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2.0 Eligibility Criteria for Bidders:

2.1 Bids of those Bidders who have not submitted the requisite Cost of bidding document and Bid Security (as per Instructions to Bidders (ITB) Clause 3.0 & 4.0) shall not be considered for evaluation-

2.2 The bidders must fulfil the following minimum Qualifying Criteria:

2.2.1 a) Bidder shall be Class-I/ Class-II Local Supplier under Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) order for Goods/ Services/ Works issued by Department of Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce and Industry Order No. P-45021/2/2017-PP (BE-II) dated 4th June, 2020. Further, with regards to Local Content/ Class-I local supplier etc. defined in ITB clause 2.2.4, bidders must submit undertaking as per Annexure-XIV of ITB.

b) Registration certificate as Contractor/Company/ Firm with State/Central Govt. Agencies.
(Notarized copies of original documents defining the constitution or legal status, Memorandum of Understanding/ Articles of Association, place of registration, and principal place of business; notarized power of attorney of the signatory of the Bid to commit the Bidder with authority of the executants to execute the same.)

c) Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India *(except to which the Government of India has extended line of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development projects as mentioned in Order Public Procurement No. 2 dt. 23.07.2020 or its subsequent revisions/amendments)* will be eligible to bid only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority, i.e. Registration Committee constituted by DPIIT.

d) Average Annual financial turnover during last three years ending 31st March of the previous financial year, should not be less than 30% (Rs.23,18,000 /-) of the estimated cost of works for which bid has been invited.

Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods containing UDIN or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

The certificate from Chartered Accountant/Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period should also contain UDIN.

e) The bidder should have successfully executed/ completed similar works ("Supply, Installation, testing & commissioning of Strong Motion Accelerograph") during last 7 years reckoned from the last day of the preceding month from the date of NIT as per following criteria: -

- (i) One similar completed work costing not less than 61.82 Lakhs
- (ii) Two similar completed works costing not less than 38.64 Lakhs each
- (iii) Three similar completed works costing not less than 30.91 Lakhs each

In support of above, the bidders shall submit the copy of the following documents to establish the successful completion of the awarded works:

(i) Notarized Copy of Supply Order / Work Order.

(ii) Notarized Copy of successful completion certificate signed/ issued by Purchaser/ Owner.

(iii) In case Purchaser / Owner issuing experience certificate is non-government entity, the bidders shall also submit Copy of Taxable Invoice / TDS certificate (if applicable) for corresponding value of Supply Orders / Work Orders issued by the Purchaser / Owner.

Similar work is defined as "Supply, Installation, testing & commissioning of Strong Motion Accelerograph"

f) Specific Qualifying Criteria (Not Exempted for Start-ups):

- i. The bidders should have adequate work experience of similar nature of work as cited above i.e. having adequate work experience of **“Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning of Strong Motion Accelerographs (SMA)”**.
- ii. The bidder shall furnish ‘**Authorized Representative Certificate**’ from the principle manufacturer. Wherever Authorized Distributors/vendors are submitting the bid, **Manufacturers Authorization Form (MAF)/Certificate** with OEM details such as name, Designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid. The equipment model shall be a standard product of the principal manufacturer and must have been in satisfactory operation for a minimum of two years (minimum) in India/~~abroad~~. The supplier either himself or his principle manufacturer should have supplied installed and commissioned minimum 4 Nos. accelerograph.
- iii. Furthermore, supplier shall also furnish a list of supplied and successfully installed accelerographs in India, evidenced by the certificate from the customers of the satisfactory performance for two years from the date of Commissioning. Apart from this, it is mandatory that, the supplier should have well established laboratory/service center in India to carry out the essential repairs for which documentary evidence shall be submitted.
- iv.
 - (a) The bidder must provide a certification confirming that the offered technical specifications meet the functional requirements.
 - (b) Details of ‘Make’ and ‘Model’ along with specifications of SMA and online monitoring software must be submitted along with bids.
 - (c) Original Data sheets of the main equipment i.e., SMA is mandatory to submit along with Bids. Data sheet must clearly represent the detailed technical specifications. Typing specification on company letterhead will not be considered as a valid document.
 - (d) Bidders shall ensure & shall quote only those products in the bid which are not obsolete in the market and have at least 7 years’ residual market life. Certificate from OEM is required.
 - (e) Firm has to submit the letter from OEM along with bid document stating that OEM shall continue to provide after sale service /technical support as well as spares of SMA recorder up-to 10 years from date of issue of taking over certificate of equipment from NHPC.
 - (f) A certificate from the principal manufacturer must be provided, confirming that they will continue to extend both technical and hardware support to the supplier throughout the entire contract period with NHPC. The service provider shall not engage any third party for partial or complete maintenance services.

