

# INTRODUCTION

NHPC Limited is the largest hydropower development organization in India, with capabilities to undertake all the activities from conceptualization to commissioning of hydro projects. NHPC has also diversified in the field of Solar & Wind energy development etc.

It is an ISO: 9001:2015, ISO-14001:2015 and ISO 45001:2018 certified company. Its vision is "To be a global leading organization for sustainable development of clean power through competent, responsible and innovative values".

NHPC's total installed capacity is 8332.90 MW including 1681.70 MW in Joint Venture, comprising 7771.20 MW from 23 Hydro Power Stations, 511.70 MW from Six Solar Power Projects and 50 MW from a Wind Power Project.

## Projects Under Construction

NHPC (including JVs / Subsidiaries) is engaged in construction of fifteen projects aggregating to 9704 MW as under:

- 2000 MW Subansiri Lower HE Project, Arunachal Pradesh

- Grid connected Solar PV Project, Stage-I & III at Khavda, Gujarat (200 MW each)

- 120 MW Rangit-IV HE Project, Sikkim
- 850 MW Ratle HE Project, UT of J&K by RHPCL
- 1000 MW Pakal Dul HE Project; 624 MW Kiru HE Project; 540 MW Kwar HE Project, UT of J&K by CVPPL (JV with JKSPDC)
- 1200 MW Jalaun Ultra Mega Solar Park, UP by BSUL (JV with UPNEDA). (This is a solar park and not part of capacity addition)

## Upcoming Projects

- The proposals received are compiled and further scrutinized in accordance with Schedule VII of Companies Act, 2013 as well as the availability of funds.
- The proposals are initially evaluated by the internal CSR Committee of CSR & SD Division and further by GM Level committee and then recommended for consideration of the Committee of Directors(CoD) on CSR & Sustainability.The CoD on CSR & SD recommends the CSR proposal to the Board of Directors for approval.
- Selection is done solely on the merit of proposals.

## Monitoring and Evaluation of CSR Activities

- Institutional arrangement exists for Implementation, Monitoring and Evaluation of the CSR & Sustainability activities of the corporation.
- The 03 tier Management structure for Implementation, Monitoring and Evaluating the progress of CSR schemes/ activities in NHPC are as under:
  - i) The Board level Committee on CSR headed by an Independent Director
  - ii) Nodal Officer of the Rank of Executive Director assisted by his team
  - iii) Regional ED/ Project Head/ Unit Head and his team for implementation and monitoring
- The progress of CSR & Sustainability schemes under implementation at each of the location is being reported by the Unit Head to Nodal Officer at Corporate Office, on monthly basis.
- Records are being maintained along with photographs/ videos to show progress of works.
- Quarterly Reports regarding the progress of implementation of CSR and Sustainability activities are reviewed by CSR Committee and NHPC Board.



