


Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

 - (ii) Online bids should be submitted containing scanned copy of documents as mentioned in ITB Cl. No. 5.1 of
 - (iii) Bidder shall upload duly filled check list as per ITB Cl. No. 15.0 of tender document.
 - (iv) Bidder shall submit offline bid submission as per ITB Cl. No. 5.2, bidders has to ensure delivery of hardcor
 - (v) Bidder shall upload self attested copy of Complete Bid document as attached at under heading " Any othe
 - (vi) Successful bidder shall submit performance security as per Cl. No. 5. of Conditions of Contract (Section-II)

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Clause No. 2.2.1 (ii) NIT (Both Hindi & English Version) shall be read as

"Average annual financial turnover during the last three (03) financial years (Ending on 31st March of F.Y. 2023-24) should be at least 30% of the **Annualized Estimated Cost.**"
