctors, 10 technicians, 3 testing centers have been provided under the camps.



➤ **Ecological Restoration and Conservation of Sale Lake in Sale Village, Raigad, Maharashtra Using JalVed™ Ayurvedic Extract.**

MoU has been signed with Social Umbrella Foundation on 10.01.2025 for implementation of CSR initiative during financial year 2024-25 and 25-26 with a project cost of ₹99.87 lakh. This activity will include ecological restoration and conservation through TM Ayurvedic extract. The activity has started from cleaning and dosage of Ayurvedic extract. Two installments have been released so far under this activity.

To establish the topographical model of Sale Lake and its surrounding area, an aerial survey, GIS mapping, and hydrological survey were carried out to analyze water level fluctuations, flow dynamics, and potential stagnation areas within Sale lake



➤ **CSR Support for Deepstambh Foundation's 'Manobal' residential training centre for students with disabilities, orphans, rural and tribal youth at Jalgaon, Maharashtra for 3 years:**

On 08.08.2024, an MoU was signed with Deepstambh Foundation, Jalgaon to provide support for the 'Manobal' Residential Training Centre for three years. This CSR initiative with a financial involvement of Rs 530.51 lakh will support 100 students including persons with disabilities, orphans, and youth from rural and tribal areas. In the current financial year 2024-25, only ₹ 123.16 lakh has been allocated for this CSR initiative. The first installment of ₹ 82.11 lakh has been released as advance. The activity is in progress.



➤ **Empowering Women's Health: NHPC's CSR Initiative for Awareness, Distribution of 'Saukhyam Reusable Pads,' and Installation of Pad Vending Machines in 20 Schools/ Colleges across Pithoragarh and Champawat Districts, Uttarakhand.**

An MoU was signed with the Ayurarogya Saukhyam Foundation on 21.08.2024 for the implementation of this CSR initiative. The project involves distributing reusable pad sets to 2000 girls of around 10 schools and colleges in Champawat and Pithoragarh district of Uttarakhand. An amount of Rs 35.00 lakhs has been allocated for this CSR initiative. The first installment of Rs 17.50 lakhs has been released. Awareness camps were organized by the Saukhyam Foundation in various schools of Champawat district during February, 2025. The activity is in under progress.



➤ **Providing Free Drinking Water Facility at Maha Kumbh Mela 2025, Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh through Pilo Smart Water ATMs**

On 23.01.2025, MoU was signed for installation of 05 Pilo Smart Water ATMs to provide free drinking water facility at Mahakumbh Mela 2025 under CSR activity.

After the completion of Mahakumbh Mela 2025, the water ATMs installed at Mahakumbh Mela will be relocated and re-installed at the following locations: 1) Etmaduddaula Fort- 01 and near the gate of Agra Taj Mahal - 02 water ATMs will be installed, the location for the remaining is being decided.

➤ **Distribution of Aids and Assistive devices to around 1000 Divyangjans through Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation Limited (ALIMCO) in the North & North Eastern states.**

MoU was signed between NHPC Limited and M/s ALIMCO on 01.08.2023 for an amount of Rs. 150.00 lakh for NHPC's CSR initiative for distribution of aids and assistive devices to about 1000 Divyangjans through Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation Limited (ALIMCO). Thereafter ALIMCO has organized Assessment & Distribution Camps for providing free aids and assistive devices to Divyangjans at following locations: 1) Pithoragarh (Uttarakhand), 2) Kishtwar, Jammu & Kashmir, 3) Baramulla & Udhampur, Jammu & Kashmir, 4) Lower Subansiri, Assam, 5) Dibang & Siang, Arunachal Pradesh, 6) Jaisalmer, Rajasthan, 7) District Chamba, Himachal Pradesh, 8) Champawat (Uttarakhand).

Total 1369/- Nos. of beneficiaries under this scheme has been benefited. The above work has been completed at all the concerned places except Pithoragarh (Uttarakhand).



B) EDUCATION & SKILL DEVELOPMENT:

- **"DISHA": Nurturing Promising Life Paths for Students from Minority, SC, ST, OBC, and Economically Disadvantaged Communities across Various Districts in Kerala:**

MoU has been signed between NHPC Limited and Build India Greater Foundation on 25.06.2024. Under this initiative, Build India Greater Foundation will conduct training sessions for around 600 learners including SC/ST/OBC and Minorities from Ernakulam, Kottayam, Thrissur and Idukki districts of Kerala.