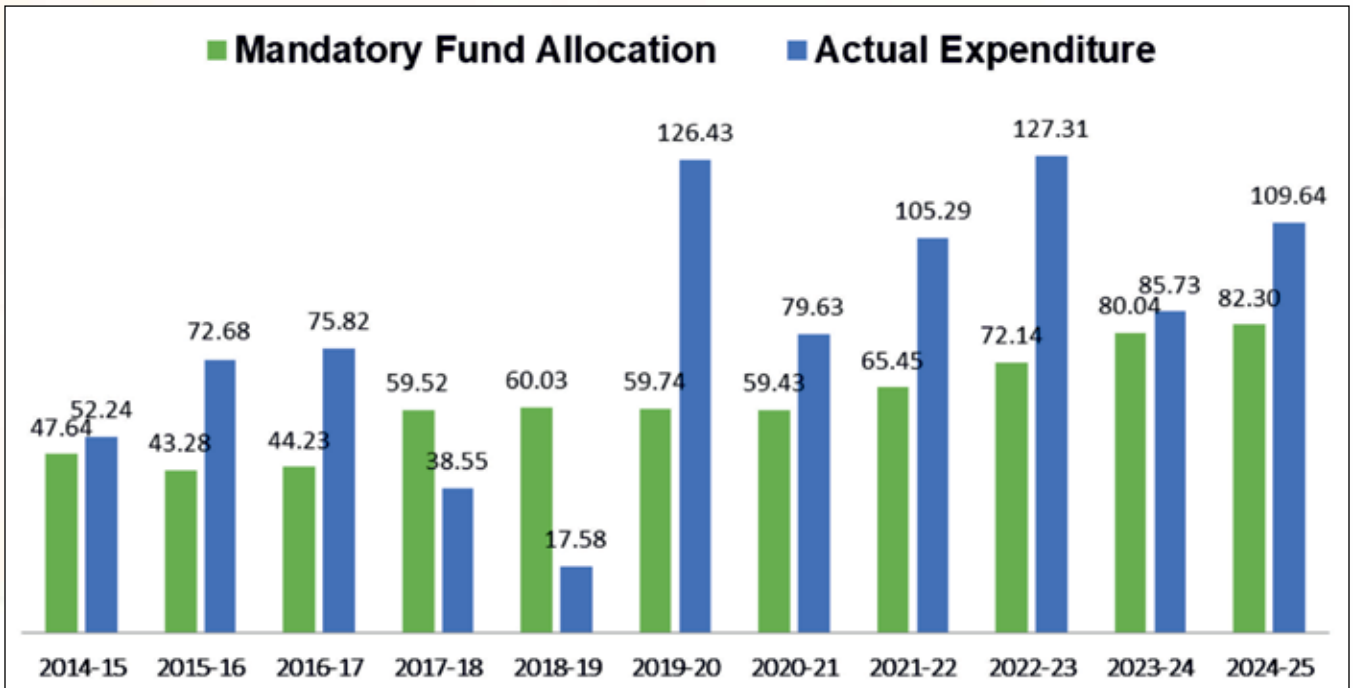

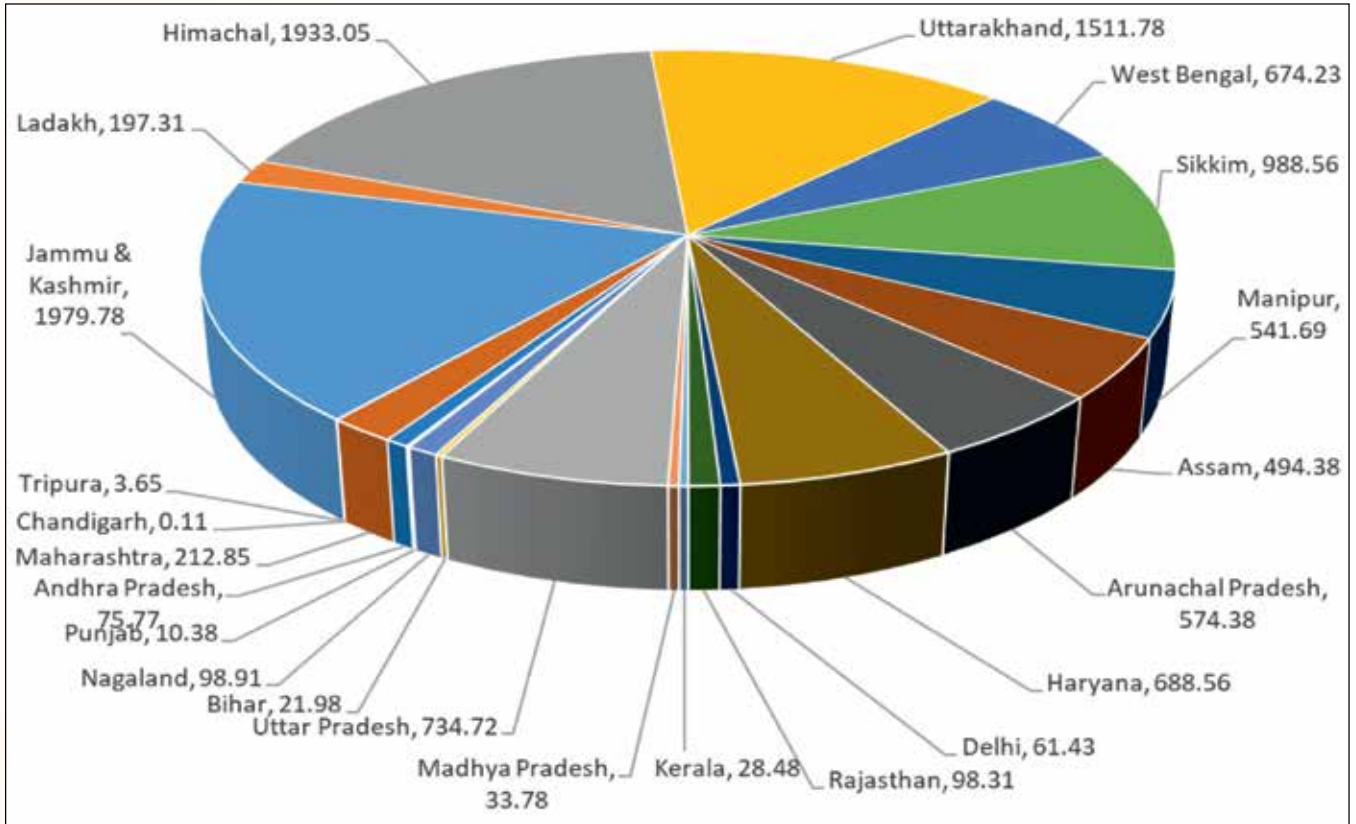

