2.0 Eligibility Criteria for Bidders:

2.1 Bids of those Bidders who have not submitted the requisite Cost of bidding document and EMD (as per Instructions to Bidders (ITB) Clause 3.0 & 4.0) shall not be considered for evaluation, except in case of exemption as per Clause No. 3.2 & Clause No. 4.1 of ITB.

2.2 The bidders must fulfil the following minimum Qualifying Criteria: -

2.2.1(A) To qualify for award for the contract:-

- Duly signed copies of documents defining the constitution or legal status, Memorandum of Understanding & Articles of Association, place of registration, and principal place of business. Original Authorisation Letter for specific work or duly notarized general authorisation letter/ Duly notarized Power of Attorney of the signatory of the bid to commit the bidder with authority of the executants to execute the same.
- Past work experience to demonstrate meeting the criteria stipulated in clause 2.2.1(B) below shall be provided in Annexure -IV past experiences record, Section-I. The past work experience shown shall be supported with the duly attested / notarized copy of Supply Orders / Work Orders/ Letter of award with BOQ. The bidders shall also submit duly attested / notarized copy of the following documents to establish the successful completion of the awarded works:
 - Bidders shall submit duly attested / notarized copy of successful completion certificate/ successful installation certificate signed/issued by purchaser/owner.
 - In case Purchaser/ Owner issuing experience certificate is non-government / Private Entity, the bidders shall also submit duly attested / notarized copy of

TDS / GST / Sales tax certificate (whichever is applicable).

2.2.1(B) To qualify for award of the Contract, each bidder should have:

- (a) Achieved average minimum financial turnover during the last 3 years, (ending 31st March of 2025) should be at least equal to 30% of the estimated cost.

[Note: - Bidder is required to submit documents i.e. financial statements duly certified by CA or duly audited financial statements in support of their claim of turnover].

- (b) The bidder should have successfully work done / performed “similar works” during last 7 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited, and that should be either of the following: -

- I. One similar work done / performed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost. or
- II. Two similar work done / performed works each costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost. or
- III. Three similar work done / performed works each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost.

Note 1: Definition of “Similar work” shall be “Upkeeping/Running/Operation/ Maintenance of Guest House/ Building/ Offices/ Field Hostel/Transit Camp/Colony etc.”.

Note 2: The qualification criteria shall be considered work done for a minimum period of one year irrespective of length of contract subject to satisfactory performance certificate issued by the employer for the particular work done.

2.2.1(C) To qualify for award of the Contract for which bids are invited in the Notice Inviting Tender, the bidder must be **belonging to Project Affected Families (PAFs) / Project Affected Villages near to Uri-II Power Station.**

Eligibility Criteria shall be governed by **“Policy for reservation of works to be awarded on Local Competitive basis to PAFs / Project Affected Villages near to the Uri-II Power Station”** as per NHPC Corporate Office **Circular No. CCW/2025/215 Dated 07.01.2025 as applicable from time to time.**

A. Definitions of Project Affected Families (PAFs)

The definition of Project affected families (PAFs) shall be as per definition provided in the “Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013” and subsequent amendments, if any.

The definition of Project affected families (PAFs) in relation to land acquired for NHPC is as below:

- i) A family whose land and other immovable property has been acquired.
- ii) A family which does not own any land but a member or members of such family may be agricultural labourers, tenants including any form of tenancy or holding of usufruct right, share-croppers or artisans or who may be working in the affected area for three years prior to the acquisition of the land, whose primary source of livelihood stand affected by the acquisition of land.
- iii) The scheduled tribes and other traditional forest dwellers who have lost any of their forest rights recognised under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 due to acquisition of land.
- iv) Family whose primary source of livelihood for three years prior to the acquisition of the

land is dependent on forests or water bodies and includes gatherers of forest produce, hunters, fisher folk and boatmen and such livelihood is affected due to acquisition of land.

- v) A member of family who has been assigned land by the State Government or the Central Government under any of its scheme and such land is under acquisition.
- vi) A family residing on any land in the urban areas for preceding three years or more prior to the acquisition of the land or whose primary source of livelihood for three years prior to the acquisition of the land is affected by the acquisition of such land.

B. Definitions of Locals

~~The geographical limits for defining the local residents eligible under the policy at the individual Project / Power Station shall be district(s) where the projects and its components are located.~~

The geographical limit for defining the locals contractors eligible under the policy has been reviewed by Uri-II Power Station and the same shall now be extended to Project Affected Families/ Project Affected Villages as identified by NHPC i.e. Nowpora, Jabla, Salamabad, Parampilla, Dachi, Ramgai, Kalgie, Dardkot, Uroosa, Bandi Brahmanan, Kitchama and Chakra villages.