This CSR initiative involves a total FI of ₹ 24.83 lakh and an advance of ₹ 12.41 lakh has been released. As of December 2024, the program has made significant progress, with 347 students registered, 6 workshops conducted and 24 online programs organized, indicating its growing impact and reach.




➤ **Strengthening of infrastructure of Government Senior Secondary School, Lakkarpur, Faridabad (Haryana) through NGO SACH.**

A MoU has been signed on 23.10.2024 with NGO "Society for Action in Community Health (SACH), New Delhi for implementation of CSR initiative to strengthen the infrastructure of Senior Secondary School, Lakkadpur, Faridabad (Haryana). The activity includes strengthening of 16 classrooms by providing tile flooring, corridors, painting of walls, repair of windows and doors etc. Presently around 2550 students are studying in this school. Till date, Rs 32.22 lakh has been released in three installments. The above activity has been completed.



➤ **Hydro Engineering College, Bandla, Bilaspur:**

Government Hydro Engineering College is fully functional from 16 December 2021. 98% of physical work on available land has been completed by February 2025. Both NHPC and NTPC have provided CSR support for setting up of Hydro Engineering College. NHPC has contributed Rs 62.50 crore under this CSR initiative. As per Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Himachal Pradesh Technical University, a total of 7.5% quota is available for dependent members of NHPC employees in B.Tech (Civil, Electrical and CSC) courses.



➤ **CSR support for Government Girls Inter College(G.G.I.C), Siddharthnagar, Uttar Pradesh towards strengthening the infrastructure of college building:**

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed on 15.07.2024 with District Civil Society Responsibility Association, Siddharthnagar for strengthening the infrastructure of Government Girls Inter College (GGIC), Siddharthnagar. The total cost of the CSR project is Rs. 615.00 lakhs only.

So far 25% of the physical work has been completed. Presently the work is in progress which includes construction of boundary wall, demolition of terraces, brick lining and other related activities. A total amount of Rs. 172.50 lakhs has been released to District Civil Society Responsibility Association Siddharthnagar in two installments so far.



C) Rural Development

➤ Gram Sethu Project, Nhattithod, Ayyankunnu, Kannur, Kerala:


An MoU has been signed between NHPC Limited and Sevakiran Charitable Society on 6th March 202. An amount of ₹ 28.48 lakh has been allocated for the construction of a culvert having a clear span of 5 m and 50 m long approach road at Nahettithode, Ayyanakunnu, Kannur, Kerala. first installment of ₹ 15.00 lakh has been released as advance. The work is in progress.



D) TRAINING TO PROMOTE RURAL SPORTS/ PARALYMPIC SPORTS

An amount of Rs. 75.00 lakh has been allocated in FY 2024-25 for providing regular sports training to Persons with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (PWIDD). An MoU was signed between NHPC and Special Olympics Bharat (SOB) on 19.07.2022 for implementation of this initiative.

NHPC is providing support to a total of 20 centres in various states. Total number of beneficiaries is around 800. Training is in progress.



E) ENVIRONMENT

- **Desilting of earthen bunds, deepening and widening of streams in Parkandi Village, Taluka - Maan, District Satara, and in Gondune Village & Borgaon (Hiridpada) Village, both in Taluka - Surgana, District Nashik, Maharashtra.**

MoU was signed with Nam Foundation, Pune, Maharashtra on 19.08.2024 for implementation of this CSR initiative. The scope of work includes enhancing water retention and recharge, mitigating flood risk and improving agricultural productivity in Parkandi, Gondun and Borgaon villages.

The project involves desilting of earthen dams, deepening and widening of streams and implementing measures to ensure a sustainable water supply and promote environmental protection. The total sanctioned cost on this activity is ₹ 93.00 lakh and the first installment of ₹ 37.20 lakh was released as advance. The work is in progress.



- **Installation of 100 Solar Street Lights in District Sitapur, Uttar Pradesh under CSR Initiative of NHPC.**

On 22.10.2024, a MoU was signed with UPSICL for installation of 100 solar street lights in Sitapur, Uttar Pradesh with a total project cost of Rs 20.78 lakh. The first installment of Rs 10.39 lakh has been released. The activity is in progress and 70 solar lights have been installed so far.




(F) ART & CULTURE:

➤ Construction of Civic Amenity Building at Badrinath Dham through Shri Kedarnath Utthan Charitable trust (SKUCT).

A MoU was signed with Shri Kedarnath Utthan Charitable Trust (SKUCT) on 18.10.2021 for construction of Civic Suvidha Bhawan at Badrinath Dham. The total cost of the project is Rs.18.58 crore. So far Rs.16.72 crore has been released in five installments and Utilization Certificate of Rs.16.38 crore has been received so far.