## State Wise Expenditure on CSR during FY 2024-25 (₹ in Lakh)

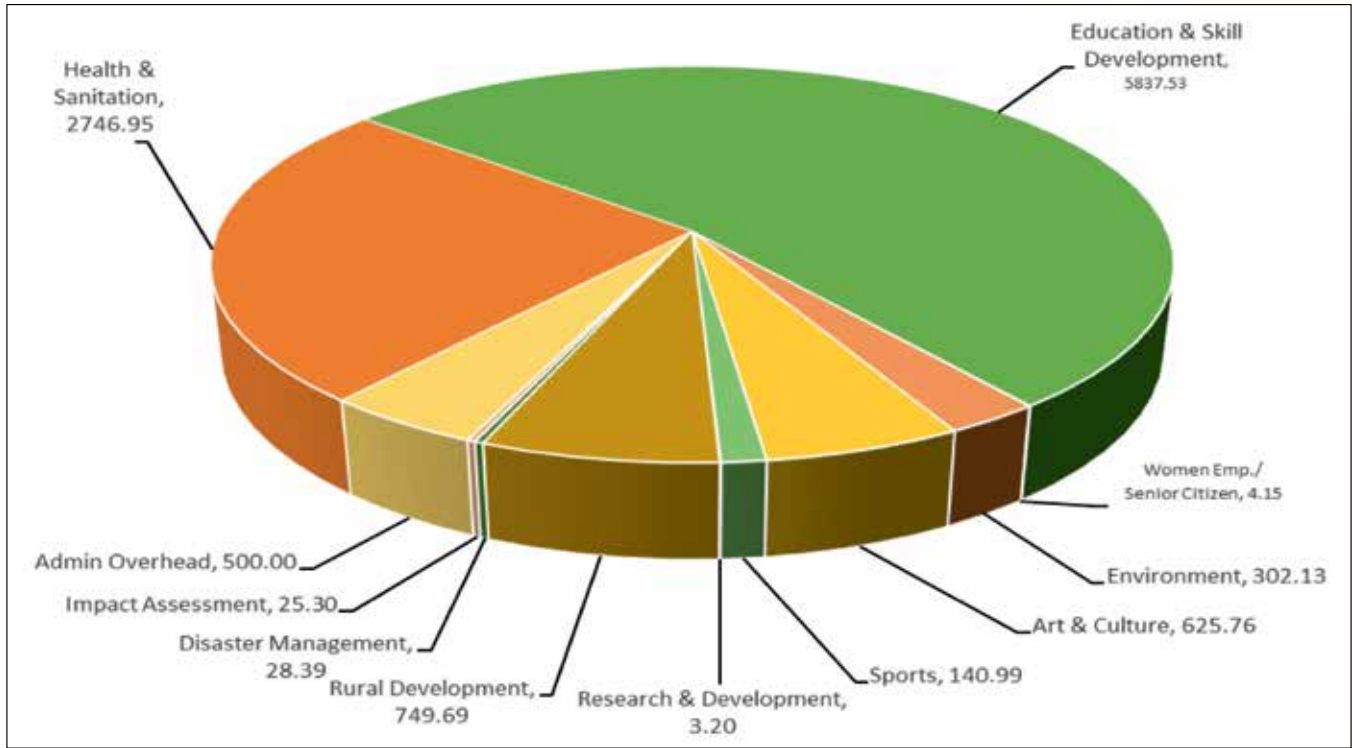