C. Who are eligible

- i) PAFs, in the form of Individuals, Partnership Firms, Group of People of Cooperative Societies / Self Help Groups (SHGs) / Companies (having 100% beneficiaries from the category of PAFs/Locals) by locals from the notified area will only be considered under the policy for award of the reserved works / services. **The eligibility of PAF to participate in the tenders shall be considered taking into account the works awarded to PAF's family as whole. The person, his family alongwith legal heirs shall be considered as single PAF. Declaration in this regard shall be provided by the PAF. In case false declaration the concerned PAF shall be debarred from participation of tenders for Six months.**
- ii) The provisions regarding **Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order-2017, restrictions under Rule 144(xi) of the General Financial Rules (GFRs)2017**, Micro and Small Enterprises and Start-ups **as amended** from time to time shall be applicable for this policy. The ownership of MSMEs/Start-ups shall be from the entities listed at S. No. 2.2.1(C)(C)(i) above.

D. Limits of Works to be awarded to same entity

For benefit of larger population of nearby areas of Power Station, at a time not more than **04** works/services be allotted / awarded to the same entity.

E. Financial Limit

The value of works and Services to be awarded to any single entity at any point of time shall be limited to **Rs. 125 Lakhs**.

- 2.2.1(D) To qualify for Contract for which bids are invited in the Notice Inviting Tender, the bidder must demonstrate having work experience, financial capability and resources sufficient to meet the aggregate of the qualifying criteria. Failure to produce the certificates and documents in clause No. 2.0 (Eligibility Criteria for Bidders) shall make the bid non-responsive.
- 2.2.1(E) JVs or any other arrangement other than sole bidder is not allowed. Work experience of bidder as sub-contractor shall not be considered in qualification of its bid.

- 2.2.2 All Start-ups (whether MSEs or otherwise), falling within the definition as per Gazette notification- G.S.R. 501(E) dt. 23.05.2017 or as amended from time to time are exempted from meeting the qualification criteria in respect of Prior Experience-Prior Turnover subject to their meeting the quality and technical specifications for which necessary documents shall be submitted by such bidders. However, the Employer reserves the right to deny such exemptions to Start-ups (whether MSEs or otherwise) in case of circumstances like procurement of items related to public safety, health, critical security operations and equipment's etc. Declaration in this regard is to be submitted by the Bidder as per Annexure-VIII.
- 2.2.3 All Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) are exempted from meeting the qualification criteria in respect of Prior Experience-Prior Turnover in public procurement subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications for which necessary documents shall be submitted by such bidders.
- 2.2.4 The reference date for considering the period for eligibility / qualification requirements above shall be the last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited.
- 2.2.5 Each bidder must also produce with their bid- PAN, Goods & Service Tax Identification No (GSTIN), EPF Registration No and ESIC Registration No.
- 2.3 The Bidder should not have been banned / de-listed / black listed / debarred from business or declared ineligible on the grounds mentioned in Para 6 of Guidelines on Banning of Business Dealings (Annexure-A) to Integrity Pact *[if applicable]*, ITB Clause 9.0. Self-declaration in this regard is to be submitted as per enclosed Annexure-III.
- 2.4 To improve transparency and fairness in tendering process and/or during execution of work undertaken, the Employer is implementing Integrity Pact as per Clause No. 9.0 of the ITB. The bidder must submit the Integrity Pact as per Proforma (Annexure-II) duly signed *[if applicable]* as per Clause 9.0 of ITB.

Pre-contract Integrity Pact *[if applicable]* is to be executed on plain paper with NHPC Ltd. at the time of submission of Bids. The successful bidder (Contractor) shall submit duly executed Integrity Pact on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of appropriate value prior to signing of Contract Agreement.

To oversee the compliance under the Integrity Pact, **Sh. Prabhash Singh, Sh. Upendra Malik and Dr. Vinod Aggrawal** have been appointed as an Independent External Monitors (IEM) by the owner. The Contact Address of IEM is as under:-

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- 2.5 The Bidder, against whom proceedings for insolvency under the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code 2016, or as amended from time to time, have started, shall not be eligible for bidding. Self- declaration in this regard is to be submitted as per enclosed Proforma (Annexure-X of Section-I).
- 2.6 Bids of only those Bidders who are meeting the Eligibility Criteria specified above will be considered for evaluation and award of the Contract. Bidders will submit duly attested / notarized requisite documents and testimonials with their bids to prove

their credentials and claim of meeting the Eligibility Criteria.

3.0 NHPC reserves the right to reject any or all tenders and shall not be bound to assign any reason for such rejection.
