The work at all the under-construction projects is progressing satisfactorily. Further, with many projects in pipeline, I am very much confident that NHPC will definitely achieve its goal of being a 23000 MW company by 2031-32.

I am happy to inform that, in 300 MW Karnisar Solar Power Project, Bikaner, after successful trial run 3rd Phase of 53.57 MW on 5th June 2025, its COD was declared w.e.f. 7th June 2025. Further, trial run of 4th Phase of 53.57 MW was carried out successfully on 29th June 2025 and COD declared w.e.f. 30th June 2025, now 214.28 MW out of total 300 MW stands commissioned.

With dedicated and sustained efforts, the Subansiri Lower Hydroelectric Project is now poised for partial commissioning of 750 MW. My heartfelt best wishes, in advance, to all of you, and especially to the entire Subansiri Lower Project team for outstanding commitment, resilience, and unwavering perseverance.

I am also pleased to inform that NHPC achieved its highest ever daily generation of 127.97 MU on 18th June 2025.

I am proud to share that NHPC has been awarded "Navratna of the Year (Manufacturing) 2024" by Dalal Street Investment Journal, recognizing its strong financial performance and was honored with the Roll of Honor Certificate on 3rd June 2025.

I am further delighted to share that NHPC has been conferred with 'Special Jury Award' under ET HR World Future Skills Award 2025 for "Use of Games & Simulations in L&D", at Mumbai on 11th June 2025.

NHPC successfully organized the 'Regional Power Ministers' Conference for the Northern Region States & UTs' on 6th June 2025 at Chandigarh. The conference was chaired by Shri Manohar Lal, Hon'ble Union Minister of Power and Housing & Urban Affairs. Shri Pankaj Agrawal, Secretary (Power), MOP, GOI was also present during the conference.