Under this initiative, construction of two stories building with top of roof truss, 04 nos. waiting rooms of large size and 11 nos. of stores cum shops for various purposes has been completed. Finishing works like stone cladding on wall, granite work for corridor flooring and false ceiling work etc. have been completed. Total 99% of physical work has been completed. Completion report is awaited for release of final installment.

REGIONAL OFFICE, JAMMU

- **Setting up an eye care unit, repairing and remodelling of the Eye OT, Construction of Ramp with Canopy at Ramakrishna Mission Medical Centre, Jammu:**

An amount of Rs 76.74 lakh has been allocated for the above activity during the financial year 2024-25. MoU was signed on 17-10-2024. The first installment of Rs 20.74 lakh has been released as advance. The work is in progress. Around 1000 people will be benefited from this activity.



SALAL POWER STATION

➤ Organizing Medical Camps in remotely located villages of Reasi District:

An amount of Rs 6.00 lakh has been allocated for this activity during the financial year 2024-25. A medical camp was organized on 17-01-2025 in which 151 patients were benefited.



➤ Construction of 02 Nos.Toilets at Industrial Training Institute, Reasi in Jammu & Kashmir.

An amount of Rs 10.00 lakh has been allocated for construction of 02 toilets at Industrial Training Institute, Reasi. MoU has been signed on 19.11.2024. About 80% of the work has been completed. The work is in progress. Total number of beneficiaries will be around 300.



➤ **Construction of Community Hall at Ward No.2, Nai Basti, Reasi Village:**

An amount of Rs 30.00 lakh has been allocated for construction of community hall in Ward No. 2, Nai Basti, Reasi village. LOA issued on 31.03.2024. About 85% work has been completed. Work is in progress. Total beneficiaries will be around 5000.



NIMMO BAZGO POWER STATION

- **Educational Improvement Programme (Financial Assistance for hiring of tutors/ Instructors to conduct winter tuitions) at Alchi, Lamayuru, Likir, Khaltse, Bazgo etc:**

An amount of Rs 12.00 lakh has been allocated for the above activity during the financial year 2024-25. The work of winter tuition is in progress. The number of beneficiaries is 800.



REGIONAL OFFICE, BANIKHET


- **Vocational training courses of cutting & tailoring, Beauty culture and certificate in computer applications to rural youth through Yog Manav Vikas Trust, Banikhet, Distt. Chamba (HP) for three years 2023-24, 2024-25 & 2025-26.**

A MoU was signed on 27.07.2023 with Yoga Manav Vikas Trust, Banikhet, District Chamba (Himachal Pradesh) to provide vocational training courses. An amount of Rs 28.24 lakh has been allocated in FY 2024-25. 145 youth completed the training during FY 2023-24 and 102 youth have enrolled for FY 2024-25. Vocational training is in progress.



➤ **Construction of Public Toilet & Providing RO System & Benches to Lord Buddha Park in Tibetan Refugee Handicraft Centre, Middle Bakrota, Dalhousie:**

An amount of Rs 6.00 lakh has been allocated during FY 2024-25 for the above activity. Benches and RO systems have been installed at the site. About 1350 people will be benefited from the above activity.



SEWA-II POWER STATION

➤ **Imparting Skill Development to Unemployed Female Youth residing in remote village Draman adjoining NHPC Sewa-II Project.:**

An amount of Rs 35.28 lakh has been allocated for the above activity. MoU has been signed on 15-10-2024. Work is in progress. Number of beneficiaries is 200.



➤ **Construction of 03 no. additional class rooms in Govt. High School Barmota, Bani (Resolution of Gram Sabha Panchayat Barmota), Kathua:**

An amount of Rs 21.00 lakh has been allocated for the above activity. Work was awarded on 02.12.2024. The work has been completed. Around 1800 people will be benefited from this activity.



➤ **Construction of OPD Complex in Sub-District Hospital, Bani:**

An amount of Rs 100.00 lakh has been allocated for the above activity during the financial year 2024-25. The work was awarded on 27.12.2024. Around 57000 people will be benefited from this activity. The work is in progress.



BAIRA SIUL POWER STATION


➤ Construction of "BALIKA ASHRAM" Chilli, Tissa:

An amount of Rs 6.36 lakh has been allocated for the above work during the financial year 2024-25. The work has been completed. The number of beneficiaries will be around 1610.




REGIONAL OFFICE, CHANDIGARH
