1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

Online electronic bids (e-tenders) are invited for one no. Bus for Sewa-II Power Station on behalf of NHPC Li mited (A Public Sector Enterprise of the Government of India) from **Project Affected Families (PAF) of NHPC, Sewa-II Power Station** on GeM Portal.

Eligibility Criteria for Bidders:

1.1 Bids of those Bidders who have not submitted the hard copy of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) shall n ot be considered for evaluation. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) is required to submit as tabul ated below.

EMD EXEMPTION: The bidder seeking EMD exemption, must submit the valid supporting document for the relevant category as per GeM GTC with the bid. Under MSE category, only manufacturers for goods of Primary Product Category and Service Providers for Services of Primary Product Category ar e eligible for exemption from EMD. MSE Services (Trading) are not eligible for EMD exemption.

- 1.2 The provisions regarding Micro and Small Enterprises, Make in India and Start-ups shall be applicable
- 1.3 The Bidder should quote only fixed charge for 24 Months (excluding GST).
- 1.4 Bidder should have valid RTA Permit / Grant Letter for All India Permit in his name for purchase of new bus.

Note:- Bus shall be deployed for regular duty in Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir and Himachal Pradesh and can be deployed for Punjab as per special requirement.

1.5 The manufactured Model of the offered vehicle should not be older than year 2024. Num ber of passenger seating capacity in Bus shall be 39 to 45.

1.6 Bid Specific ATC i.e. Annexure-I to IV and Special Conditions of Contract to be filled, signed and uplo aded online by the Bidder.

- 1.7 The eligibility of PAF to participate in the tenders shall be considered taking into account the works a warded to PAF's family as a whole. The person, his family alongwith legal heirs shall be considered a s single PAF. Declaration in this regard (Annexure-III) shall be provided by the PAF. In case of false d eclaration, the concerned PAF shall be debarred from participation of tenders for six months.
- 1.8 This work is reserved for PAFs residing near to the Power Station. Definition of Project Affected Family (PAFs) shall be as per the definition provided in the "Right to fair compe nsation and transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 and subsequent amendment, if any. The detailed definition in respect of PAFs for NHPC i s specified as below: -.

Definition of Project Affected Families (PAF) of NHPC, Sewa-II Power Station

- i. a family whose land or other immovable property has been acquired;
- ii. a family which does not own any land but a member or members of such family may be agricultu ral labourers, tenants including any form of tenancy or holding of usufruct right, share-croppers o r artisans or who may be working in the affected area for three years prior to the acquisition of la nd, whose primary source of livelihood stand affected by acquisition of land;
- the Scheduled Tribes and other traditional forest dwellers who have lost any of their forest rights recognized under the scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Fore st Right) Act 2006 due to acquisition of land;
- iv. family whose primary source of livelihood for three years prior to the acquisition of land is depen dent on forests or water bodies and includes gatherers of forest produce, hunters, fisher folk and boatmen and such livelihood is affected due to acquisition of land;
- v. a member of the family who has been assigned land by the State Government or the Central Gov ernment under any of its schemes and such land is under acquisition;
- vi. a family residing on any land in the urban areas for preceding three years or more prior to the ac quisition of land is affected by the acquisition of such land.

1.9 Documentary proof for PAFs: **PAF**/ **Oustee Certificate/Statement of acquiring the land of ap** plicant by NHPC Ltd. for constructing Sewa-II Power Station issued by Tehsildar/SDM of S tate Government.