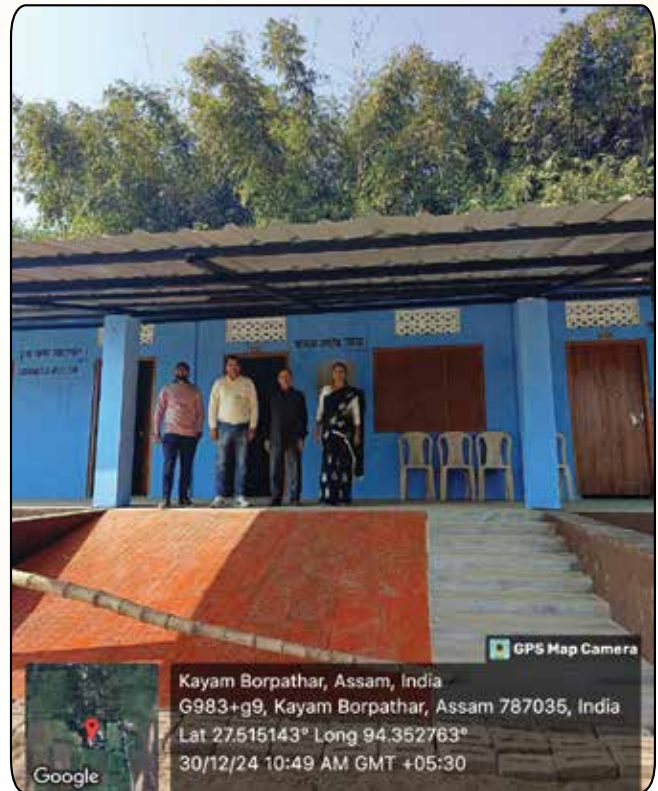

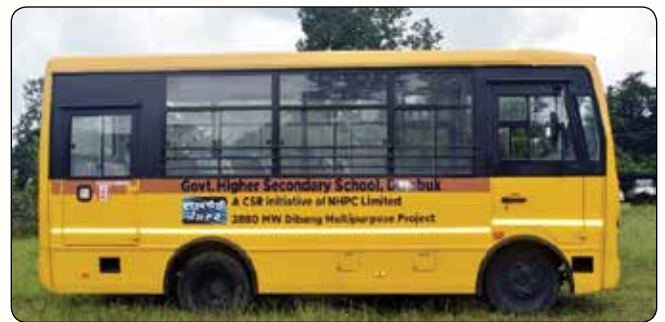
