2.0 Eligibility Criteria for Bidders:

2.1 Bids of those Bidders who have not submitted the requisite Cost of bidding document and EMD/ Bid Security (as per Instructions to Bidders (ITB) Clause 3.0 & 4.0) shall not be considered for evaluation.-

2.2.1 The bidders must fulfil the following minimum Qualifying Criteria:-

- (a) Bidder shall be **Class-I Local Supplier** under Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) order for Goods/ Services/ Works issued by Department of Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce and Industry Order No. P-45021/2/2017-PP (BE-II) dated 16th Sept’ 2020 as amended from time to time. Further, Local content/ Class-I local supplier etc. defined in ITB clause 2.2.4, in this regard bidders must submit undertaking as per Annexure-X of ITB.
- (b) Deleted.

- (c) The bidders should have successfully executed/completed contract as mentioned below for **similar items during last Seven years ending last day of month** previous to the one in which tenders are invited:

i) One Contract of at least- Rs. 160.03 Lakhs

Or

ii) Two Contract(s) each costing at least. Rs. 100.02 Lakhs

Or

iii) Three Contract(s) each costing at least Rs. 80.02 Lakhs.

The bidder shall provide with their Techno-Commercial Bid, **notarized copy** of Letter of Award/Supply Order, Bill of Quantities and execution/ completion certificate issued by the purchaser/ owner against above contract. In case Purchaser/Owner issuing execution/ completion certificate is non-government entity, the bidders shall also submit notarized copy of TDS Certificate.

Similar items referred above shall mean “Hydro Mechanical Works involved in Installation/ Repair work related to Hydro Power Project/ Station”.

- (d) Average Annual Turnover during last 3 years, ending **31st March 2024** should not be less than **Rs. 60.01 Lakh**. The bidder shall submit duly notarized copy of Auditor’s reports/audited Balance sheet & Profit Loss account for the last three financial years or Certificate from Chartered Accountant in respect of Annual Turnover during last 3 years, ending **31st March 2024** along with copy of ITR to prove financial standing of the bidder.

2.2.4 Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) order :

Definitions:

Local Content: means the amount of value added in India which shall, unless otherwise prescribed by the Nodal Ministry, be the total value of the item procured (excluding net domestic indirect taxes) minus the value of imported content in the item (including all custom duties) as a proportion of the total value, in percent.

Class-I local supplier: means a supplier or service provider, whose Goods/ services/ Works offered for procurement, has local content equal to or more than 50%.

- (a) For procurement of Goods/Services/Works, irrespective of purchase value where there is sufficient local capacity and local competition, only Class-I local supplier shall be eligible to bid.
- (b) Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India (except to which the Government of India has extended line of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development of projects as mentioned in Order Public Procurement No. 2 dt. 23.07.2020 or its subsequent revisions/amendments) will be eligible to bid only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority i.e. Registration Committee constituted by DPIIT.
- (c) The successful bidder shall not be allowed to sub contract works to any contractor from a country which shares a land border with India (except to which the Government of India has extended line of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development of projects as mentioned in Order Public Procurement No. 2 dt. 23.07.2020 or its subsequent revisions/amendments) unless such contractor is registered with the Competent Authority i.e. Registration Committee constituted by DPIIT.
- (d) A bidder is permitted to procure raw material, components, sub-assemblies etc. from the vendors of countries sharing a land border with India without getting registered with the Competent Authority i.e. Registration Committee constituted by DPIIT, as it is not regarded as “sub-contracting”.
- (e) However, in case a bidder proposes to supply finished goods procured directly/ indirectly from the vendors of countries sharing land border with India, such vendors will be required to get registered with the Competent Authority i.e. Registration Committee constituted by DPIIT.

Verification of local content:

(a) The 'Class-I local supplier' at the time of tender, bidding or solicitation shall be required to indicate percentage of local content and provide self-certification that the item offered meets the local content requirement for 'Class-I local supplier', as the case may be. They shall also give details of the location(s) at which the local value addition is made.

(b) False declarations will be in breach of the Code of Integrity under Rule 175(1)(i)(h) of the General Financial Rules for which a bidder or its successors can be debarred for up to two years as per Rule 151(iii) of the General Financial Rules along with such other actions as may be permissible under law. A supplier who has been debarred by any procuring entity for violation of this Order shall not be eligible for preference under this Order for procurement by any other procuring entity for the duration of the debarment. The debarment for such other procuring entities shall take effect prospectively from the date on which it comes to the notice of other procurement entities.