Note: - For the purpose mentioned above, the relevant period shall be considered as the last seven years, counted up to the last day of the month immediately preceding the month in which the tender is issued.

- v. A valid ISO certification of manufacturer for manufacturing the similar equipment (SMA) should be submitted with the bid.
- vi. The seller should upload following certificate in the bid: - This is to certify that the Hardware and the Software being offered, as part of the contract, does not contain Embedded Malicious code that would activate procedures to:
 - (a) Inhibit the desires and designed function of the equipment.
 - (b) Cause physical damage to the user or equipment during the exploitation.
 - (c) Tap information resident or transient in the equipment/network.
 - (d) The firm will be considered to be in breach of the procurement contract, in case physical damage, loss of information or infringements related to copyright and Intellectual Property Right (IPRs) are caused due to activation of any such malicious code in embedded software.

2.2.2 All Startups (whether MSEs or otherwise) **registered for similar nature of work and falling within the definition as per Gazette notification- no. GSR 127(E) dated 19.02.2019** or as amended from time to time are exempted from meeting the qualification criteria in respect of ~~Prior Experience~~ Prior Turnover as per para 2.2.1d) in public procurement subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications for which necessary documents shall be submitted by such bidders. However, in case of circumstances (like procurement of items related to public safety, health, critical security operations

and equipment's etc.) where purchaser may prefer the vendors to have prior experience rather than giving orders to new entities, such procurements, wherever adequate justifications exist, the purchaser may not relax the criteria of prior experience/turnover for the Startups..

2.2.4 **Preference to Make in India:**

A) Definitions

Local content: means the amount of value added in India which shall, unless otherwise prescribed by the Nodal Ministry, be the total value of the item procured (excluding net domestic indirect taxes) minus the value of imported content in the item (including all custom duties) as a proportion of the total value, in percent.

Class-I local supplier: means a supplier or service provider, whose Goods/ Services/ Works offered for procurement, meets the minimum local content as prescribed for Class-I local supplier under this order.

Class-II local supplier: means a supplier or service provider, whose Goods/ Services/ Works offered for procurement, meets the minimum local content as prescribed for Class-II local supplier but less than that prescribed for "Class-I local supplier" under this order.

Non-local supplier: means a supplier or service provider, whose Goods/ Services/ Works offered for procurement has local content less than that prescribed for "Class-II local supplier" under this order.

Minimum local content: Nodal ministry/department may prescribe only a higher percentage of minimum local content requirement to categorize a supplier as Class-I local supplier/Class-II local supplier/Non local supplier. For the items, for which Nodal ministry/department has not prescribed higher minimum local content notification under the order, it shall be 50% and 20% for Class I local supplier/Class-II local supplier respectively:-

Margin of purchase preference: means the maximum extent to which the price quoted by a "Class-I local supplier" may be above the L-1 for availing purchase preference. The margin of purchase preference shall be 20%.

Works: means all works as per Rule 130 of GFR-2017, and shall also include Turnkey works, Engineering, Procurement & Construction (EPC) Contracts and Services include System Integrator (SI) contracts.

B) Eligibility Criteria for Class I/II and Non Local Suppliers:

- a) For procurement of Goods/Services/Works, irrespective of purchase value where there is sufficient local capacity and local competition, only Class-I local supplier shall be eligible to bid.
- b) For procurement of Goods/Services/Works, not covered under B(a) above and having estimated value less than INR 200.00 Crores, where Global tender enquiry shall not to be issued except with the approval of Competent Authority as designated by Department of Expenditure. Only Class-I and Class-II local supplier shall be eligible to bid in procurements, except when Global tender enquiry has been issued. ~~In Global tender enquiries, Non local suppliers shall also be eligible to bid alongwith Class I and Class II local suppliers.~~

The above criteria shall be subject to compliance of following:

- i) The bidder shall have to be an entity registered in India in accordance with law. Indian subsidiaries of foreign bidders are eligible to participate in the bidding process provided they meet the qualifying criteria in terms of capability, competency, financial position, past performance etc. Further, Foreign bidders shall compulsorily set up their manufacturing units on a long term basis in India.
- ii) Foreign bidders can also participate in the bidding process provided they form Joint Venture with any bidder registered in India in accordance with law.
- iii) Country of origin of the equipment/material shall be provided in the bid.
- iv) The bids shall be in Indian National Rupees (INR) only in respect of local content.
- v) The bidder shall follow Indian laws, regulations and standards.
- vi) For supply of equipment / material from the country of origin other than India, the

bidder shall submit performance certificate in support of satisfactory operation in India or a country other than the country of origin having climatic and operational conditions including ambient temperature similar to that of India for minimum one year.