- 1.10 For benefit of larger population of nearby area of Power Station, at a time not more than 4 (four) w orks/ services be allotted/ awarded to the same entity. Financial limit of award to any single entity at any point of time of work & service shall be limited to Rs. 125 lakhs. The reference date for considering the eligibility for bidders as PAF/ Locals shall be the last date of the submission of the online bid.
- 1.11 Details of works with duration executed in Sewa-II Power Station under works reserved for PAFs an d/or Locals, need to be furnished (Annexure-I).
- 1.12 The Bidders(s) whose contract(s) has been terminated due to poor performance by the Employer, shall not be allowed to participate in the bidding process for next 2 years w.e.f. the date of notificati on of termination.
- 1.13 Proof of ownership & Photocopy of all documents of the vehicle such as Ownership, Registration Certificate, Insurance and Road Permit etc. shall be submitted with the tender. In case, any bidder, i ntends to purchase the vehicle on a later date and interested to participate in above Tender, shall s ubmit an undertaking on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs 100/- duly attested by Notary (Ref. Annexur e-IV) that they will produce the vehicle along with required documentation of the vehicle, within 60 d ays from the date of issue of letter of intent (LOI). In case of failure of the bidder to submit the required documents, within time, NHPC reserves the right to forfeiture of its Bid security and terminate the award offer.
- 1.14 PAN and Goods & Services Tax Identification No. (GSTIN). However, as per Government of India not ification, "those person/firm/supplier, who are unregistered with GST can provide intra state/ intersta te services to a GST registered person/firm". If this condition is not extended by the Government of I ndia, then GST registration shall be required for all service providers. Therefore any bidder, who are not registered with GST, but interested to participate in above NIT, shall submit an undertaking on n on-judicial stamp paper of Rs 100/- duly attested by Notary (Ref. Annexure-IV) that they will register with GST (intra state/ interstate, as the case may be). In case of failure of the bidder to submit the re quired documents of GST registration GST registration within 1 month from the date of notification, NHPC reserves the right to reject the bid/contract and to forfeiture of its Bid security.
- 1.15 The Bidder should not have been banned/ de-listed/ black listed/ debarred from business or declar ed ineligible on the grounds mentioned in para 6 of Guidelines on Banning of Business Dealings (Ann exure-A) to Integrity Pact [if applicable]. Self-declaration in this regard is to be submitted as per encl osed Annexure-II.
- 1.16 Integrity Pact To improve transparency and fairness in the tendering process and/or during exec ution of work undertaken, the Purchaser is implementing **Integrity Pact**. The bidder must submit d

uly signed Integrity Pact as per Proforma.

- 1.17 Bids of only those Bidders who are meeting the Eligibility Criteria specified above will be considere d for evaluation and award of the Contract.
- 1.18 NHPC reserves the right to reject any or all tenders and shall not be bound to assign any reason fo r such rejection.

2 Evaluation of Bid

2.1 Work is reserved for project affected families (PAFs) only and at a time not more than 4 (four) wo rks/ services be allotted/ awarded to the same entity.

2.2 If the bidder has already been awarded four work/service from Sewa-II Power Station, their bid fo r instant tender shall be rejected.

3 Guidelines for finalizing the award process:

Letter of Intent will be issued to L-1 bidder for the bid. In case, the L1 bidder failed to provide the servi ce within stipulated time, the LOI will be cancelled.

7. Forms of EMD and PBG

Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). DD should be made in favour of

Sewa-II Power Station, NHPC Limited payable at SBI Khairi, IFSC Code SBIN0008844 . After award of contract, Successful Bidder can upload scanned copy of the DD in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy to the original DD to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.

8. Purchase Preference (Centre)

Bid reserved for Make In India products: Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local suppliers as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific

Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document 50%. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 . In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

9. Purchase Preference (Centre)

Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for percentage of 100% of total value.

Disclaimer/अस्वीकरण

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

- 1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.

- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for <u>attached categories</u>, trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
- 15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers / Service Providers are mandated to ensure compliance with all the applicable laws / acts / rules including but not limited to all Labour Laws such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 etc. Any non-compliance will be treated as breach of contract and Buyer may take suitable actions as per GeM Contract.

This Bid is governed by the <u>General Terms and Conditions/सामान्य नियम और शर्त</u>, conditons stipulated in Bid and <u>Service Level Agreement</u> specific to this Service as provided in the Marketplace.