2.2.5 The reference date for considering the period for eligibility/qualification requirements above shall be the last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited.

2.2.6 The bidder should submit copy of PAN Card and Goods & Services Tax Identification No. (GSTIN) and EPF Registration No .

2.2.7 The bidder should submit copies of original documents defining the constitution or legal status, place of registration and principal place of business and notarized copy of power of attorney of the signatory of the Bid to commit the Bidder.

2.3 The Bidder should not have been banned / de-listed / black listed / debarred from business or declared ineligible on the grounds mentioned in ITB Cl. No. 12.0 (d) or para 6 of Guidelines on Banning of Business Dealings (Annexure-A) to Integrity Pact, ITB Clause 8.0. Self-declaration in this regard is to be submitted as per enclosed Annexure-III.

2.4 To improve transparency and fairness in tendering process and/or during execution of work undertaken, the Employer is implementing Integrity Pact as per Clause No. 8.0 of the ITB. The bidder must submit the Integrity Pact as per Proforma (Annexure-II) duly signed as per Clause 8.0 of ITB.

Pre-contract Integrity Pact is to be executed on plain paper with NHPC Ltd. at the time of submission of Bids. The successful bidder (Contractor) shall submit duly executed Integrity Pact on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of appropriate value prior to signing of Contract Agreement.

To oversee the compliance under the Integrity pact, Dr. Vinod Aggarwal, Shri Prabhash Singh & Shri Upendra Malik have been appointed as Independent External Monitor (IEM) by the Purchaser. The Contact Address of IEM is as under :-

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2.5 Bids of only those Bidders who are meeting the Eligibility Criteria specified above will be considered for evaluation and award of the contract. Bidders will submit duly notarized requisite supporting documents and testimonials with their Bids to prove their credentials and claim of meeting the Eligibility Criteria.

3.0 In the event of the specified date for the submission of offline documents being declared a holiday for the Employer, the hard copies of the documents will be received up to the specified time on the next working day. However, the date and time for online submission of the bids shall continue to be the date and time specified above or any amendment for the same.

4.0 Online submission of the Bids (incl. attachments) will not be permitted on the portal after expiry of submission time and the Bidders shall not be permitted to submit the same by any other mode. In such case, even if the bidder has submitted the specific documents in hard copy (ies) in original within the stipulated deadline, its bid shall be considered as late and shall not be considered at all any further. Offline documents, if received by the Employer after the deadline for submission of hard copies, then it will be considered as late bid even if the bidder has uploaded the bid online within the deadline. In such a case, the bid uploaded on the portal shall not be considered at all any further.

5.0 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bid, the Employer may amend the Tender Document

by issuing corrigendum/addenda/amendment which shall be notified on portal <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> & NHPC website www.nhpcindia.com. Therefore, the bidders are advised to visit the site regularly before deadline for submission of bids. Bidder is required to acknowledge the receipt of any such amendment from the CPP Portal. It will be presumed that the amendment has been accepted and the information contained therein has been taken into account by the Bidder in its bid. The bidders are requested to see the web site once again before the due date of tender submission/ opening to ensure that they have not missed any corrigendum/ addendum uploaded against the said tender after downloading the tender document.

The responsibility of downloading the related corrigendum/ addendum, if any, will be that of the downloading firm/prospective bidder.

- 6.0 Bids will be opened as per the schedule at the aforesaid venue. In case the office of Employer happens to be closed or in-advertent condition of non-availability/ non-working of Central Public Procurement (CPP) portal or for any other reason on the date of opening of bid as specified, the bid will be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.
- 7.0 Tenderer who has downloaded the tender from the NHPC website www.nhpcindia.com or Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) website <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>, shall not tamper/modify the tender document including downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tempered/ modified in any manner, tender will be completely rejected and EMD would be forfeited and tenderer is liable to be banned from doing business with NHPC.
- 8.0 The details/ information regarding online tendering i.e. Registration on CPP portal, Preparation of Bid and Submission of bid are available in the tender document and as well as on CPP Portal under “Bidders Manual Kit”.
- 9.0 NHPC reserves the right to reject any or all tenders and shall not be bound to assign any reason for such rejection.
