1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. QUALIFYING CRITERIA

1. The Bidder shall furnish Earnest Money Deposit (EMD), for amount specified in the Bid Document only in the form of Demand draft/Banker's Cheque/BG/ Payment online through RTGS/NEFT/ internet banking in Beneficiary name: NHPC Ltd payable at SBI Uri Branch (Branch Code-02500, IFSC Code - SBI N0002500---NHPC A/C No. 31150155087). No exemption for submission of EMD shall be given to Authorized Dealers/ Distributors/ Service providers/Traders etc. Only valid MSE registered seller/ StartUp companies are exempted from submission of EMD.

The bidders must fulfil the following minimum Qualifying Criteria:-

2. The bidder should be Manufacturer of the equipment **Portable gasoline engine driven hydraulic power pack**.

Or

The bidder should be authorized dealer/distributor of the manufacturer of quoted brands of the item of required configuration/specifications as specified in the NIT to quote on behalf of their Manufacturer, in case manufacturer does not quote directly. In such a case, the authorized dealer shall have to submit relevant 'Authorized Dealership' certificate from the manufacturer showing validity period.

A valid ISO certification of manufacturer for manufacturing the specified equipment/ system should be submitted with the bid.

3. In case a dealer is participating in a tender on behalf of one manufacturer, he is not allowed participating / quoting on behalf of another manufacturer in this tender or in a parallel tender for the same item. All such bids with same make/manufacturer will be rejected.
4. The Bidder should have supplied at least two similar equipment/systems of same capacity or higher in previous seven years. In support of the same, the bidder should submit authenticated copies of **supply orders for similar items issued by various clients with Bill of Quantities and completion certificate for above supply during last seven years** ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited.
 - Similar items means **“Supply, Installation, Commissioning of Portable gasoline engine driven hydraulic power pack, having engine capacity of 20 HP or more”**.
 - The reference date for considering the period for eligibility/ qualification requirements above shall be the last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited.
 - In case of experience certificates produced by the contractors/firms for having executed works for private organizations, TDS certificate shall also be produced along with experience certificate.
5. The equipment/system supplied should have performed satisfactorily for one year from the date of commissioning. The bidder should furnish the performance report from the clients in support of performance criteria.

6. Financial Criteria:

a. Turnover:

The average annual financial turnover of 'The bidder' during the last three years, ending on 31st March 2023 should be at least 50% of the estimated cost (or equivalent in foreign currency at exchange rate prevalent on 31 March of the respective accounting year) as per the Annual Report (Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account) of the relevant period, duly authenticated by a Chartered Accountant/ Cost Accountant in India or equivalent in relevant countries.

b. Working capital:

The working capital (current assets minus current liabilities) shall be equal to at least 3 times the monthly cash flow requirement i.e. Estimated cost of work*3/Supply period.

c. Net Worth:

1.0 Scope of Work:

The scope of this contract covers “Supply, Installation, testing & Commissioning of Portable gasoline engine driven hydraulic power pack for Radial Gate s” for Uri-II Power Station as per ‘Schedule of Quantities & Prices’ and per attached ‘Technical Specifications’. The Contractor shall obey all the labor laws & statutory provisions during execution of work at their firm premises/at work place.

2.0 Prices and Taxes & Duties:

(i) Prices shall be Firm and on F.O.R destination basis i.e. at “Central Store, Uri-II Power Station, Uri, Baramulla, J&K” (This is most essential), inclusive of charges for packing, handling, forwarding, transportation, Installation and all applicable taxes & duties, including those assessed on the Employer. Further, the contract unit rates shall also be after taking into account the input tax credit and other benefits.

(ii) Taxes, duties and levies, as applicable twenty eight (28) days prior to deadline for submission of bids (including on transportation), shall be mentioned in Price Bid i.e. Schedule of Quantities & Prices.

(iii) All taxes & duties mentioned in the Price Bid as per the above shall be paid/ reimbursed against proper invoice as per rules and other relevant document, if any and restricted to the total amount of Taxes & Duties in Price Bid subject to clause mentioned below. No other taxes and duties shall be payable / reimbursable by NHPC. TDS wherever statutorily required under any Tax Act/ Rule shall be deducted and deposited and necessary certificate will be provided by the Employer.

3.0 Terms of Payment:

i. 70% amount for supplied items shall be released along with GST after delivery of material at Uri-II Power Station along with submission of relevant documents after successful inspection of equipment & materials within specified period.

ii. 30% amount of supplied items and 100% amount of installation charges shall be released after successful testing & commissioning and 15 days uninterrupted trial run of the system within specified period.

The following documents shall be presented by the firm for payment:

- Invoice in triplicate (One original and two copies).
- Detailed packing list / challan.
- LR copy.
- Guarantee / warrantee certificate.
- Inspection report and / or dispatch clearance.
- Calibration certificates of the Data logger and the sensors.
- General Authorization for Data Logger from OEM.
- Insurance declaration / document.

In case of MSE:

All the payments for the supplies and/ or services rendered by MSEs (Micro & Small Enterprises) Supplier/ Contractor under the Contract shall be released within forty five (45) days from the day of acceptance*. In case, payment are not released as mentioned above, NHPC shall pay the principal amount plus compound interest with monthly rests from the date of immediately following the date agreed upon @ three times of bank rates as notified by Reserve Bank of India from time to time.

* Day of Acceptance means - day of the actual delivery of goods or the rendering of services; where any objection is made in writing by the buyer regarding acceptance of goods or services within fifteen (15) days from the date of delivery of the goods or the rendering of services, the day on which such objection is removed by the Supplier.

In case of non-MSE:

All the payments for the supplies and/or services rendered by non-MSEs (non-Micro & Small Enterprises) Supplier/Contractor under the Contract shall be released within forty five (45) days from the receipt of invoice/ bills from the Contractor/ Supplier complete in all respect.

In case, payment are not released as mentioned above, NHPC shall pay the principal amount plus simple interest from the date immediately following the date agreed upon @ 6% (six percent) per annum.

4.0 Completion period:

The total completion period shall be 04 (four) months from the date of issue of Supply Order, which includes supply, installation, testing, commissioning and trial run.

5.0 Liquidated Damages:

For supply: If the Contractor fails to attain completion of scope of work or any part thereof within the prescribed time for completion under clause 5.0 or any extension thereof, the contractor shall pay to the liquidated damages equal to the amount computed @ ½ (half) percent per week or part thereof of Contract Price plus applicable GST. The aggregate amount of such Liquidated damages shall in no case exceed 10% of the Contract Price. However cost compensation for any time extension shall not be paid.

6.0 Warranty Period:

The equipment/ items shall be warranted against poor quality or workmanship of material or manufacturing defects for a minimum period of 18 months from the date of supply or 12 months from the date of commissioning or standard warranty of the product offered by the Supplier/Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM), if higher. During the Warrantee period the Supplier shall repair/replace the defected items free of cost and no conveyance or any other charges shall be paid. If any defect is not remedied within a reasonable time, the Purchaser may proceed to do the work at the Supplier's risk and expense, but without prejudice to other rights, which the Purchaser may have against the Supplier in respect of such defects.

2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.

14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