- vii) The manufacturer/ supplier shall list out the products and components producing Toxic Ewaste and other waste. It shall have an Extended Producers Responsibility (EPR) so that after the completion of the lifecycle, the materials are safely recycled / disposed of by the Manufacturer/ Supplier and for this, the Manufacturer/Supplier along with procurer has to establish recycling / disposal unit or as may be specified.
- viii) The bidder shall have to furnish a certificate regarding cyber security/safety of the equipment / process to be supplied/services to be rendered as safe to connect.
- ix) Wherever required, the Foreign supplier shall establish fully functional service centers in India and shall keep spares/material locally for future needs of Utilities.
- x) ~~Arbitration proceedings shall be instituted in India only and all disputes shall be settled as per applicable Indian Laws.~~

C) Verification of local content

- a) The 'Class-I local supplier'/ 'Class-II local supplier' at the time of tender, bidding or solicitation shall be required to indicate percentage of local content and provide self-certification that the item offered meets the local content requirement for 'Class-I local supplier'/ 'Class-II local supplier', as the case may be. They shall also give details of the location(s) at which the local value addition is made.

(In this regard bidder shall submit Self certification/declaration as per Annexure-XIV of ITB).

- b) In cases of procurement for a value in excess of INR 10.00 Crores, the 'Class-I local supplier'/ 'Class-II local supplier' shall be required to provide a certificate from the statutory auditor or cost auditor of the company (in the case of companies) or from a practicing cost accountant or practicing chartered accountant (in respect of suppliers other than companies) giving the percentage of local content.
- c) False declarations will be in breach of the Code of Integrity under Rule 175(1)(i)(h) of the General Financial Rules for which a bidder or its successors can be debarred for up to two years as per Rule 151(iii) of the General Financial Rules along with such other actions as may be permissible under law. A supplier who has been debarred by any procuring entity for violation of this Order shall not be eligible for preference under this Order for procurement by any other procuring entity for the duration of the debarment. The debarment for such other procuring entities shall take effect prospectively from the date on which it comes to the notice of other procurement entities.

2.2.5 The reference date for considering the period for eligibility / qualification requirements above shall be the last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited.

2.2.6 Each bidder must also produce with their Bid – PAN, Goods & Services Tax Identification No. (GSTIN) and EPF Registration No.

2.2.7 The exemption under NIT/ITB clause no. 2.2.2 is only for ~~Prior Experience~~ Prior Turnover detailed in NIT/ITB Clause no 2.2.1 (d) ~~& 2.2.1(e)~~.

2.3 The Bidder should not have been banned / de-listed / black listed / debarred from business or declared ineligible on the grounds mentioned in para 6 of Guidelines on Banning of Business Dealings (Annexure-A) ~~to Integrity Pact, ITB Clause 9.0~~. Self-declaration in this regard is to be submitted as per enclosed Annexure-III.

~~2.4 To improve transparency and fairness in tendering process and/or during execution of work undertaken, the Purchaser is implementing Integrity Pact as per Clause No. 9.0 of the ITB. The bidder must submit the Integrity Pact as per Proforma (Annexure II) duly signed [if applicable] as per Clause 9.0 of ITB.~~

~~Pre-contract Integrity Pact [if applicable] is to be executed on plain paper with NHPC Ltd. at the time of submission of Bids. The successful bidder (Contractor) shall submit duly executed Integrity Pact on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of appropriate value prior to signing of Contract Agreement. To oversee the compliance under the Integrity Pact, Sh. Dr. Vinod Agrawal, IAS (Retd.) and Sh. Prabhash Singh has been appointed as an Independent External Monitor (IEM) by the owner. 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- 2.5 The Bidder, against whom proceedings for insolvency under the Insolvency and Bankruptcy code 2016, or as amended from time to time, have started, shall not be eligible for bidding. Self-declaration in this regard is to be submitted as per enclosed Proforma (Annexure-X of Section-I).
- 2.6 Bids of only those Bidders who are meeting the Eligibility Criteria specified above will be considered for evaluation and award of the Contract. Bidders will submit duly notarized copy of following requisite supporting documents and testimonials with their Bids to prove their credentials and claim of meeting the Eligibility Criteria.
- Notarized copies of original documents (Registration certificate as Contractor/Company/ Firm with State/Central Govt. Agencies) defining the constitution or legal status, Memorandum of Understanding/Articles of Association, place of registration, and principal place of business; notarized power of attorney of the signatory of the Bid to commit the Bidder with authority of the executants to execute the same, as per clause 2.2.1(b) above.
 - Notarized Documentary evidence in support of average annual financial turnover (as per clause no. 2.2.1 (d) above is to be submitted as detailed below:
