## Dear Colleagues,

I am honored to assume the charge of Chairman and Managing Director of our esteemed organization for the second time. Having served NHPC for over 36 years, I have been privileged to witness its extraordinary journey of growth and transformation. I remain truly grateful for the opportunities and responsibilities our organization has bestowed upon me and I have always endeavored to fulfill my duties with utmost passion and dedication.

I am glad to share that work is progressing steadily and satisfactorily at our under-construction projects. In a major milestone at 2000 MW Subansiri Lower HEP, the Generator Rotor of Unit #4, weighing 673 metric tonnes, was successfully lowered into the pit on 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2025. This important achievement was witnessed by Shri Pankaj Agarwal, IAS, Secretary, Ministry of Power, Government of India during his visit to the Project from 19 – 20 July, 2025. He reviewed the work progress of key components at the Dam and Power House including Diversion Tunnel protection works. He also inaugurated the Power House Control Room of the Project. He appreciated the dedication of the project team and advised them to maintain momentum for expeditious commissioning of Units. He also visited NHPC's Siang Upper Project in Pasighat, Arunachal Pradesh on 19<sup>th</sup> July, 2025, where he reviewed the progress of survey works and encouraged the team to ensure timely execution of deliverables.

During July 2025, Pakal Dul HEP has achieved highest ever monthly tunnel boring progress of 927 m including lining by TBM. I congratulate the entire CVPPL & Pakal Dul HEP team for this remarkable achievement.

I held courtesy meetings with Shri Ghanshyam Prasad, Chairperson, CEA, Shri A. Balan, Member (Planning), CEA, Shri M.G. Gokhale, Member (Hydro), CEA and Shri V.K. Singh, Member (Power System), CEA on 10<sup>th</sup> July 2025. During the interactions, the senior officials were briefed on the key initiatives and ongoing activities being undertaken by NHPC across various domains.

I along with senior NHPC officials, participated in the meeting of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Communications & Information Technology on the subject 'Impact of Emergence of Artificial Intelligence and Related Issues' held on 7th July, 2025 at Guwahati, Assam.

The Parliamentary Standing Committee on Energy, led by Hon'ble Chairperson Shri Shrirang Appa Barne, visited NHPC's 45 MW Nimoo Bazgo Power Station on 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2025. Shri Sanjay Kumar Singh, Director (Projects), NHPC briefed the Committee about the Power Station's activities and highlighted its benefits to the local region and its strategic importance to the nation.

In a significant step towards Cyber Security fortification, on 14<sup>th</sup> July 2025, NHPC's Cyber Security Operations Centre (CSOC) has been set up at Corporate Office. The CSOC will strengthen NHPC's Cyber security posture by unifying and coordinating all cyber security devices / applications with round the clock operations.

## Other Highlights – July 2025

In July 2025, NHPC's revenue stood at ₹837.36 crore. Total generation from all NHPC Power Stations in July 2025 was 3049 MU, and cumulative generation up to July was 11394 MUs.

Tanakpur Power station generated 72.68 MU in July 2025 which is highest ever monthly generation achieved in the month of July, since commissioning.

In a significant development towards implementation of Sawalkot HEP, Forest Clearance Stage-I and Defence Clearance have been accorded to the Project by the concerned agencies.



A devastating flash flood occurred in Sainj Valley on 25th June, 2025 leading to complete shutdown of Parbati-II and Parbati-III Power Stations. Parbati-III Power Station was restored completely on 01st July, 2025. Two units of Parbati-Il have been restored and balance two units shall be resorted soon. The efforts made by teams of both these Power Stations is highly commendable.

Shri Sanjay Kumar Singh, Director (Projects), visited the 2880 MW Dibang Multipurpose Project in Arunachal Pradesh from 20th to 22nd July, 2025 and reviewed the activities of key components of the project.

Shri Uttam Lal, Director (Personnel), along with senior NHPC Officials, participated in a meeting of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Education, Women, Children, Youth and Sports held on 18th July, 2025 at Leh (UT of Ladakh). The meeting focused on the topic "Efforts through CSR Funding to Support Education and Sports in the Union Territory of Ladakh."

NHPC signed an MOU with Mewat Trust for Educational Welfare on 16th July, 2025 under CSR, for 'Installation of Water Coolers and Provision of Drinking Water at 50 Police Establishments' for the use of general public across Faridabad District, Haryana.

NHPC signed an MoU on 23rd July, 2025, with the Varanasi Development Authority (VDA) for the transformative CSR initiative titled "Transforming Varanasi District Library" to transform District Library into a Net Zero Facility.

Shri Suprakash Adhikari, Director (Technical), attended the Launch of Bihar Policy for Promotion of New and Renewable Energy Sources 2025, held in Patna on 28th July, 2025. During the event, Shri Adhikari met Shri Manoj Kumar Singh, Secretary (Energy) & CMD, BSPHCL and conveyed NHPC's keen interest in contributing to Bihar's green energy vision.

NHPC signed an MOU with IIM Jammu on 31st July, 2025 at Corporate Office in the presence of Shri Uttam Lal, Director (Personnel), NHPC. This collaboration aims to enhance leadership development, research and capacitybuilding initiatives.

Master Aryavansh Tyagi, NHPC Sports Scholar won silver medal (individual) in Trap Shooting at the Italian Open Green Cup on 20th July, 2025 in Italy.
