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SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT - Part B

These special conditions of contract shall be read and construed, along with the general conditions of contract for work of **“Supply of EHV grade Transformer oil for Power Transformers installed at Power House, Rangit Power Station.”** annexed hereto, but in case of any conflict or inconsistency between these Special Conditions and annexed General Conditions of Contract, provisions of Special Conditions contained herein shall prevail.

- 1. Transportation & Packing:** Transportation of material from firm's premises/works to Central Store, Rangit Power Station, Sagbari, Sikkim shall be arranged by the supplier/firm. The contractor shall be responsible for all the packing for transportation at site. All the equipment, material etc. shall be packed to transport the items safely in hilly terrain and climatic condition.
- 2. Delivery period:** The delivery period shall be 30 days from the date of Letter of Award (LOA). However, time taken for QAP approval, Pre- Inspection at the manufacturer's works, and issue of MDCC, if any shall be excluded from the above mentioned delivery period.
- 3. Pre-dispatch Inspection & Dispatch Clearance:** Inspection shall be carried out at the works/ premises of the bidder before dispatch of material. At least 07 days' advance/prior intimation to be given by supplier to Engineer-In-Charge for deputing its representative to carry out inspection. Necessary assistance for conducting the inspection shall be provided by the Supplier free of cost and detailed test reports shall be submitted to NHPC.

1. This specification covers manufacture, testing, inspection, supply and delivery of fresh, unused and pure EHV grade insulating TRANSFORMER OIL. The TRANSFORMER OIL should be clear and transparent and free from moisture and other suspended matter.

2. **SCOPE**

Supply of Transformer Oil, Apar Make – 77 drums (16093 liters). The quantity as indicated above are Fixed.

3. **SPECIFICATION OF TYPE-II TRANSFORMER OIL:**

The **TRANSFORMER OIL** is for insulation and cooling of the 11KV/132 KV Generator Step Up transformers extra high voltage conforming to the Technical particulars as mentioned below and National and international standards. The tests on TRANSFORMER OIL shall be conducted in accordance with the relevant methods detailed in IS:335/2018 as amended up to date or latest and as per our specification.

7. Performance Criteria & Guarantee

The material covered under this contract shall be capable of performing all intended duties and it is the responsibility of contractor to supply the Materials as per technical particulars.

8. Testing and Inspection

All the items to be supplied shall be routine tested as per relevant IEC/IS at the works of Contractor in presence of the Employer as per approved Quality Assurance Plan by NHPC. The Contractor is required to submit type test certificates and routine test reports of materials.

9. Sampling and Testing

Sampling of the oil shall be done in accordance with IS: 6855 – 2023 or National or International Standards and the tests shall be carried out in accordance with the test methods mentioned in IS: 335-2018 or National or International Standards with latest amendments in the manufacturer's laboratory with all arrangements made by the manufacturer.

The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:

- All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove; and
- All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.
